THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their current seven-game roadtrip, losing in Cleveland on Monday night, winning on Tuesday night, then losing last night...today, the Twins will play the four-game series finale at Progressive Field...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Boston for three at Fenway Park over the weekend...after this trip, the Twins will finish the regular season with an off-day on Monday, followed by a six-game homestand with three against the Marlins and three against the Orioles.

At 80-72, the Twins need two wins in their final 10 games to secure a winning record for the second-straight season (87-75 in 2023) and fourth time in six seasons under Rocco Baldelli.

ANOTHER HEARTBREAKER IN CLEVELAND: The Twins lost to the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 5-4 in 10 innings, making them 4-7 in extras this season...the Twins had three different leads on the night, including a two-run lead in the 10th inning...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with no walks and a career-high 12 strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, including three apiece from Carlos Correa and Matt Wallner...Correa drove in all four runs on the night, tying a season-high.

Willi Castro was hit by a pitch twice last night, giving him 21 on the season, breaking a tie with Chuck Knoblauch (19 in 1996) to set Twins' (since 1961) single-season hit-by-pitch record.

ON GUARD: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the 13th and final time in 2024...the Twins have gone 3-9 against Cleveland this season, going 2-4 at Target Field and 1-5 at Progressive Field.

Of the 12 games played between these two teams this season, 11 have been decided by three runs or fewer...Cleveland has eight wins in those instances and Minnesota has three. Carlos Correa is hitting .315 (39-for-124) with seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .397 on-base percentage, a .508 slugging percentage and a .905 OPS in 33 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022...in seven games this season, he's hitting .417 (10-for-24) with six walks and a .533 on-base percentage against Cleveland pitching.

The next time these two are scheduled to meet will be for a four-game series at Progressive Field from April 28-May 1, 2025.

YOU'VE GOT TO CHANGE YOUR EVIL WAYS: Carlos Santana has hit .246 (592-for-2411) with 122 doubles, seven triples, 111 home runs, 335 RBI and an .802 OPS in 685 career games at Progressive Field...in his career as an opponent vs. Cleveland, he is slashing .138/.220/.208...below are all-time Progressive Field ranks:

CORREA ON A RUN: After going 3-for-5 last night, Carlos Correa tied his career-high, hitting safely in 16 consecutive games with an at-bat, dating back to June 26, the longest hitting streak by a Twin this season and longest active streak in baseball...during the streak, he is hitting .377 (23-for-61) with a 1.153 OPS...his other 16-game hitting streak was from April 19-May 6, 2019 with Houston.

The longest hitting streak in baseball this season is Pittsburgh's Bryan Reynolds (25).

CENTRAL OF ATTENTION: Twins enter today 7.5 games back of Cleveland in the AL Central and 1.5 games back of the Royals...additionally, they are 0.5 games ahead of the Tigers for the final wild card spot...below are miscellaneous Twins, Guardians, Royals and Tigers records:

NOTE: The Tigers and Royals are both off today...the Tigers begin a three-game weekend series in Baltimore tomorrow and the Royals will host the Giants.

LEFT SIDE STORY: The Twins are slashing .256/.312/.429 (.742 OPS) against left-handed pitching, compared to .246/.319/.415 (.735 OPS) against right-handers.

The Twins are 21-22 when facing a left-handed starter...they went 16-9 when facing a left-handed starter prior to the All-Star break, but have since gone 5-13.

Minnesota's .256 average against lefties ranks second the AL and ranks seventh-best in baseball...the Twins .429 slugging percentage leads the AL and ranks sixth in baseball.

In their last five games, Twins are slashing .302/.400/.488 (.888 OPS) vs. lefties.

In his last 41 games against lefties (since June 5) Carlos Santana is slashing .306/.392/.682 (1.074 OPS)...since that date, his slugging ranks sixth in the AL and his OPS ranks eighth.

In his last 14 games against left-handed pitching, Manny Margot is slashing .323/.382/.419 (.802 OPS)...Margot, who typically leads off against left-handed starters, is hitting .358 (34-for-95) from the leadoff spots against left-handed pitching, the fourth-best in baseball, trailing Jose Altuve (.372), Yandy Diaz (.367) and Ketel Marte (.361).

BUCK AROUND AND FIND OUT: Since coming off the 10-day IL last Thursday, Byron Buxton has reached base in all four games played, posting a slashline of .308/.400/.615 (1.015 OPS) with four hits, four RBI and two walks...over his last 47 games dating back to June 11, Buxton is hitting .329 (53-for-161) with 16 doubles, 14 home runs, 37 RBI, a .394 on-base percentage, a .702 slugging percentage and a 1.096 OPS...since that date, he leads baseball in OPS, fifth in batting average, and eighth in on-base percentage.

Buck's 94 games played are the second-most of his career, ahead of his 2016 and 2022 totals of 92...career-high is 140, set in 2017.

He ranks in the 93rd percentile in baseball in xSLG (.512) and 91st percentile in barrel percentage (14.0%).

FARMER'S ONLY: Kyle Farmer's 10-game hitting streak remains alive after he walked in a pinch-hit appearance on Tuesday night...10-game hitting streak ties his career-high, done three times previously (2023 and twice in 2021)...in 15 games this month, he is hitting .429 (12-for-28) with two doubles, three home runs, five RBI, five runs scored, an .821 slugging percentage and a 1.288 OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: On this day in 2019, the Twins beat the Royals by a score of 8-5 and improved to 94-59 on the season...the 94 wins made Rocco Baldelli the fifth rookie manager in Twins/Senators franchise history to reach that mark...Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970 and Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933...in 2020, the Twins clinched a playoff berth with an 8-1 victory over the Cubs...they went on to win the American League Central on the season's final day, then were swept in two games by Houston in the American League Wild Card Series.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched September 14 vs. Cincinnati, opposite Nick Martinez, and took the loss in Minnesota's 11-1 defeat...allowed three runs on five hits in 3.0 innings, with three walks and three strikeouts...escaped a bases-loaded, no-outs jam in the third...was pulled after allowing a walk, two singles and a run to begin the fourth; Louie Varland entered and allowed both inherited runners to score.

- ☞ Threw 69 pitches, his second fewest in a start this season (66, 6/2 at HOU).
- ☞ Induced four whiffs on 24 swings (16.7%)...ranks in MLB's 23rd percentile with a 22.0 percent whiff rate.
- ☞ Allowed two hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph), both singles...ranks in MLB's 66th percentile with a 36.9 percent hard-hit rate.
- ☞ Has failed to complete 5.0 innings in four-straight starts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started September 8 at Kansas City, opposite Michael Wacha, and took the loss in Minnesota's 2-0 defeat...allowed two runs on three hits in 4.1 innings, with three walks and two strikeouts...was pulled with a 1-0 deficit and the bases loaded in the fifth; Cole Sands entered and allowed one inherited run to score on Salvador Perez's infield single.

- ☞ Induced seven whiffs on 31 swings (22.6%) and allowed eight hard-hit balls.

COMFORTABLE VS. CLEVELAND: Has faced Cleveland twice this season, going 0-1 with a 2.19 ERA (12.1 IP, 3 ER), no walks, nine strikeouts, two home runs and a .178 (8-for-45) opponent batting average.

- ☞ May 17 at Progressive Field (no-decision in 3-2 CLE win): 5.1 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 K.
- ☞ August 10 at Target Field (loss in 2-1 CLE win): Career-high 7.0 IP, 4 H (2 HR), 2 ER, 7 K.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making 15th road start of 2024...is 4-3 with a 4.25 ERA (65.2 IP, 31 ER), 6.72 K/9, 3.02 BB/9, 1.10 HR/9 and a .732 opponent OPS on the road, compared to 1-2 with a 3.90 ERA (62.1 IP, 27 ER), 8.66 K/9, 3.47 BB/9, 0.87 HR/9 and a .601 opponent OPS in 12 home starts.

- ☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in four-straight road starts since August 16 at Texas.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 26 games vs. Woods Richardson, left-handed hitters have hit .237 (47-for-198) with a .338 slugging percentage, .648 OPS, 19.7 percent strikeout rate and 8.5 percent walk rate, while righties have hit .236 (67-for-284) with a .387 SLG, .686 OPS, 20.5 percent strikeout rate and 8.5 percent walk rate.
