TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros look to even up their series with the Tigers tonight in the middle game of their three-game set in Houston...

THE HUNT IS ON: RHP Hunter Brown is returning tonight from a right shoulder strain which cost him over two months, 67 team games, and approximately 12 starts...

WELCOME BACK FRAMBER!: The Astros will face off against 2022 World Series Champion LHP Framber Valdez tonight in what is his first start against his former club...

PEANUTS NIGHT: Tonight is Peanuts Night at Daikin Park, which will be buzzing with Peanuts-themed activations, including playful photo opportunities and charming surprises...

TONIGHT'S RADIO BROADCAST: The Astros English radio broadcast for the Tigers series will feature Robert Ford and Kevin Eschenfelder, who's subbing for Steve Sparks.

LOS ASTROS: Space City Home Network will televise this series in English and Spanish with the Spanish broadcast being televised on SCHN2... Enrique Vasquez and Gene Flores will be on the call on the Spanish telecast this series.

PEN PALS: Since May 15, the Astros bullpen has a 2.73 ERA (32ER/105.2IP) with 99 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and a .189 opponent average...

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Astros have committed the fewest errors (29) in the AL and own the best fielding percentage (.989) in the AL...1B Christian Walker has led the way, as he has not committed an error in 72 games and 522 total chances.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros dropped their series opener with the Tigers last night by a score of 9-3...the Astros did all their damage in the 3rd on back-to-back homers by 3B Isaac Paredes and 2B Jose Altuve...

ASTROS ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have reinstated RHP Hunter Brown from the 60-day IL and C Yainer Diaz from the 10-day IL...

ALL-STAR VOTING UPDATE: Yesterday, MLB announced the first balloting update for the 2026 MLB All-Star Game, which revealed DH Yordan Alvarez as the AL's top vote-getter among all position players...

ON THE LEADERBOARD: DH Yordan Alvarez leads the Majors in OPS (1.087), SLG (.653) and total bases (173) and is tied for the Major League lead in home runs (24)...

ON-BASE MACHINE: OF Yordan Alvarez is on a 22-game on-base streak (dating back to May 22), in which he's batting .388 (31x80) with nine homers, 23 RBI, 15 walks, a .485 OBP and a 1.247 OPS...

SELECT COMPANY: Last night, DH Yordan Alvarez played in his 750th career game and went 2x4 to raise his career average to exactly .300...

THE LINEUP: The Astros have not repeated a lineup, using 74 different lineups in their 74 games...DH Yordan Alvarez has the most starts at any spot in the lineup among Astros, hitting second 62 times.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: 1B Christian Walker ranks third in the AL in RBI (52), behind only 1B Nick Kurtz (57) and DH Yordan Alvarez (54)...

SEÑOR CIEN: IF Isaac Paredes, who recently reached 500 career hits and 100 career homers, is one double shy of 100 career doubles...

ON THE MEND: RHP Cristian Javier is scheduled to start tonight for Triple A Sugar Land at Albuquerque (COL) in what will be his third minor league rehab start...

LAST REHAB START - 6/10 vs. SAC: Allowed 2 runs (1 ER) on 3 hits and 2 walks with 7 strikeouts in 5.0 innings...threw 78 total pitches, 49 for strikes.

LAST MLB START - 3/31 vs. BOS: Allowed 1 run on 1 hit with 2 walks and 8 strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

ON THE MEND: Was placed on the 15-day IL on April 2 with a right shoulder strain...was later transferred to the 60-day IL...made 4 rehab appearances with between Double A and Triple A...combined for a 1.88 ERA (3ER/14.1IP) with 21 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 0.77 WHIP and a .157 opponent average.

THE DIESEL: 2025 All-Star, Brown finished third in the AL in Cy Young voting last season after turning in the best year of his career with a 12-9 record, a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) and posting a 1.03 WHIP...the hard-throwing right-hander has pitched in parts of 5 big league seasons (2022-26), while going 37-31 with a 3.44 ERA (207ER/542IP) in 102 games (94 starts).

HISTORIC SEASON: In 2025, Brown held opponents to a career-low .201 average and posted 206 strikeouts in 185.1 innings pitched...his 2.43 ERA ranked 10th all-time among Astros starters and was the second-lowest by an Astros starter in the last 20 seasons (since 2005)...among AL starters, he ranked first in opponent SLG (.318) and second in ERA (2.43)...lastly, by reaching 206 strikeouts, he became the 18th pitcher in club history to reach 200 strikeouts in a season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU: By finishing third in the AL Cy Young voting in 2025, the Astros were granted a compensation pick immediately after the first round of the 2026 draft...the Astros earned the pick through the Prospect Promotion Incentive (PPI), which was ratified into the latest CBA...the PPI rewards teams for promoting their best prospects to the big leagues at the start of the season, having them accrue one full year of service time and then having them factor into a major award that season or prior to qualifying for arbitration.

MIXING IT UP: Has changed his repertoire over the course of his career, which resulted in a huge turnaround over the last 2 seasons...many coaches and teammates have worked with Brown, none more so than former teammate **Alex Bregman**, who suggested Brown incorporate a running sinker into his arsenal to keep right-handed hitters from leaning out over the plate... while the sinker does not grade out analytically as well as his other offerings, it compliments his offerings perfectly...prior to the change, Brown owned a 5.10 ERA in 41 games, since the change Brown has posted a 2.61 ERA (102ER/352.1 IP) in his last 60 appearance, since April 16, 2024.

FOLLOWING HIS FOOTSTEPS: Born and raised in Detroit, Brown went to grade school, high school and college in his hometown...he grew up a Tigers fan and a fan of Justin Verlander, who he modeled his pitching delivery after...Brown met Verlander as a fifth-grader at St. Isaac Jogues Catholic School in Saint Clair Shores, MI, a suburb of Detroit...Verlander, fellow Tiger **Carlos Guillén** and others visited the school as part of a radio promotion, won by one of Brown's classmates...the two later were teammates for three years (2022-24) and became close friends...now Brown is the Astros Opening Day starter, a position Verlander held for three seasons (2018-20).

AGAINST THE TIGERS: In 6 career regular season appearances, including 5 starts, he's recorded a 2.41 ERA (9ER/33.2IP) with 42 strikeouts, 10 walks, a 1.19 WHIP and a .242 opponent average...in his last start against the Tigers on Aug. 19, 2025, he tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing 5 hits and 3 walks with 6 strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/15 vs. DET): Allowed 1 run on 1 hit with 2 strikeouts in 1.0 inning last night vs. DET...allowed a solo home run to **Colt Keith**.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 3.00 ERA (5ER/15IP) in his last 17 appearances, dating back to May 3...within these appearances, he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the longest by an Astro this season.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has made 345 career appearances, recently passing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342g) for 6th in franchise history in relief appearances...now directly trails **LHP Joe Sambito** (348g) for 5th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (481) and 10th in innings pitched (354.0).

CAREER: In 345 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.92 ERA (115ER/354IP) with 481 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.23 K/9 and a 0.79 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.

STRONG STRETCH: Has posted a 2.25 ERA (9ER/36IP) and .169 opponent batting average (21x124) over a 22-appearance stretch dating back to April 16.

MULTI-INNING MAN: Leads AL relievers and ranks 2nd among MLB relievers with 46.2 innings pitched this season, behind only **WSH RHP Brad Lord** (48.0)...a starter throughout his MiLB career, he has 16 multi-inning outings among his 28 apps. this season.

CHANGING THINGS UP: Has tossed his changeup at a 20.4-percent rate...used his changeup at a 19.3-percent rate as a rookie in 2025...has held opponents to a .158 average (6x38) with his changeup this season.

INHERITANCE: Has stranded 12 of 13 inherited runners this season for a 7.7% inherited runners scored rate.

REVERSE SPLIT: Has held left-handed hitters to a .155 average (13x84) with 24 strikeouts this season.

DEBUT VS. DET: Made his MLB debut with a start vs. the Tigers on April 30, 2025, at Daikin Park...struck out 6 batters in 4.0 innings, with only 2 of the 7 runs allowed in the outing earned...the bulk of the Tigers' damage came on a grand slam from **Javier Báez**...following his debut, Blubaugh went on to go 3-0 with a 1.29 ERA (4ER/28IP) with 29 strikeouts and a .126 opponent average through his final 10 games (2 starts) of the season.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/13 at KC): Worked 0.1 of an inning on Sat. night allowed 2 runs on 2 hits and a walk, while being charged with his first blown save of the season...tossed 16 pitches (9 strikes) in the outing...also pitched on Fri. night, tossed 0.1 of an inning while allowing 3 runs on 3 hits on 27 pitches (20 strikes).

RUN OF SUCCESS: Prior to allowing 5 runs over the last 2 games, had been on a strong run over the last month and a half...from April 30 thru June 10, appeared in 17 games, recording a 1.42 ERA (3ER/19IP) with 20 strikeouts, 4 walks, a 0.74 WHIP and a .154 opponent batting average...within this span, went 7 straight scoreless appearances (8.2IP) from May 22-June 5, while allowing just 1 hit in that timeframe.

SAVE THE DAY: Has recorded 4 saves this season, already setting his single-season career high...prior to this year, had recorded 3 total saves through the first 7 seasons of his MLB career.

CHANGE OF PACE: Has used his changeup at a 24.9-percent rate so far this season, with opponents going 5x31 (.161) vs. the pitch...would mark his most usage for the pitch since his rookie season in 2018 (25.1).

INHERITANCE: Has stranded 10 of his 12 inherited runners this season and his 16.7% inherited runners scored rate ranks T-10th among qualified AL relievers.

VS. DET: Has posted a 2.04 ERA (4ER/17.2IP) with 17 strikeouts, a .200 opponent batting average and a 0.91 WHIP in 17 career appearances vs. DET...are the most career appearances vs. the Tigers among current Astros pitchers, with **RHP Bryan Abreu** (11) next-closest.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/12 at KC): Picked up his 2nd save of the season on Fri. night after he tossed a scoreless 9th inning...faced 3 hitters in the 9th, retiring the side on 20 pitches (15 strikes).

MILESTONE MARKERS: Friday's save gave him 229 for his career which moved him past Hall of Famer RHP Hoyt Wilhelm (228 saves) and into a tie with RHP Joakim Soria for No. 44 on MLB's all-time saves list...is also 40 strikeouts from matching LHP Sparky Lyle (873 SO) for the 9th-most by a left-handed reliever in MLB history (since at least 1900).

DOMINANT RETURN: Has made 5 scoreless appearances since being reinstated from the IL on June 2...has not allowed a hit, while striking out 7 and walking just 1 in his 5.0 innings of work...is 2-for-2 in save chances and has already picked up a win on the season.

THE WAY BACK: Missed the Astros first 61 games of the season due to left biceps tendinitis...made 9 rehab appearances between Triple A Sugar Land (4g) and Double A Corpus Christi (5g)...combined for a 4.15 ERA (4ER/8.2IP) with 11 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 1.27 WHIP and a .242 opponent batting average.

2025 RECAP: Was selected to his 6th All-Star Game in 2025...posted a 2.05 ERA (12ER/52.2IP) with 76 strikeouts, 29 saves, a 0.85 WHIP, a .158 opponent batting average and a 12.99 SO/9IP in 48 appearances...missed the final 44 games of the season due to a left shoulder capsule sprain...marked the first time in his career he'd been placed on the 15-day IL due to an injury...prior to this IL stint, he had only been placed on the 10-day COVID IL in 2021.
