RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their six-game homestand today with the finale of a three-game weekend series against division-rival Milwaukee. The Nationals (81-66) visit Busch Stadium for three games tomorrow. St. Louis enters today in first place in the NL Central, 3.0 games ahead of Chicago.

TIME TO FLY: After a five-game losing streak on a West Coast trip to Oakland and Los Angeles (NL), the Cardinals are 25-10 since August 9, tied with Atlanta for most wins in MLB over that period while boasting a MLB-best 2.83 ERA.

FIESTA CARDENALES: The Cardinals today are hosting their 4th annual "Fiesta Cardenales" at Busch Stadium as Major League Baseball celebrates Hispanic Heritage Month. For the first time in Busch Stadium history and second time ever, St. Louis is wearing "Cardenales" jerseys, which replaces the traditional "Cardinals" script. The club previously wore Cardenales in a 5-3 defeat on June 11, 2011 at Miller Park, during Milwaukee's annual "Cerveceros Day."

PONLE ACENTO: 151 Latin-American born players have appeared in a Cardinals uniform in franchise history, including 10 on the active roster: **Yadier Molina** (Puerto Rico), **Carlos Martínez** (Dominican Republic), **Génesis Cabrera** (Dominican Republic), **Junior Fernandez** (Dominican Republic), **Giovanny Gallegos** (Mexico), **Edmundo Sosa** (Panama), **Rangel Ravelo** (Cuba), **José Martínez** (Venezuela), **Marcell Ozuna** (Dominican Republic), **Randy Arozarena** (Cuba).

EARLY BIRDS: The Cardinals are 31-18 in day games this season, sporting the 2nd-best winning percentage in the National League (.633) behind the Dodgers (.711, 27-11). St. Louis has won nine of its last 10 under natural lighting.

I LOVE GOOOOOOLD: Eight of **Paul Goldschmidt's** team-leading 31 homers have been hit against the Brewers this season, tying his single-season most vs. any opponent (8 vs. the Dodgers in 2015). His eight home runs vs. Milwaukee tie Cincinnati's **Eugenio Suarez** (8) for most in MLB this season, tie **Albert Pujols** (8 in 2010) for the Cardinals single-season record, and trail only **Sammy Sosa** (12 in 1998) in MLB single-season history.

SOBERING EFFECT: The Cardinals have clinched the season series (10-8) over the Brewers for the 15th time in 22 seasons since Milwaukee joined the NL Central in 1998. A win today would give St. Louis its 7th at home over the Brewers in 2019, matching its single-season most at home vs. the Brew Crew (2002 & 2016).

RARE ERROR: The Cardinals have not committed an error in a season-high nine straight games (Sept. 5-present), their longest since a 10-game errorless stretch from June 10-20, 2017. St. Louis leads MLB this season with a .989 team fielding pct. (59 errors in 5,406 total chances), currently the highest mark in franchise single-season history, ahead of the 2013 Cardinals (.988, 75 errors). The last time St. Louis led MLB in team fielding pct. was 1985 (.983, 108 errors).

MAHALO: **Kolten Wong** has reached base safely in 17 straight games vs. Milwaukee (.448/.515/.672 (26-58), tied with **Cody Bellinger** for longest active in MLB. Wong's 26 hits vs. Milwaukee in 2019 are his single-season career high vs. any opponent and rank T3rd-most in Cards single-season in history vs. the Brewers, trailing **Edgar Renteria** (30-for-61) and **Albert Pujols** (28-for-62).

A WINNING TRADITION: The Cardinals have posted their 12th consecutive winning season (2008-19), something they'd done just once previously in franchise history when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-53. Only the Yankees (27 seasons) sport a longer active consecutive winning season streak in Major League Baseball.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 15, 1986): **Mike Laga** hits the only ball out of Busch Stadium II during a game with a foul ball that leaves the ballpark approximately two-thirds of the way down the right field line. Earlier this season (June 21 vs. the Angels), **Paul Goldschmidt** follows suit by hitting a foul ball out of Busch Stadium III, exiting the park down the third base line.

Paul DeJong graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) High School...resides in Hazelhurst, Wisc.

Dexter Fowler and **Jordan Lyles** were traded for each other during the 2013-14 offseason (Dec. 3, 2013)...Colorado sent Fowler to Houston for Lyles and outfielder **Brandon Barnes**.

Yadier Molina hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's **Matt Wise** (Sept. 23, 2004).

Tyler Webb pitched for Brewers in two games in 2017...claimed off waivers by San Diego (April 2018).

Cardinals Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** previously served as the Brewers Pitching Coach from 2003-08...oversaw Brewers staff that ranked 2nd in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, lowest mark by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Devin Williams was born in Florissant, Mo. and resides in Maryland Heights...was First Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American as a senior at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the University of Missouri before being selected by Milwaukee in the 2nd round of the 2013 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Hall of Famer, broadcaster and Special Assistant **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Cardinals Director of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay, Wisc...earned his Master's in Physical Therapy from The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** is a Marquette Univ. graduate...started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Cardinals Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played 13 seasons with St. Louis (1968-80), where he was a six-time NL All-Star and won 1980 Silver Slugger Award...traded by St. Louis with pitchers **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** to Milwaukee for outfielders **David Green** and **Sixto Lezcano** and pitchers **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**...played five seasons with the Brewers (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against the Cardinals in the 1982 World Series.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher **Jimmie Coker** and outfielder **Gary Kolb** (April 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).
