CLEVELAND GUARDIANS (16-16) at Athletics (17-14) #54 LHP Joey Cantillo (1-1, 2.97) vs. #35 RHP J.T. Ginn (0-0, 3.24)

DeLAUTER STINGS THE RAYS, GUARDS WIN 3-1

» Cleveland snapped a 4-game skid, avoiding the sweep with a 3-1 win on Wednesday afternoon over Tampa Bay at Progressive Field.
» **1B KYLE MANZARDO** (0-for-3, RBI, SF) gave Cleveland a 1-0 lead with a sacrifice fly in the 3rd inning...**RF CHASE DeLAUTER** (2-for-3, 2RBI, BB) broke the game open for Cleveland, extending the lead, 3-0, with a 2-run single in the 5th inning.
» **RHP GAVIN WILLIAMS** (W, 7.2IP, 5H, 1R/0ER, 0BB, 9SO, 95 pitches/71 strikes) earned the win, working his 3rd quality start of the season, striking out 9 over 7.2 innings of work...his only mark on the day was a run that scored due to a throwing error from **TRAVIS BAZZANA** in the 7th...was relieved by **ERIK SABROWSKI** (0.1IP, 1SO) after allowing back-to-back singles with 2 outs in the 8th, Sabrowski would escape the jam unscathed with a strikeout with runners on 2nd and 3rd...**RHP CADE SMITH** (1.0IP, 2SO) locked down the win in the 9th for his 7th save of the year.

SHOWDOWN IN SACTOWN

» The Cleveland Guardians head out to West Sacramento for a 3-game homestand against the Athletics from Friday-Sunday... Cleveland has won each of the last 4 season series between these two clubs, marking the first time that the Guardians have claimed 4-straight season sets over the A's since 1950-56 (7-straight)... since the start of the 2022 season, the Clevelanders are 21-5 (.808) against the Athletics, the 3rd-best record by a team against any single opponent (min. 20G), trailing a of 24-5 (.828) record by the Yankees against the Royals, along with a 24-5 (.828) record by Orioles against the Royals...during that stretch, the Guards have outscored the Athletics 155-100(+55), plating 6-or-more runs in 16 of those 26 contests...since 1901, the Clevelanders are 1,058-927 (.533) all-time vs. the Athletics.

» Since the start of 2022, **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** has tortured the green and yellow, owning a .340 (34-for-100) batting average with 19 extra-base hits (10 doubles, 4 triples, 5 home runs), 22 RBI and 1.081 OPS in 25 games vs. the A's...**STEVEN KWAN** - a Bay Area native - has hit safely in 20 of 21 career games against the Athletics since the start of 2022, owning a .387 (36-for-93) batting average with 10 doubles, one home run and 9 RBI.

» **STEPHEN VOGT** spent a majority of his playing career with the Athletics, playing for the club from 2013-17 and 2022, making the American League All-Star team in 2015 and 2016.

SACRAMENTO TIES

» **RHYS HOSKINS** calls Sacramento home in the offseason and will be playing in his hometown for the first time in his career as a pro - attended Sacramento State University...Bench Coach **TONY ARNERICH** grew up in Santa Rosa and played at Santa Rosa Junior College for two years before transferring to Texas Tech... he returned to the area in 2006 as an assistant coach at Sonoma State University...Field Coordinator **ANDY MCKAY** was the head baseball coach at Sacramento City College for 14 seasons from 1999-2012.

RUN IT UP! COUNT IT UP...

» Since the start of last season, games at Sutter Health Park have yielded an average of 10.16 combined runs per game the 3rd-highest mark in MLB, behind Nationals Park (10.17) and Coors Field (11.44)...on the contrary, games at Progressive has witness 7.77 combined runs per game since the start of 2025, 2nd-fewest in MLB, ahead of only Globe Life Field (6.86).

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS

» Over the last 5 seasons, the Guardians are 74-61 (.548) in the month of May, and the club has posted a winning record in May in 3 of their last 5 seasons and 8 of 12 since snapping a 5-year Postseason drought in 2013...during this span, the Guards were at-or-below .500 at the end of April 3 times (2021, 12-12; 2022, 9-12; 2023, 13-15) and finished with a winning record just once (2022, 92-70, AL Central Champs)...the table below shows how the Guardians have performed in May since 2021:

'PEN PALS

» Over the past 7 games, the Guardians bullpen has posted a 1.35 ERA (3ER/20.0IP), which is the best mark in MLB since April 22... during that same stretch, the bullpen leads MLB in hits allowed (12), opponent batting average (.167), opponent on-base percentage (.231), opponent slugging percentage (.236) and opponent OPS (.461), while ranking 2nd with a 0.90 WHIP.

THE DUKE OF CLEVELAND

» With 2 hits on Wednesday, **CHASE DeLAUTER** extended his on-base streak to a career-high-tying 9 games (also: 4/3-12/26)... despite not homering since April 3, DeLauter is batting .313 (10-for-32) with one double, one triple, 6 RBI and a .795 OPS during the streak...DeLauter has recorded 26 hits through March and April, the most by a Cleveland rookie through March and April in club history, ahead of **Joe Sewell** in 1921 (24H).

THE ULTIMATE UTILITY MAN

» **DANIEL SCHNEEMANN** extended his career-high on-base streak to 15 games with his multi-extra-base hit performance on Wednesday...the 15-game run is the longest by a Guardians hitter this season and tied for the longest by a Clevelander since **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** reached base in 15-straight games from Sept. 14, 2025-March 26, 2026...since the streak began on April 11, Schneemann is batting .400 (20-for-50) with 3 doubles, 4 home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.192 OPS during this span...during this run, he's made six appearances at third base, five in center field, five at second base and one at shortstop...over his last 15 games, he has raised his average from .200 to a team-leading .321...after finishing with a .206 (78-for-379) batting average in 2025, his 115-point jump to .321 is the largest year-to-year increase among MLB players (min. 50PA).

THE JOSÉ REPORT

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** is one steal shy of 300 career stolen bases...he will join Hans Lobert (316) and Chone Figgins (341) as the only third basemen in MLB history to steal 300+ bases...for more info on where Ramirez stands in franchise history, visit the milestone tracker on the last page of the game notes.

YES WE CAN-TILLO

» The 6-4 left-hander is making his seventh start of the season and fourth start on the road tonight in the opener of this 3-game set against the Athletics at Sutter Health Park.

» Tonight marks his first start vs. the A's...is making this start on 5 days' rest after making the start on April 25 at Toronto... owns a 2-4 record with a 2.68 ERA (15ER/50.1IP) in 9 career starts on 5 days' rest.

» Since joining the Guardians rotation on July 3, 2025, Cantillo is 5-4 with a 2.96 ERA (32ER/97.1IP) and a .223 (80-for-359) opposing batting average...earned AL Rookie of the Month honors for September last season, going 2-0 with a 1.55 ERA (5ER/29.0IP) across his 5 September starts.

» He's one of eight left-handed starters in MLB with a sub-3.00 ERA since the start of 2025 (min. 75.0IP).

LAST TIME OUT

» Suffered his first loss of the season on Saturday at Toronto, yielding 3 runs (one earned) on a season-high 6 hits (1HR) with 4 strikeouts and one walk over 5.0 innings...hurled 3.0-scoreless innings prior to a solo blast from Kazuma Okamoto to lead-off the 4th inning...Cantillo tossed a clean 5th before surrendering consecutive hits to Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and Kazuma Okamoto to start the 6th...**MATT FESTI** would replace Cantillo, and allow both the inherited runners to score...Cleveland was unable to mount a comeback, ultimately falling, 5-3.

CREATING CHAOS ON THE CAUSEWAY

» Tonight marks Cantillo's first career start/appearance against the Athletics and his 6th career appearance (5GS) against the AL West.

» The southpaw is 0-1 with a 4.66 ERA (10ER/19.1IP) with 29 strikeouts in 5 career appearances against the division...has allowed at least 2-or-more runs (earned) in all 4 starts against the AL West...AL West opponents are hitting .240 (18-for-75) against Cantillo.

SWINGING AT AIR MOLECULES

» Cantillo has produced a 58.1% strikeout rate on his changeup this season, the best mark in all of MLB (min. 85 P)...18 of his 34 strikeouts this season have come via his changeup, and his 46.8% whiff rate on the pitch ranks 5th-highest in MLB.
» The lefty has held opposing hitters to a .138 (4-for-29) clip on the pitch, 6th-lowest in the American League and 8th-lowest in MLB (min. 25 PAs).

LEAVING 'EM STRANDED

» The southpaw has held his opposition to a .111 (3-for-27) clip with runners in scoring position, the lowest mark in the American League, and T4th-lowest mark in MLB with PIT's Braxton Ashcraft, trailing NYM's Freddy Peralta (.107), PIT's Yohan Ramirez (.091) and SD's Michael King (.080).
» Since joining the Guardians rotation on July 3, 2025, Cantillo has held opposing hitters to a .139 (10-for-72) average with runners in scoring position (min. 75BF w/RISP), the 3rd-lowest mark in MLB, trailing NYM's Freddy Peralta (.101) and teammate **GAVIN WILLIAMS** (.086)...has allowed multiple hits with RISP in just one of his 18 starts over that stretch and 0 hits with RISP in 10 of those starts...only 4 of the 10 hits he's surrendered with RISP over this stretch have gone for extra bases.

STARTING OFF STRONG

» Cantillo has held his opposition to a .167 (10-for-60) clip with a .598 OPS in the first 3 innings of his starts, compared to a .333 (17-for-51) clip with a .924 OPS in innings 4-6.
» Last season, opposing batters were held to a .210 (30-for-143) clip in innings 1-3 compared to a .226 (48-for-212) clip when he pitched in innings 4-9.
