THE TWINS: Began the post-All-Star break portion of their schedule with a loss to the Rockies last night at Coors Field...tonight, they will play the second of three in Denver...they will conclude the series tomorrow afternoon, then travel to Los Angeles to play the Dodgers for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

ROCKY START TO THE ROADTRIP: The Twins lost to the Rockies last night at Coors Field by a score of 6-4...Chris Paddack (3-9) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing five runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...four of the runs allowed came in the first inning, allowing two doubles, a triple and a home run before recording an out...the offense recorded 10 hits, three from Byron Buxton and four from Ryan Jeffers, tying a season and career-high (also 5/17/25 at MIL)...Minnesota went 1-for-8 with runners in scoring position and left eight men on base.

A TO Z, ADAMS TO ZEBBY: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Matthews, who was placed on the 15-day IL on June 8 with a right shoulder strain, made one rehab start with Triple-A St. Paul on July 13, pitching 4.0 scoreless innings against lowa and allowing one hit, with no walks and nine strikeouts...he made four starts for the Twins earlier this season, going 1-1, 5.21 ERA (19.0 IP, 11 ER), with eight walks and 25 strikeouts...over his last two starts for Minnesota from May 30-June 4, he went 1-0, 3.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 5 ER) and a .227 opponent batting average.

◆ To make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned right-handed Travis Adams to St. Paul following last night's game...Adams appeared in three games during his most recent stint with Minnesota, going 1-0, 6.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 6 ER), with one walk and six strikeouts.

TWINS AND ROX ON THE RECORD: The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 25th, 26th and 27th times in their history this weekend...the Twins have gone 14-11 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 5-5 at Coors Field (2008, '14, '23 & '25) and 7-5 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22 & '24).

◆ The Twins' 25 games against the Rockies are tied with Los Angeles-NL and Miami for their second-fewest among any MLB opponent, trailing Washington (24 games).

◆ Dating back to June of 2022, the Twins have gone 6-3 against Colorado in their last nine.

◆ In nine career games against the Rockies, Byron Buxton is hitting .387 (12-for-31) with one double, two triples, three home runs, seven RBI, four walks and a 1.296 OPS.

COORREA, SILVER BULLET: Carlos Correa has played in 23 career games against the Rockies, hitting .402 (35-for-87) with eight doubles, three home runs, 20 RBI, a .598 slugging percentage and a 1.057 OPS...he has reached safely in 18-straight games against the Rockies, dating back to August 15, 2018 (.467 OBP in span).

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone 13-18 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13) and 0-1 at Colorado.

♣ Twins have five NL teams still to play: Dodgers (July 21-23), Nationals (July 25-27), Padres (August 29-31), D-Backs (September 12-14) and Phillies (September 26-28).

BUCK NATIONAL: In his last 23 Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .378 (34-for-90) with five doubles, three triples, nine home runs, 14 RBI and a 1.214 OPS...below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1977).

 BUCK ON BEGINNER MODE: After going 3-for-5 last night, Byron Buxton now has 12 hits in his last 18 bats (last 4 games), five going for extra-bases...he has multiple hits in four-straight, matching his career-high, done three times previously, last from May 30-June 3.
 ◆ Over his last 30 games, Buxton is hitting .354 (40-for-113) with eight doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBI, 29 runs scored, 10 walks, a .416 on-base percentage, a .761 slugging percentage and a 1.177 OPS.
 ◆ He hit his 22nd home run of the season last night, six short of his career-high of 28, done in 2022...last night's home run gave him 57 RBI, setting a new single-season career-high passing his 2024 total of 56...he also now has 66 runs scored, three short of his career-high of 69, done in 2017.
 ◆ Buck has a 13.77 at-bat-per-home run ratio, third-best in the AL and sixth-best in baseball, trailing Cal Raleigh (9.24), Aaron Judge (10.17), Eugenio Suárez (11.32), Kyle Schwarber (11.45) and Shohei Ohtani (11.69).
 ◆ Since June 17, Buck has 11 home runs (25 games), tied with Juan Soto and Kyle Stowers for second-most in baseball...only Raleigh has more since that date.
 ◆ At 17 stolen bases, Buck needs three more to become the seventh different Twin (8th overall time) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hisle (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

TOP JEFF: In 12 games this month, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with three doubles, one home run, five RBI, two walks, a .471 on-base percentage, a .613 slugging percentage and a 1.083 OPS.

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: Carlos Correa has reached safely in seven of his last eight games...over his last 22 games, Correa is hitting .325 (26-for-80) with four doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, six walks, a .372 on-base percentage, a .450 slugging percentage and an .822 OPS.

REHAB UPDATES: Bailey Ober (right hip impingement) and Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) both began their rehab assignments with Triple-A St. Paul last night at Louisville:

© Ober pitched 4.0 shutout innings, with four hits allowed, no walks and three strikeouts, throwing 50 pitches.

© Keaschall went 1-for-5 with a single, an RBI and a strikeout while playing the entire game at designated hitter.

LAST START (TRIPLE-A): Last pitched on July 13 on a rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints vs. the lowa Cubs, opposite Ben Brown, but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 2-8 defeat... allowed just one hit with no walks and nine strikeouts in 4.0 scoreless innings...nine strikeouts tied his professional career high, done five times previously, including twice this season on April 8 with St. Paul against Omaha and on May 24 with the Twins against Kansas City...the lone hit he gave up was a two-out double to the league's hitting leader, Jonathan Long, in the first inning.

• Retired his final 10 batters faced in the first through fourth innings, and struck out the side

in the third

 Φ Had a 52% whiff rate...his fastball averaged 97.4 mph, while topping out at 98.7 mph.

TWO STARTS AGO (MAJORS): Last pitched in the majors on June 4 at the Athletics, opposite Jeffrey Springs...he earned his first major league win of the 2025 season, and first since his MLB debut on August 13, 2024, breaking a five-game losing streak (over 11 starts)...allowed one run on four hits, with three walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings in the Twins' 6-1 win...his sole run allowed came on an RBI double from Jacob Wilson, scoring Lawrence Butler...allowed a career-high-tying three walks for the third time in his MLB career (also, 9/28/24 vs. Baltimore and 5/18 at Milwaukee).

After the start, was placed on the 15-day Injured List on June 8 (retroactive to June 5) due to a right shoulder strain

MOW 'EM DOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews has totaled 68 strikeouts through his first 13 career major league games, the fifth most in Twins history (1961-)...here are some of his numbers compared to other Twins pitchers through their first 13 games:
