**TWO WORDS: THE TWINS (ALSO, NAZ REID):** After completing their three-game series/home-stand with the Yankees by getting swept in three games, the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with consecutive losses in Cleveland over the last two nights...today, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale at Progressive Field...after today's game, they will travel to D.C. and watch the Wolves play the Nuggets in Game 7 of the Western Conference Semifinals...tomorrow night they will begin a three-game series with the Nationals through Wednesday, April 19...they are looking to avoid losing six-straight for the first time since August 20-24, 2022, when they dropped six straight to Texas (3 games) and Houston (3 games)...they came out of that losing streak winning each of their next five.

**RAMÍREZ AGAIN, UP HIGH AND DOWN HARD!** The Twins lost to the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 11-4...Bailey Ober (4-2) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts, including a two-run homer from José Ramírez in the first inning...the offense scored all four of their runs in the ninth inning...Manny Margot recorded a season-high with three hits.

**AND 1:** Rocco Baldelli enters today with 399 career managerial wins...since becoming the Twins manager in 2019, only two AL managers have won more than Rocco: Kevin Cash (446-309) and Aaron Boone (441-314)...14 active managers have reached the 400 wins mark (Bruce Bochy, Bob Melvin, Bud Black, A.J. Hinch, Dave Roberts, Cash, Craig Counsell, Ron Washington, Brian Snitker, Scott Servais, Boone, Torey Lovullo, Alex Cora and Dave Martinez)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

**(TWENTY) SIXTH MAN:** The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Caleb Boshley from Triple-A St. Paul...Boshley (BOZZ-lee) has gone 4-1, 4.54 ERA (41.2 IP, 21 ER), five walks, 38 strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP in eight starts for the Saints this season...this is his second stint with the Twins this year; was previously with the club from May 1-2 and did not appear in a game...to make room for Boshley on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Jay Jackson for release or assignment...Jackson went 1-2, 6.85 ERA (22.1 IP, 17 ER), eight walks, 23 strikeouts, one hold and a 1.39 WHIP in 17 relief appearances for the Twins.

**GUARD PLAY:** The Twins are playing the Guardians for the fifth of 13 times in 2024...the Twins have gone 0-4 against Cleveland this season, going 0-2 at Target Field from April 4-6, followed by two losses this series...the next meeting between these two will be a four-game series at Target Field from August 9-11...make-up game/doubleheader on the 9th.

The Twins have lost five straight to Cleveland, dating back to September 6, 2023, their longest losing streak since dropping eight straight to the Guardians from June 29-September 17, 2022.  
Carlos Correa is hitting .304 (34-for-112) with seven home runs, 14 RBI, a .386 on-base percentage, a .509 slugging percentage and an .895 OPS in 30 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022.  
In his last nine games at Progressive Field, Willi Castro is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with a .900 OPS.

**THE (S)ANT(ANA)-MAN:** Carlos Santana has hit .247 (590-for-2393) with 122 doubles, seven triples, 111 home runs, 335 RBI and an .806 OPS in 680 career games at Progressive Field...since leaving Cleveland, he has slashed .131/.230/.192 against Guardians pitching...he has six hits in 53 at-bats at Progressive Field...below are all-time Progressive Field ranks:

**THE BIG TICKET:** Ryan Jeffers is hitting .295 (23-for-78) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, six walks, a .367 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.033 OPS in his last 22 games, since April 22.

Among all AL qualifiers on the season, Jeffers ranks fifth in OPS (.938), trailing Kyle Tucker (1.010), Juan Soto (.975), Aaron Judge (.973) and Salvador Perez (.949)...additionally, he ranks second in the AL in slugging percentage (.585), and fourth in OPS+ (167.2) and RC/27 (.794).

**THE LAST DANCE:** The Twins are looking to avoid being swept for the fourth time this season...the first sweep was in two games at Target Field by the Guardians April 4 and 6; the April 7th game was postponed due to rain, giving the Twins no chance to salvage the series finale...the second sweep was of three games in Baltimore from April 15-17...the third sweep was three games from Tuesday-Thursday this last week against the Yankees at Target Field.  
The last time the Twins were swept by the Guardians in three games came September 9-11, 2022 at Target Field...the last time they were swept in this ballpark was August 29-31, 2016 (3 games).

**EURO STEP:** Max Kepler has hit safely in 21 of his last 23 games since April 22...since that date, the Berlin, Germany native is hitting .373 (28-for-75) with 10 doubles, three home runs, seven walks, 17 RBI, a .422 on-base percentage, a .627 slugging percentage and a 1.048 OPS...since that date, he leads baseball in batting average and ranks fifth in OPS and eighth in slugging.

**TWINS & LEAGUE WEEKLYS:** FCL Twins outfielder Yasser Mercedes and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Pierson Ohl have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

Mercedes, 19, played in four games, hitting .625 (10-for-16) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, seven runs scored, three walks and a 1.809 OPS...the Rio Piedras, Puerto Rico native was signed by the Twins in January of 2022.  
Ohl, 24, made the start on Tuesday at Tulsa, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with four hits allowed and one walk, while tying a professional career high 10 strikeouts...the Moorpark, California native was selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Grand Canyon University.

**DOUBLE DOUBLES:** Did you know that Bally Sports analyst Denard Span went 3-for-4 with a double and an RBI in his first game in this ballpark on July 25, 2008...Denard doubled in this ballpark in five consecutive games from August 7-September 20, 2021, tied for second-longest streak in this ballpark's history with Shin-Soo Choo, Robinson Cano and José Bautista, and trailing Rusty Greer (6).

- Making ninth start of season and 74th of career (77th appearance)...last pitched May 14 vs. New York-AL and took the loss, allowing five runs on 12 hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings with two walks and four strikeouts.
Has never faced Cleveland...only active Guardians hitter he's faced is Ram3n Laureano (3-for-8, 3 K).
Has posted a 9.42 ERA (14.1 IP, 15 ER) with four home runs, four walks and six strikeouts in three road starts this season.

HIT HARD BY THE YANKEES: Last started May 14 vs. New York-AL, opposite Carlos Rod3n, and took his second loss of the season in Minnesota's 5-1 defeat...allowed five runs on a career-high-tying 12 hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts...allowed four hits and two runs in the second inning, then a Giancarlo Stanton solo home run in the third...Alex Verdugo added a two-out, two-run double in the fourth.

- Yankees went 4-for-10 with runners in scoring position vs. Paddack, stranding five runners in 5.0 innings.
Induced 13 whiffs on 51 swings (25.5%)...now ranks in MLB's 50th percentile with a 24.9 percent whiff rate.
Allowed eight hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph), including his two hardest-hit balls of the season - a 115.1 mph Aaron Judge lineout and Stanton's 114.0 mph, 427-foot home run...ranks in MLB's 42nd percentile with a 40.3 percent hard-hit rate.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 8 vs. Seattle, opposite George Kirby, earning his career-best fourth-straight win in Minnesota's 6-3 victory...allowed one run on eight hits (1 HR) in 5.1 innings, with one walk and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts...threw a season-high 99 pitches, his most in a start since July 27, 2021 vs. Oakland (102)...only run came on Mitch Garver's fourth-inning solo home run...was pulled with a runner on first in the sixth; Caleb Thielbar entered and stranded the runner.

- Induced a season-high 19 whiffs on 55 swings (34.5%).
Allowed seven hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...Seattle went 4-for-7 on those swings, including Garver's 98.3 mph home run.

PADDACK AT PROGRESSIVE: Has never faced Cleveland in his career...only active Guardians hitter he's faced is Ram3n Laureano, who's gone 3-for-8 with a double and three strikeouts...since joining Minnesota in 2022, Paddack has made three starts vs. AL Central opponents; has gone 1-1 with a 1.53 ERA (17.2 IP, 3 ER), one walk and 20 strikeouts.

- In 2018, Paddack and Cleveland's Josh Naylor were teammates on the San Antonio Missions, San Diego's Double-A affiliate.

ROAD RECORD: Making fourth road start of the season...has gone 1-1 with a 9.42 ERA (14.1 IP, 15 ER), 2.51 home-runs-per-9.0-innings and 3.77 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings on the road, compared to 3-1 at home with a 2.57 ERA (28.0 IP, 8 ER), 0.96 HR/9 and 11.25 K/9...nine of his 15 runs allowed on the road came April 16 at Baltimore.

PLATOON SPLITS: On May 14, New York-AL's left-handed hitters went 5-for-13 with a double, two walks and two strikeouts, while its righties went 7-for-13 with a double, a home run and two strikeouts...through eight games vs. Paddack, left-handed hitters have hit .352 (32-for-91) with an .836 OPS and 16.8 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .304 (28-for-92) with an .837 OPS and 25.3 percent strikeout rate.

- Among MLB pitchers who've thrown 500-or-more total pitches, Paddack has allowed the fourth-highest batting average (.352) to left-handed hitters.

THE ARSENAL: Has thrown a four-pitch mix through eight starts, per Baseball Savant...here are his pitch usage and results thus far in 2024:

His 4-seamer's 31.5 putaway percentage ranks fourth in baseball (min. 50 PA).

Included on American League Wild Card Series roster but didn't appear in two-game sweep of Toronto.

- Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.
In 2022, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.
In 2021, his third big league season, went 7-7 with 5.07 ERA...oblique and elbow injuries limited him to 108.1 innings...walk rate of 4.8% ranked in MLB's 95th percentile.
Made Postseason debut in 2020 NL Wild Card Series vs. St. Louis, surrendering six earned runs on eight hits in 2.1 innings...credited with loss in Game 1.
In 2020, made Opening Day start and earned win July 24 vs. Arizona...posted 4.73 ERA across 12 regular season outings...became seventh pitcher in San Diego franchise history with 200+ strikeouts in first 35 career starts.
As a rookie in 2019, posted career-bests in wins (9), ERA (3.33), innings (140.2) and strikeouts (153)...named to Baseball America's Major League All-Rookie Team.
Made major league debut March 31, 2019 vs. San Francisco, yielding one run on two hits and striking out seven in 5.0-inning no-decision.
