THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 14
2017 - The Astros spoil **Derek Jeter** Night at Yankee Stadium, erupting for six runs in the 1st inning off **RHP Masahiro Tanaka** en route to a 10-7 win on national TV...**3B Alex Bregman** hits his first career grand slam in the big 1st inning...the win gave Houston a split in what was a Mother's Day doubleheader.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros will continue their seven-game homestand today as they look to earn a four-game series split with a win against the rival Seattle Mariners...Astros starter **RHP Mike Burrows**, who tossed 7.0 shutout innings his last time out, will oppose **RHP Luis Castillo** and the Mariners in this series finale.

ABOUT BURROWS: **RHP Mike Burrows** owns a 2.50 ERA (5ER/18IP) in his last three starts and is coming off the best start of his young career on Friday at CIN (0ER/7IP)...Burrows is acclimating himself to the AL West, as he was acquired from the Pirates this offseason as part of a three-team, six-player trade in which the Astros sent **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays, while the Rays sent **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates.

ROCK CLIMBING: The Astros are facing **RHP Luis Castillo** for the 11th time in his career today and for the second time this season, with the first coming on April 11 in Seattle when the Astros tagged him for seven runs on 3.1 innings...**DH Yordan Alvarez** took Castillo deep in that game and now has three career home runs and a lifetime .474 (9x19) average off the three-time All-Star.

VS. SEATTLE: The Astros and Mariners are playing their second series of 2026 and after today will not see each other again until August...with a win last night, the Astros snapped a nine-game losing streak to Seattle, which spanned back to 2025.

ON THE RADIO: Today's Astros radio broadcast on SportsTalk 790 will feature **Robert Ford** and **Kevin Eschenfelder**...the Spanish broadcast can be heard on TUDN 102.9 FM with **Francisco Romero** and **Alex Treviño** on the call.

ABOUT THE SKIPPER: Manager **Joe Espada** recorded his 192nd career managerial victory last night, which moved him past **Harry Craft** (1962-64) into 12th in club history...he now immediately trails **Jim Williams** (215) for 11th on that all-time list.

GIVING BACK: In honor of the recent passings of **Phil Garner** and **René Cárdenas**, a \$5,000 donation in each of their names will be made from today's Share2Care 50/50 Raffle to **Spring Spirit**, the Charity of the Game...Spring Spirit is a Houston-based NPO dedicated to empowering youth to realize their full potential through comprehensive education, sports, and ministry programs.

LAST NIGHT'S WALKOFF: The Astros picked up their first walkoff win of the year last night in a 4-3, 10-inning win over the Mariners...**LF Zach Cole** (3x4) was the hero, as he singled home the winning run...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (2ER/5.1IP) had a solid start, while **RHP Bryan Abreu** (0ER/1IP) pitched a scoreless 10th en route to the win.

LANCE REACHES 900 K'S: **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** surpassed 900 career strikeouts last night as he fanned six in his 5.1 innings pitched...McCullers became the 15th player in franchise history to reach 900 strikeouts and the quickest to do so in terms of appearances (154g).

TOMORROW'S FASHION SHOW: The annual Astros Foundation's Champions for Healthy Families Luncheon & Fashion Show will take place tomorrow beginning at 11 a.m. in Union Station at Daikin Park...the models of the fashion show will be wives and girlfriends of Astros players and coaches...the goal of the event is to impact and promote healthy families in support the Astros Foundation and a variety of local nonprofits...media wishing to cover the event must RSVP with **Rachel Caton** at rcaton@astros.com.

THE ORDER: The Astros have used 44 different lineups in their 44 games in 2026...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (hitting second), while **1B Christian Walker** has played in every game (43 starts).

AIR YORDAN: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is batting .309 (50x162) with 10 doubles, 13 HR, 29 RBI and a 1.029 OPS (.418 OBP/.611 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks first in total bases (99), tied for first in extra-base hits (23), second in OPS, tied for third in hits, tied for third in RBI, fourth in SLG, fourth in batting average, fourth in OBP and tied for fourth in homers.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has 355 career extra-base hits, which ties him with **3B Doug Rader** for 10th in extra-base hits in Astros franchise history...the two immediately trail **1B Bob Watson** (410) for ninth on that all-time list.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: With two RBI last night **2B Jose Altuve** reached 900 career RBI, making him the fifth player in franchise history to reach that mark...he also checks in with 238 career homers as a second baseman, needing one more to tie **Lou Whitaker** for seventh place all-time in MLB history among second basemen.

THE SHEW FITS: **SS Braden Shewmake** went 2x5 last night, which extended his current hitting streak to a career-long eight games...Shewmake has hit .364 (12x33) with three homers and a 1.000 OPS in 13 games since being acquired by the Astros in a trade from the Yankees on April 19.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** is hitting .296 (24x81) in his last 21 games (since April 20) with six homers and 13 RBI...among AL players this season, Walker ranks tied for third in RBI (29), sixth in extra-base hits (20), seventh in total bases (84), and seventh in SLG (.525).

GUN 'EM DOWN: In just 21 games, **C Christian Vázquez** has thrown out nine baserunners attempting to steal (in 25 attempts), which ranks tied for first in the AL and fourth in the Majors.

LAST START, MAY 8 AT CIN: Allowed 3 hits and 1 walk with 6 strikeouts in 7.0 scoreless innings...set a single-game career-high in innings (7.0)...was also his first scoreless outing since Sept. 21, 2025 vs. ATH, where tossed 4.0 scoreless innings...has also tossed consecutive quality starts for the second time in his career, also from July 25-30, 2025 with those starts coming at San Francisco and vs. Arizona.

ABOUT BURROWS: The 2nd-year starter is making his 9th start of the season after opening the year as the Astros No. 2 starter...leads the Astros in innings pitched (44.2) and is tied with **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** in starts (8)...also ranks 2nd in strikeouts with 42 behind only **McCullers Jr.** (43).

HIS REPERTOIRE: Has thrown his changeup at a 25.9% rate this year, throwing the pitch 190 times this season, compared to 207 four-seam fastballs (28.2%)...is holding opponents to a .200 (9x45) opponent average on the changeup this season...opponents are also hitting just .143 (3x21) vs. his curveball, which he's thrown at a 15.1% rate.

SPINNIN' IT: Has averaged a spin rate of 2920 RPM this season on his curveball, which ranks in the 93rd percentile and 9th overall among MLB pitchers.

CONNECTICUT CONNECTION: Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from Connecticut...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).

THE JOURNEY: a native of Waterford, CT, Burrows was committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...the Pirates selected him in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft and signed him to an over-slot bonus to sign and forego his commitment to UConn...spent 6 seasons (2018-23) in the Pirates minor league system before finally debuting in 2024 with a single appearance...pitched the majority of the 2025 season at the Major League level and flashed potential before the Pirates flipped him to Houston this offseason.

THE TRADE: After spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates organization, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a 3-team, 6-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

2025 RECAP: Pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed 1-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97).

LAST APPEARANCE (5/13 vs. SEA): Earned his 2nd win of the season last night vs. SEA after he allowed 1 walk and struck out 1 in 1.0 scoreless inning.

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA (1ER/6.1IP) in his last 6 games dating back to April 24...prior to this hot streak, posted a 14.73 ERA (12ER/7.1IP) in his first 9 games of the season.

VS. SEA: Has struck out 53 batters through 37.1 innings in 35 career appearances vs. the Mariners, holding an impressive 12.78 SO/9IP with a 3.38 ERA (14ER/367.1IP)...has the most strikeouts among active relievers against Seattle with 53...has held **C Cal Raleigh** to a 2x10 mark with 6 strikeouts in their career matchups.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...currently has 343.1 IP, with **RHP Xavier Hernandez** next on the all-time list at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (469) and 7th in apps. (332).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Is 1.0 inning from matching **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for the 4th-most innings pitched by a reliever in Daikin Park history...is also 3 strikeouts from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

CAREER: In 332 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.88 ERA (110ER/343.1P) with 469 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP, 12.29 -K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
