TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **Cory Little's Rockies** and the fifth game (2-2) of a 7-game homestand before the All-Star break that includes a 4-game series split vs the **Marlins** (7/7-7/10).
- Following Sun's "first-half" finale vs **Col**, the Reds will enjoy 4-day break before lifting the lid on the season's "second half" at **NYM** (7/18-7/20) and **Wsh** (7/21-7/23).
- Cin went 2-4 on its most recent road trip at **Bos** (1-2) and **Phi** (1-2).

ALL-STAR ABBOTT: On Tue, **LHP Andrew Abbott** was named to the National League All-Star team as a replacement for **LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto**.

- It's his first career All-Star selection.
- Is the first Reds All-Star **LHP** since **Aroldis Chapman** in 2015.
- Is just 1 of 4 Cin left-handed starting pitchers over the last 40 years to be selected to the All-Star team (**John Smiley** 1995, **Tom Browning** 1991, **Danny Jackson** 1988).
- Ranks among all Major League pitchers with at least 91 innings in several categories, including ERA (2.07), runs (26), earned runs (21), AVG (.219), OBP (.272), SLG (.348), WHIP (1.08), base runners allowed (100), hits (75), extra-base hits (24), strike pct (66.2), hard hit pitches (62) and hard hit pct (.332).

ALL-STAR: DE LA CRUZ: **SS Elly De La Cruz** has been named to the National League All-Star team for the second consecutive season.

- He's the first Reds player to be selected as an All-Star in back-to-back years since **Joey Votto** (2017-18).
- Is the sixth primary shortstop in Reds history to make consecutive All-Star teams, joining **Barry Larkin** (1988-91, '93-'97, '99-2000), **David Concepcion** (1975-82), **Leo Cardenas** (1964-66), **Roy McMillan** (1955-57), and **Eddie Miller** (1943-44, '46-'47).
- Is the seventh Red to earn multiple All-Star selections within his first 3 career seasons, the first since **Chris Sabo** (1988, '90).
- Joins **Johnny Bench** (4, 1968-71), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1956-59), and **Vada Pinson** (2, 1959-60) as the only Reds players named to multiple All-Star teams before turning 24.

THE FUTURE IS HERE: **C Alfredo Duno** and **INF Sal Stewart** will represent the Reds organization in the 26th edition of the **All-Star Futures Game** tomorrow at **Truist Park** in Atlanta, GA.

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 30 series this season, including the recently completed 4-game set vs **Mia** (2-2).

- Marks their longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to open a season since **1989**, when that team also went 30 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 7/17-7/19 vs **Phi**.
- Only the **1970** Reds team, which won the NL Pennant, opened a season with a longer streak, going **32** straight series before getting swept in a 2-game set at **Chc** from 7/22-23.
- Cin is the only Major League team not to have been swept this season.

WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST: The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the 1st inning 30 times this season, including in each of the last 3g vs **Mia**.

- Cin has plated 68 runs in the 1st inning this season, second-most in the majors, behind only **Bos** (70)...this includes the 10 runs plated in the 1st inning on 5/10 at **Hou**.
- Cin has outscored opponents 68-41 in the first inning and are slashing .264/.345/.412 with 11 home runs.
- Have plated multiple runs in the opening frame of a game 19 times this season (last: Wed vs **Mia**), tied with the **Red Sox** for the most-such instances in MLB.

SERIES NOTES:

- The Reds are 121-115 all-time vs the **Rockies** (51-70 in **Colorado**).
- From 4/25-4/27 the Redlegs swept the **Rockies** at **Coors Field** for the second consecutive season...have won 6 straight games and 7 of their last 8 in the **Mile High City**.
- Since 6/19/23 Cin has won 12 of 13 overall vs **Col**, including 6 of 7 here at **Great American Ball Park**.

FRANCONA CLOSING IN ON 2000 WINS: **Terry Francona** enters tonight's game 2 wins away from reaching 2,000 as a Major League manager.

- He'd become the 13th manager to reach the 2,000-win milestone.
- Would be the second active manager in the majors with 2,000 wins (**Tex*** **Bruce Bochy** 2,217).
- Each big league skipper with 2,000 career wins, except for **Bochy** and **Dusty Baker**, are in the Hall of Fame.
- Baker** (2,183) and **Sparky Anderson** (2,194 wins) are the only 2,000-win skippers to manage the Reds.
- Leo Durocher** is the only 2,000-win manager to play for Cin (1930-33).
- Would be the fourth manager to earn his 2,000th win for a team he once played for (1987), joining **Bochy** (SF), **Bucky Harris** (Det), and **John McGraw** (NYG).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision in the 3-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi (4.2ip, 2h, 1r/1er, 4bb, 7k, 91TP).

- Did not allow a run while he was in the game...his 1-out walk to Brandon Marsh scored on Kyle Schwarber's RBI-double off Sam Moll in the 5th inning.
- Was just the second time in his pro career that he walked 4 batters in a game (6/12 for Louisville vs Iowa, 4bb).

JUNE 30: On 6/30, in his second career Major League appearance, was reached for 7 runs (5er) on 5 hits in 0.1 inning (2bb, 1hr, 33TP, 9 batters faced) in the Reds' 13-6 loss at Bos.

- Was the shortest start of his professional career and the shortest by a Reds pitcher this season.
- His outing marked the first time a Cin non-opener was pulled before the end of the 1st inning since Frankie Montas on 4/21/24 vs LAA (0.2ip)...RHP Connor Phillips was the last Reds pitcher to record 0.1 inning or less when he didn't get anyone out in his start on 9/30/23 at StL.
- Became the ninth Reds pitcher since at least 1901 to record 1 or 0 outs in a start within their first 2 career games, the first since Eddie Priest on 6/1/98 at SF (0.1 IP).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT, JUNE 24: Was selected from AAA-Louisville on 6/24 and that night made his Major League debut vs NYY, 345 days after the Reds drafted him with the second overall pick in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft.

- Allowed 3 runs (3er) on 6 hits over 5.0 innings (0bb, 8k, 1hr, 81TP) in the 11-inning 5-4 win...did not factor in the decision.
- Became the second Reds' draft pick in as many seasons and the 13th in franchise history to debut within a year of being drafted (Rhett Lowder debuted in 2024 after being selected seventh overall in 2023).
- Became the first starting pitcher in the expansion era (since 1961) to retire the first 5 batters he faced via strikeout in his ML debut (*Elias*).
- He struck out the first 3 batters he faced in the first inning to become just the second Cin pitcher in the live-ball era (since 1920) to accomplish that feat in the opening frame of his ML debut (also: RHP Mo Sanford, 1991)...*courtesy Elias*.
- Joined TB's RHP Wade Davis (9/6/09) and NYY's Al Leiter (9/15/87) as the only pitchers during the live-ball era to have each of their first 6 outs of their Major League debut come via strikeout (*Elias*).
- Became the first Reds pitcher since RHP Jackson Stephens in 2017 to record 8 or more strikeouts in his debut.
- Went 7-3 with a 1.77 ERA over 13 combined starts with A-Dayton, AA-Chattanooga, and AAA-Louisville.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE BATS: Earned the 8-1 win on 6/18 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (7.0ip, 3h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 7k, 88TP).

2025 PRO DEBUT: Made 3 appearances at A-Dayton in his professional debut.

- Was Dayton's Opening Day starter on 4/4 at West Michigan (4.0ip, 1h, 0r, 1bb, 6k, 57TP)...his 6 strikeouts were the most by a Dragons' pitcher in a season opener since Robert Stephenson fanned 6 in 2013.

- Entered the game having not allowed a hit to any of his previous 32 batters on which he reached 2 strikes...that streak was snapped at 39 by Kyle Stowers' full count single in the 4th inning.
- Held Mia scoreless through 4 and until Agustín Ramírez' 2-out RBI-double in the 5th inning...the next batter, Liam Hicks, singled home Ramirez...Kyle Stowers popped out to end the inning...Stowers was Singer's last batter faced.

15 STRIKEOUTS: His 15 strikeouts over his first 3 Major League appearances are the most by any Reds pitcher to start his career since Connor Phillips (17k, 2023).

REDS TOP PROSPECT: Is rated the Reds' top prospect by MLB Pipeline and *Baseball America* and is ranked among baseball's best prospects (*BA's* No. 8; Pipeline's No.11).

SOUTHERN LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for 5/26-6/1 (1-0, 6.0ip, 2h, 1bb, 4k, 82TP).

RANKED AMONG LEADERS: At the time of his promotion, ranked among all full-season minor league pitchers in WHIP (0.77), ERA (1.77), strikeouts (89), opponents batting average (.167), and K/BB ratio (89k/13bb).

PERSONAL: Pitched collegiately at Tennessee (2022-2023) before transferring to Wake Forest (2024)...graduated from Beech High School in Hendersonville, TN where he was selected by Baseball America as a 2021 First Team High School All-American...his father, David, played college football at Division II North Greenville College.

ACQUIRED: Was selected by the Reds in the first round (second overall) in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft...was signed by Eddie Lehr.

WITH THE LOOKOUTS: Was transferred from A-Dayton to AA-Chattanooga on 4/22.

- Made his Double-A debut in the first game of a doubleheader on 4/26 vs Columbus (4ip, 5h, 1r/1er, 1bb, 5k, 73TP).
- Earned his first professional victory in the 4-1 win on 5/2 at Montgomery (5.0ip, 5h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 8k, 59TP).
- Produced a career-high 10 strikeouts in the 7-2 win on 5/25 vs Rocket City...was his fourth win in 6 starts with Cha.
- Fanned 7 or more batters in 5 consecutive starts from 5/2-5/25, was the longest streak in the Southern League to that point of the season, and the longest such streak by a Lookouts pitcher since Hunter Greene (7g) in 2021.
- On 6/2 became the fourth Lookouts player to win Southern League Player or Pitcher of the Week in 2025.
- Pitched a 7-inning complete game shutout on 6/7 at Knoxville...became the first Chattanooga pitcher to throw a CG SHO since Andrew Abbott on 9/6/22 at Birmingham.

WITH THE BATS: Promoted to AAA-Louisville on 6/9.

- Made his Triple-A debut in the first game of a doubleheader on 6/12 at Iowa (5.1ip, 4h, 2r/2er, 4bb, 7k, 86TP).
- His only other appearance with the Bats came on 6/18 vs Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, in which he matched his season-high with 7.0 innings pitched (3h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 7k, 88TP).
