TODAY'S GAME: The Giants can take the series and the homestand with a win in this afternoon's finale vs. Atlanta...they are 3-2 on this homestand thus far (2-1 vs. the A's and 1-1 vs. the Braves).

- ▶ With last night's win, the Giants are now 8-2 (.800) against the Braves overall in the last two seasons and 5-1 in their last six home games versus Atlanta dating to August 15, 2024.
- ▶ Giants pitching over their last 11 games has a 2.81 ERA (30er, 96.0ip), best in the Majors.
- ▶ Specifically looking at the starters, they have a 1.57 ERA (7er, 40.0ip) in the club's last six games but SF is 3-3 in those games.
- ▶ SF faces LHP Chris Sale this afternoon for the fifth time in Sale's career...he's 2-0 with a 1.33 ERA in the four starts vs. SF and the Giants are winless against him overall in the four starts.

ROSTER MOVES: OF Heliot Ramos (#17) was returned from his rehabilitation assignment and reinstated from the 10-day IL...**IF Buddy Kennedy** was designated for assignment in a corresponding move.

- ▶ Ramos returns to SF's active roster after missing 37 games with a right quad strain that he sustained in mid-May...Ramos appeared in seven rehab games at Triple-A Sacramento and went 9-for-26 (.346) with seven runs, three doubles, a homer, two RBI and five walks.

RAYGUN: LHP Robbie Ray starts the finale this afternoon as he bookends the homestand.

- ▶ He fired 8.0 innings Tuesday night against the A's, allowing one unearned run on two hits while striking out six and walking four in SF's 3-1 win.
- ▶ He faces the Braves for a second time in two weeks after resuming SF's suspended game on June 17 on what was already his start day...he picked up the win with 6.1 scoreless innings of work and eight strikeouts while permitting just two hits.
- ▶ In four starts this month, the 34-year-old is 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (5er, 25.0ip), .151 opponent's average against, .445 opponent's OPS and a 0.96 WHIP.
- ▶ The Giants have won each of Ray's last six appearances and are 10-6 overall in games he's appeared this season.

CALL RAFI!: IF Rafael Devers clocked a pair of homers last night for his 22nd multi-homer game overall and third as a Giant...he now has 249 career homers entering play today.

- ▶ Devers hit his first homer of the night in the 2nd inning to give the Giants an early 1-0 lead...it was his fifth go-ahead homer of the year...10 of Devers' 14 homers this season have given the Giants a lead or tied the game.
- ▶ 12 of Devers' 14 homers this year have also come since May 1...his 12 homers since the start of May are tied for seventh-most in the National League in that time.

THE STARTING LINE: Giants starters have been a bright spot for SF as of late...after a rocky start, SF's rotation has a 3.45 ERA in June that is fourth-best in the Majors behind the Marlins (3.05), Nationals (3.31) and Brewers (3.43).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH INCOMING?: RHP Logan Webb fired 7.0 scoreless innings in yesterday's win to lower his June ERA to 0.71 (3er, 38.0ip)...in his five starts, Webb limited opposing hitters to a .148 clip with a 0.61 WHIP and an opponent's OPS of .370.

- ▶ Webb's 0.71 ERA was the lowest in a calendar month (min. five games started and 35.0 innings pitched) by a Giants starter since **Noah Lowry** logged a 0.69 ERA in August of 2005...overall Webb's 0.71 ERA this month is sixth-lowest by a Giants starter since 1913...chart courtesy of *Elias* via Sarah Langs.
- ▶ Since being activated off the IL, Webb has lowered his season ERA from 5.06 to its current spot at 3.09...his 3.09 ERA sits just outside the NL top-10 (12th).

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Had his best performance of the year in his last start on June 23 against the A's...threw 8.0 innings, allowing one unearned run on two hits and four walks with six strikeouts in the Giants 3-1 victory...the Giants have now won each of his last six outings and are 10-6 over this season when Ray pitches.

SOLID STRETCH: Over his last five outings, Ray has posted a 3-0 record with a 1.86 ERA (6er, 29.0ip), 27 strikeouts and a .176 opponents average against...he's been even better over his last two appearances, as he's held opponents to one unearned run over 14.1 innings of work...opponents are just 4-for-46 (.087) off him with 14 strikeouts in those two games...this solid stretch came on the heels of a rough three games from May 13-24 where he posted a 0-2 record with an 11.08 ERA (16er, 13.0ip) and a .370 opponents average against.

WALK IT OUT: Has issued 42 walks over his 87.2 innings pitched this year, tied for third-most in the Majors.

SLIP AND SLIDE: Ray's slider has been different this year with his average velo dropping from 87.9 mph last year to 85.9 mph this year...he's also allowed four HR with it compared to seven all of last year...opponents are hitting .233 off his slider this season, compared to a .206 average last year...in 2025 his slider had a run value of 4, compared to a run value of -1 this season.

I'VE WATCHED A CHANGE IN YOU: On the flip side, Ray's changeup has a +5 run value this season (his best of any pitch in his arsenal) compared to a -1 run value a season ago...this year, hitters have an xBA of .195 on the offering while hitting .208 off it overall...it's been his second-best put away pitch (19.5%) behind his knuckle curve (21.2%)...in his last four starts, hitters are 3-for-26 in at-bats that end with Ray's changeup.

AGAINST THE BRAVES: Will face the Braves for the second time in his last three games...earned the win when he faced Atlanta on June 17...Ray resumed the Giants' suspended game from the rainout the night before and threw 6.1-scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and two walks with a season-high eight strikeouts...it marked just his fifth career appearance out of the bullpen and his first since September 1, 2020 with Toronto at Miami...overall, he's posted a 2-4 record with a 5.09 ERA in eight career appearances against the Braves.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers are just 2-for-20 (.100) off him over his last two games, after going 11-for-27 (.407) off him with three doubles, triple and HR in his previous six starts from May 13-June 10...prior that that tough stretch, lefties were 6-for-36 (.167) with no extra-base hits through his first eight starts of the year.

RUNNERS ON: When leading off an inning, opponents are hitting .321 (27-for-84) off Ray...overall, opponents are hitting .316 (30-for-95) off him with no one on base and no one out, compared to a .169 (21-for-124) average with runners on base...opponents are just 10-for-56 (.179) off him with runners in scoring position and have just two hits in 27 at-bats (.074) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

- ▶ Took a no-decision his last time out against the Athletics in his first MLB start since May 26 after a stay on the IL with a left hamstring strain...pitched 5.2 shutout innings, allowing two hits and two walks while striking out four... leads the Giants with four starts of 5.0-or-more shutout innings this season.
- ▶ Is making his eighth career appearance (all starts) against Arizona, and third this season alone... has lost both of his starts against them this year, allowing nine runs in 10.0ip (8.10 ERA)...overall, he's 0-3 with a 3.38 career ERA (15er, 40.0ip) against the D-Backs.
