RHP Festa recalled from AAA TWINSPRESSBOX.COM THE TWINS: After going 2-4 on their six-game homestand last week (1-2 vs. Toronto, 1-2 vs. Texas), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with consecutive losses in Houston...today, the Twins will continue the trip with the three-game series finale at Daikin Park...after today's game, Minnesota will fly to Cincinnati to enjoy an off-day tomorrow,then play three games against the Reds at Great American Ball Park from Tuesday-Thursday.

◆ Iwins are 29-19 in their last 48 games since April 22, tied with New York-NL (29-19), Houston (29-19), Chicago-NL (29-18) and Tampa Bay (29-19) for the second most wins in baseball since that date, and trailing only Detroit (32-17).

◆ Twins have lost three-straight and looking to avoid losing their fourth for the first time since April 29-May 2 (also 4).

TWINS WALKED-OFF IN HOUSTON: The Twins lost to the Astros yesterday at Daikin Park by a score of 3-2, suffering their fifth walk-off defeat of the season...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on two hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...his only runs allowed came off a Yainer Diaz two-run homer in the third inning...the offense recorded three hits, walked twice and struck out a season-high 17 times...Brooks Lee provided the runs for Minnesota, hitting a two-run homer in the fifth inning.

TWINS LOSE LEWIS: The Twins have placed infielder Royce Lewis on the 10-day Injured List with a left hamstring strain, an injury he sustained on Friday night in the ninth inning, running to first base on a single...Lewis hit .202 (20-for-99) with four doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, 11 walks, 10 runs scored and a .585 OPS in 30 games for the Twins...this is his second stint on the Injured List this season, after missing the first 34 games of the year with the same injury...to replace Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder DaShawn Keirsey Jr. from Triple-A St. Paul...Keirsey Jr. hit .231 (9-for-39) with four doubles, four RBI, two walks, one stolen base, five runs scored and a .619 OPS in 10 games for the Saints after being optioned there on May 31...the 28-year-old was on the Twins 2025 Opening Day roster and went 7-for-64 with one home run, four RBI, one walk, five stolen bases and six runs scored in 45 games between March 27-May 30.

NORTH STARS TO LONE STARS: The Twins and Astros are playing the sixth and final game of 2025.

♣ After today, Houston will be one of two AL teams the Twins are done playing in 2025 (also Baltimore).

♣ Twins have lost three-straight to the Astros...their only win this season was on April 5 at Target Field...it marks their longest losing streak to Houston since dropping six-straight during the 2022 season.

♣ Ty France is hitting .327 (87-for-266) with 12 doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBI, a .391 on-base percentage and an .876 OPS in 73 career games against the Astros...87 hits are his most against any opponent...73 games are also his most.

♣ Brooks Lee is hitting .400 (8-for-20) with one double, two home runs, six RBI and a 1.150 OPS in five career games vs. Houston...he has hit safely in all five.

PARDON MY FRENCH: Ty France went 0-for-3 yesterday afternoon, snapping his on-base streak at 24 games...the streak remains tied for the ninth-longest in baseball this season... over his last 25 games, he is hitting .309 (29-for-94) with three doubles, two home runs, 16 RBI and a .369 on-base percentage.

◆ In 13 games this month, France is hitting .340 (17-for-50) with an .849 OPS...his batting average ranks ninth in the AL.

DON'T STOP BE-LEE-VING: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 14-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and the longest active streak in baseball...Winnesota's last streak as long was from Carlos Correa, who hit in 16-straight from June 26-September 18, 2024.

**During the current streak, Lee is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with two doubles, two home runs, nine RBI and an .809 OPS.

WILLMATIC: In his last 25 games, Willi Castro is hitting .349 (29-for-83) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs, 12 RBI, 11 walks, 17 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .432 on-base percentage, a .639 slugging percentage and a 1.070 OPS.

◆ In his last nine road games, since May 30, he is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with five home runs, seven RBI, an .824 slugging percentage and a 1.274 OPS...since that date, he ranks tied for second in baseball in road homers with Pete Alonso and trailing Aaron Judge (6)... and his .824 slugging percentage ranks eighth.

BREAKING BROOMS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the third time this season...the other two were in three games at St. Louis to open 2025, from March 27-30, and April 18-20 at Atlanta...other than those two sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale and avoided a sweep twice this season: April 13 vs. Detroit and June 8 vs. Toronto.

◆ The last time the Twins were swept by the Astros was in three games from August 23-25, 2022 at Daikin Park.

SOUTHPAW STORIES: Today marks the 12th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 5-6 against lefty starters...they lost their last two games started by left-handers: May 25 vs. Kansas City (Kris Bubic) and June 12 vs. Texas (Patrick Corbin)... their last win was on May 23 vs. Kansas City, a game started by Noah Cameron.

*Since April 19, Twins are slashing. 259/.337/.408 (.744 OPS) against lefties...prior to that stretch, they slashed .157/.222/.289 (.511 OPS) vs. lefties.

*Notable individuals since April 19 vs. LHP: Willi Castro is hitting .351 (13-for-37)...Byron Buxton is hitting .393 (11-for-28).

*Correa is hitting .393 (11-for-45) with three doubles, four home runs, a .622 slugging percentage and a .941 OPS vs. lefties this season...four of his five homers are off lefties.

*Buxton is hitting .306 (11-for-36) with a .937 OPS against left-handed pitchers this season.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: High-A Fort Myers left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill and Dominican Summer League Twins infielder Haritzon Castillo have been named Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

Hill, 19, made the start for the Mighty Mussels against Palm Beach, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts...Hill, who is the repeat winner from last week, was selected by the Twins in the second round (69th overall) of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Grapevine High School in Grapevine, Texas.

Castillo, 17, played in four games for the DSL Twins, hitting .500 (6-for-12) with one double, two triples, four RBI, four walks, four runs scored and a 1.542 OPS...the Barquisimeto, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January.

HAPPY PLOUFFE DAY: Trevor Plouffe is celebrating his 39th birthday today...Plouffe is one of two players in Twins history (1961-present) with a multi-homer game on his birthday, the other being Justin Morneau (who did it twice, in 2007 & 2009).

WHO'S YOUR DADDY: Twins are 35-31 on Father's Day (since 1961)...last season, they played a doubleheader on Father's Day and won both games against the A's by scores of 6-2 and 8-7 at Target Field.

LAST START: Last pitched on June 10 vs. Texas, opposite Tyler Mahle, taking his third loss of the season in Minnesota's 16-4 defeat...allowed a season-high seven runs (6 ER) on eight hits, with three walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...threw three scoreless innings before allowing an RBI double to Adolis García, scoring Jake Burger (unearned) and an RBI single to Kyle Higashioka in the fourth, followed by a two-run RBI single to Josh Jung in the fifth...then permitted a double to García before being replaced by Justin Topa who subsequently allowed a two-run RBI double to Higashioka, both

- and replaced by Justin Topa who subsequently anowed a two-full KBI double to Higashioka, both is retroactively charged to Woods Richardson.

 ◆ Threw a wild pitch in the fourth and fifth innings...first career game with two wild pitches.

 ◆ Was his first time with zero home runs allowed in a major league game since first start of 2025 on April 1 at Chicago-AL...snapped career-long streak of seven-straight games with a homer... was one of just five pitchers to have such a streak in 2025.

TWO STARTS AGO IN THE MAJORS: Pitched on May 14 in Game 2 of the doubleheader at Baltimore, opposite Chayce McDermott...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-6 victory...allowed six runs off a career-high-tying eight hits (career-high-tying 2 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts

a 4.0 in a categor-light-lying eight litts (categor-light-lying 2 Hk), with two wans and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work.
 a All six runs allowed in the game came in the third inning...permitted an RBI single to Gunnar Henderson, then a grand slam from Cedric Mullins (second career grand slam allowed, also 6/14/24 vs. the Athletics), followed by a home run from Heston Kjerstad...allowed back-to-back home runs for the first time time in his MLB career.

THIS AHN'T IS TEXAS: Woods Richardson grew up in Sugar Land, TX as an Astros fan - one of his childhood birthday parties was on the outfield upper deck at then-Minute Maid Park...he started for the Twins on June 2, 2024 in Houston and had a large contingent of family and friends in the stands that day, including his parents, youth coaches, teachers, etc....his mom, Wendy Blair-Woods, was on the broadcast and he allowed a home run while she was being interviewed.

AGAINST THE ASTROS: SWR has no record and a 4.35 ERA in two career starts against Houston (both AGAINST THE ASTROS: SWR has no record and a 4.35 LRA in two career starts against Houston (both in 2024); Twins are 2-0 in those starts...has allowed five runs on six hits, four walks, 10 strikeouts and a .167 (6-for-36) opponent batting average...started on June 2, 2024 at Daikin Park, allowing three runs on thee hits (2 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts in 4.1 innings; Twins won, 4-3.
♣ His career .167 opponent batting average is his lowest among opponents he has faced at least twice, and third lowest all time, behind the Mariners (.053) and the Phillies (.158).
♣ In his last start vs. the Astros on July 7, 2024 at Target Field, SWR did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 victory...allowed two runs on three hits, with two walks and four strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings...retired the last 13 batters he faced.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Woods Richardson has gone 3-3 with a 4.62 ERA (87.2 IP, 45 ER), 8.62 K/9, 3.29 BB/9 and 1.13 HR/9 in 18 games (17 starts) at home compared to 4-6 with a 4.68 ERA (98.0 IP, 51 ER), 7.35 K/9, 3.49 BB/9 and 1.38 HR/9 in 21 road games (20 starts). **SWR** is 0-2 in five road games (4 starts) this season, posting a 6.75 ERA (22.2 IP, 17 ER) with

13 walks and 22 strikeouts...has allowed a home run in his last four road starts.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through nine major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .354/.422/.557 in 79 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .258/.324/.4441 in 93 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 88.5 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 41.8 compared to righties' 94.0 mph and 53.7 percent.

This whiff rate is at an all-time high of 24.0 percent (lefties, 21.1 percent; righties, 26.0 percent)... compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:
