RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a six-game, six-day Midwest road trip through Chicago (0-1, 2 to play) and Milwaukee (3 to play) tonight on the South Side...the Rays are 0-2-1 in their last three series after winning three straight from April 5-14...they have lost four of their last five games and are 5-8 since April 13 on the heels of a 5-1 run...they have remained within two games of .500 each day since the beginning of the season.

- Last night's 9-4 loss dropped the Rays to 1-8 in series openers, including 0-4 on the road...the 1-8 record is tied for second worst in the majors, ahead of only the winless Marlins (0-9)...the Rays drew a season-high-tying seven walks (also April 16 vs. LAA), but stranded a season-high 12 runners on the basepaths, matching their most in any game all of last season (3x, last: Sept. 11 at MIN).
- Tampa Bay has not scored first in its last five games since April 21 at NYY, its longest streak of the season...it has lost five of its last six contests when yielding the opening tally and won eight of its last 11 when scoring first.
- The Rays have trailed at some point in every game during their current 1-4 skid...they overcame a two-run deficit in the lone win on April 24 vs. DET.
- In their last six night games, the Rays are 1-5 following a 6-3 start to the season.
- Tampa Bay will be opposed by rookie RHP **Jonathan Cannon**, who is scheduled for his third career start...this marks the third instance of the Rays facing a rookie starter, having gone 1-1 thus far (April 12 vs. SF - Winn; April 21 at NYY - Gil)...they went 18-12 against rookie starters in 2023.
- The Rays need a win tonight to avoid falling to 0-3-1 in their last four sets, which would mark their longest streak of winless series since June 12-25, 2023 (0-1-3)...a loss would also send them multiple games below .500 for the first time since April 5 (3-5).
- Kevin Cash** (752) remains three victories shy of surpassing **Joe Maddon** (754) as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader.

RISP MANAGEMENT—The Rays rank ninth in the AL/tied for 19th in the majors with a .241 average with runners in scoring position...after going 2-for-13 (.154) last night, they are hitting just .161 (15-for-93) with RISP over their last 11 games since April 15, third worst in the AL over that span, better than only the Athletics (.132) and Red Sox (.159)...Tampa Bay has hit .324 (36-for-111) with RISP in wins compared to .149 (15-for-101) in losses.

Isaac Paredes has been the Rays most prolific hitter in scoring situations, batting .348 (8-for-23)...however, he is 0-for-5 with RISP in his last six games.

WHAT'S THE DIFF?—At -29, the Rays run differential is 12th in the AL/25th in the majors...it signals their worst mark through 27 games since 2007 (-43)...the last time they had a lower run differential at any point in a season was April 20, 2018 (-31)...they have trailed by multiple runs at some point in eight of 11 and nine of their last 13 games...on the season, they are 11-0 in games in which they held a multi-run lead at any point.

- Last night's 9-4 setback marked their seventh defeat by 5+ runs, tied for third most in the majors behind the Astros and White Sox (both 8)...last season, the Rays didn't record their seventh 5+ run loss until their 105th game (July 26 vs. MIA).
- The Rays have yet to outscore an opponent over the course of a series...they came closest in Colorado from April 5-7, when both clubs pushed across 18 runs.
- In innings 1-3, the Rays own a +8 (35-27) run differential...however, they have posted a -37 (109-72) mark from the 4th inning on...their six blown lead losses are tied for fourth most in the AL behind the Astros (10), Red Sox and White Sox (both 8).
- They have been outscored, 27-10 (-17), in the 6th inning, their worst mark in any frame...among AL clubs, only two teams have recorded worse differentials in an individual inning, according to Elias: the White Sox in the 7th (-24) and the Athletics in the 4th (-19).

POWER OUTAGE—Rays hitters rank fifth in the AL in batting average (.244) and lead the league in singles (T1st w/ HOU, 163) and infield singles (36) while ranking third in opposite-field hits (57) behind the Yankees (61) and Red Sox (58)...however, their .360 SLG ranks 11th in the AL and their 59 extra-base hits are 13th, more than only the Mariners (58) and White Sox (54)...the 59 XBH are the second fewest through the first 27 games of a season in franchise history—the 2004 squad had 58...the Rays .665 OPS is third worst in such a span, besting only the 2001 (.641) and 2002 (.639) Devil Rays.

- Tampa Bay hitters have recorded MLB's second-lowest pull rate at 33.7 pct., ahead of only the Blue Jays (33.0%) and down from 38.8 pct. in 2023...they also own the second-lowest barrel rate (5.9%), better than only the White Sox (5.7%).
- The Rays have been held to four runs or fewer in 18 of their 27 games (66.7%), going 5-13 in those contests and 8-1 when plating 5+ runs...for comparison, they scored four or fewer times in 76 of 162 (46.9%) games in 2023.

GONE FISHIN'—Rays hitters own the highest chase rate in the AL (32.0%), ranking third behind the Marlins (34.4%) and Rockies (32.4%) in all of MLB...their 56 hits on pitches out of the zone lead the majors...part of their aggressiveness could be attributed to their 95 called strikes on pitches outside of Statcast's strike zone, sixth most in MLB...**Isaac Paredes** (15), **José Caballero** (14) and **Yandy Díaz** (14) have been affected the most by such pitches—all three have posted career highs in chase rate.

Of the Rays 242 strikeouts, 111 (45.9%) have come when chasing pitches out of the zone, the second-highest rate in the AL behind the Mariners (50.5%).

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—Rays pitching has allowed 37 HR, tied with the Blue Jays for second most in the majors behind the White Sox (38)...the Rays are 6-13 when allowing at least 1 HR, including five straight losses, and 7-1 with 0 HR...on the season, 59 of the 136 (43.4%) runs allowed by Rays pitching have come off the 37 HR.

- Despite recording the third-fewest HR in the AL on the season (22), Rays hitters have 4 HR in their last four games...this comes on the heels of tallying 3 HR in their previous six contests.
- Rays hitters have posted the AL's highest ground ball rate (45.1%) and lowest fly ball rate (22.5%)...meanwhile, Rays pitching owns a major league-low 36.5 pct. ground ball percentage and the fourth-highest fly ball rate (29.1%).

SUNSHINE IN THE WINDY CITY—The Rays and White Sox continue a six-game season series tonight on the South Side, with all six games being played over the course of 13 days...the White Sox will visit Tropicana Field for a three-game set from May 6-8 in the middle of the Rays nine-game homestand...the Rays went 6-1 against the Sox in 2023, winning each of the first six matchups before a 12-9 defeat on April 30.

- The Rays have won four of their last six games at Guaranteed Rate Field since April 17, 2022...they have scored 9+ times in four of those contests, averaging 8.5 runs per game in that span.
- Yandy Díaz** is batting .455 (20-for-44) with 5 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI and 16 BB against 5 SO during his 15-game on-base streak against Chicago, which began on Aug. 21, 2021.

CONNECTIONS

- White Sox Bench Coach **Charlie Montoyo** spent 22 seasons in the Rays organization, including four on **Kevin Cash's** staff as third base coach (2015-17) and bench coach (2018), before departing to manage the Blue Jays in 2019.
- Chicago 1B/OF Coach **Jason Bourgeois** played for Chicago (6G, 2008) and Tampa Bay (9G, 2013) during his eight-year ML career.
- White Sox ML Coach **Grady Sizemore** appeared in 58 games with the Rays in 2015 to conclude his major league career.
- White Sox Assistant Hitting Coach **Mike Tosas** began his professional coaching career as a hitting coach with Tampa Bay...worked with the Gulf Coast League Devil Rays in 1996 and Rookie-level Princeton from 1997-99.
- Rays Senior Advisor, Player Development & Baseball Operations **Mitch Lukevics** was a second-round selection by the White Sox in 1975 and worked in the Chicago farm system as a pitching coach (1981-85) and minor league administrator (1986-88).
- Rays RHP **Chris Devenski** was drafted by the White Sox in 2011 before they dealt him to the Astros in 2012 as a player to be named later in a trade that sent RHP **Brett Myers** to Chicago.
- The late **Al Lopez**, one of four Tampa natives in the Hall of Fame, is the second-longest-tenured skipper in White Sox history behind **Jimmy Dykes** (13), guiding the club for 11 seasons (1957-69).

BACKSTOP POP

Rays catchers have combined for a .798 OPS, third highest in the AL behind the Red Sox (.906) and Angels (.808) and eighth in the majors...last season, Rays backstops produced the AL's 11th-ranked OPS (.656).

HOME(S) AWAY FROM HOME

Since the beginning of 2023, **Harold Ramirez's** .348 (78-for-224) average on the road leads the majors (min. 200AB), ahead of LAD **Freddie Freeman** (.346)...**Amed Rosario** is batting .396 (19-for-48) during his 12-game road hitting streak, the longest active run in the majors, ahead of the injured MIN **Royce Lewis** (11G).

TONIGHT'S START—Civale will make his sixth start of the season, including his third on the road...in seven road starts since being acquired by Tampa Bay last season, Civale is 3-3 with a 4.55 ERA (31.2IP, 16ER).

LAST TIME OUT—Suffered his second defeat of the season on April 21 at Yankee Stadium...allowed season highs in hits (8) and runs (5), while walking a career-high five batters.

- Allowed one run in the 1st inning, but held the Yankees scoreless from innings 2-4...retired **Juan Soto** and **Aaron Judge** to open the 5th, but issued three consecutive walks to **Giancarlo Stanton**, **Anthony Rizzo** and **Gleyber Torres**...following the three straight free passes, conceded three straight singles to **Alex Verdugo**, **Jose Trevino** and **Oswaldo Cabrera**.
- Failed to reach the 5.0-inning mark for the first time this season.

IF THE SOX FIT—Civale has made 10 career starts opposite Chicago, going 5-3 with a 4.21 ERA (47.OIP, 22ER)...faced the White Sox in his final start as a Guardian on July 30, 2023 and tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits and two walks with four strikeouts.

- In five starts at Guaranteed Rate Field, he is 2-2 with a 2.63 ERA (27.1IP, 8ER).

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE—He has allowed 3ER or fewer in 15 consecutive starts against the AL Central dating to May 20, 2022, having conceded two runs or fewer in 14 of the 15 outings.

- During this 15-start stretch, Civale has tallied eight quality starts, going 6-1 with a 1.98 ERA (81.2IP, 18ER) and 75 strikeouts against 12 walks.

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK—Civale has thrown 100+ pitches in back-to-back starts for the fifth time in his career, including the first time since another two-start streak from June 5-11, 2021...he threw 100+ pitches in a career-best five straight starts from May 3-25, 2021.

- He is the first Rays pitcher to throw 100+ pitches in consecutive starts since **Ryan Yarbrough** (2GS) from July 10-19, 2021...the last Tampa Bay hurler to do so in three consecutive starts was **Charlie Morton** from June 26-July 7, 2019.

STRIKEOUT STUFF—He has struck out 31 batters, his second-most strikeouts through five starts to begin a season behind his 32 SO in 2020...he has 8 SO in two of five starts (April 3 vs. TEX and April 16 vs. LAA) after having four such starts all of last season, three of which came with the Rays.

- Since joining Tampa Bay, Civale has made 15 starts and produced a 28.3 pct. strikeout rate (89SO/314BF)...in 76 starts for the Guardians, he posted a 21.1 pct. strikeout rate (370SO/1750BF).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN—Prior to allowing five runs in his last start on April 21 at Yankee Stadium, Civale had surrendered three runs or fewer in each of his previous 15 road starts dating back to Sept. 20, 2022, including six outings in which he yielded one or zero runs...it was the second-longest active streak in the majors, trailing only **MIL Wade Miley** (16GS)...last season, his 2.40 ERA (60.OIP, 16ER) on the road ranked third in MLB behind **SD Blake Snell** (1.99) and **NYY Gerrit Cole** (2.34).

SNAPPING THE STREAK—Civale did not allow a home run in his last start, snapping a career-long streak of eight consecutive starts having given up at least one home run.

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER—For his career, Civale is 31-1 with a 3.09 ERA (302.2IP, 104ER) in games when he receives three or more runs of support...he has a 2-27 record with a 5.17 ERA (200.1IP, 115ER) in games receiving two or fewer runs of support...since joining the Rays, Civale is 4-0 with a 3.61 ERA (42.1IP, 17ER) with 3+ runs of support and 0-5 with a 6.46 ERA (30.2IP, 22ER) when receiving two or fewer runs.

SINK AND SWEEP—He utilizes his sinker 23.2 pct. of the time and is holding opponents to a .167 (5-for-30) clip with 9 SO on the offering.

- Civale throws his sweeper 16.2 pct. of the time, but deploys it almost exclusively against right-handed hitters...opponents are 4-for-26 (.154) vs. the sweeper, including a 3-for-22 (.136) clip from RHH.
