NATIONALS NEWS

RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD
The Washington Nationals square off against the Chicago White Sox in the rubber match of this three-game weekend series on Sunday afternoon...The Nationals are 1-2 in rubber games, with the win coming in the opening series against the Chicago Cubs on March 29...Of note, the Nationals (2005-pres.) have never won a road series against both the White Sox and Cubs in the same season.

- The Nationals topped the White Sox, 6-3, in 10 innings on Saturday...**Jake Irvin** (5.2 IP, 4 H, 9 SO) and **Nasim Nuñez** (2-for-4, 4 RBI, BB, SB) led the way.
- This afternoon's matchup concludes their stretch of 17 games in 17 days that began on April 10...Washington will enjoy a day off on Monday in New York...The Nationals are 8-8 (.500) so far during this stretch.
- Washington is 9-6 (.571) on the road in 2026, tied for the fourth-most road wins in Major League Baseball.

ROSTER MOVES

The Nationals announced the following roster moves:

- Recalled right-handed pitcher **Andre Granillo** from Triple-A Rochester
- Recalled right-handed pitcher **Paxton Schultz** from Triple-A Rochester
- Placed right-handed pitcher **Clayton Beeter** on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to 4/23) with right forearm soreness.
- Optioned infielder/designated hitter **Andrés Chaparro** to Triple-A Rochester on Saturday

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball with 154 runs, the second most by a Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) through its first 28 games behind the 2017 National League East champion Nationals (179).

- Washington has scored 30 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have scored 56 runs in the seventh inning or later, tied for the most in MLB with Cleveland.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 19 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

HITTERISH

Some notes on a few Nationals hitters as of late:

- **Luis García Jr.** is 8-for-15 (.533) with two doubles, four RBI, one stolen base and four runs scored over his last five games...He's hit safely in four of the five.
- **Brady House** has hit safely in seven straight games, going 7-for-24 (.292) with a homer, three RBI, three walks, one stolen base and five runs scored.
- **Jorbit Vivas** has hit safely in 14 of his 17 starts this season and has reached base safely in 10 consecutive starts.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood has placed himself among the league leaders...See chart to the right.

- Wood leads Major League Baseball in on-base percentage (.485), OPS (1.207), home runs (9) and walks (T1st, 23) since April 5...This comes after starting the season 4-for-26 (.111) in eight games from March 26 to April 4.
- He is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 39 batted balls over 100 MPH are the most in Major League Baseball.

DON'T WALK SIGN

Washington's pitching staff ranks fourth in Major League Baseball in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.90) and third in walks per 9.0 innings (2.74) since April 15...The staff has fanned 90 batters against 31 walks in 102.0 innings.

- Including a career-high 10 strikeouts on Thursday vs. Atlanta, **Cade Cavalli** has struck out 15 batters without issuing a walk over his last two starts...**Jake Irvin** has 13 strikeouts against zero walks in his last two starts...Irvin ranks eighth in the National League with 10.31 strikeouts per 9.0 innings and Cavalli ranks ninth (10.22).

FRAME JOB

Bobby Wilson's catchers rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with three Catcher Framing Runs (**Drew Millas** - 2, **Keibert Ruiz** - 1) along with the New York Yankees, according to Baseball Savant..."*Catcher Framing Runs converts strikes to runs saved on a .125 run/strike basis, and includes park and pitcher adjustments. To qualify, a catcher must receive 6 called pitches per team game.*"

- For comparison, Washington's catchers ranked 30th in MLB with -18 Catcher Framing Runs in 2025.

DAYLEN'S DAYS

Daylen Lile has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 games and has reached safely in 14 of the 15...Lile is hitting .305 (18-for-59) and is slugging .525 (4 2B, 3 HR) during this 15-game stretch...He has struck out just twice in 26 plate appearances over his last six games.

- Lile is tied for third in the NL with 10 multi-hit games and is ninth in the NL with 32 hits.

FARM REPORT

TOP OF THE CHARTS
Fredericksburg outfielder **Jack Moroknek** has hit safely in 14 straight games, the longest active streak in all of Minor League Baseball...He's hitting .333 (18-for-54) with three doubles, one triple, three homers, 15 RBI, nine walks and 13 runs scored during the streak.

APRIL 26 (7-8)

2013 - Washington blanked Cincinnati, 1-0, as **Jordan Zimmermann** posted the first shutout of his career. Zimmermann one-hit the Reds and in doing so, the Nationals became the first D.C. based club to toss consecutive one-hitters since the AL Nationals, Aug. 10-11, 1917 vs. Chicago (AL).

Lefty starter returns to Major League Baseball after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball...Was a first-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 and their Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.

- Made his Major League debut with Kansas City on July 27, 2020, his 25th birthday.
- Became the third pitcher since at least 1901 to earn the win in his MLB debut on his birthday, joining Edwin Jackson (9/9/03 at ARI) and Zach Day (6/15/02 at MON).

LAST START

Went a career high 6.0 innings and threw 96 pitches...He allowed three earned runs on five hits (2 HR) and a walk with three strikeouts against the Atlanta Braves on April 21.

WINNING WAYS

Griffin has won three of his first five starts without taking a loss, becoming just the third pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to win at least three of his first five starts with Washington without suffering a loss...He joins **Luis Atilano** (3-0 in 2010) and **Micah Bowie** (3-0 in 2007).

BACK IN THE STATES, BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN

Griffin earned his first Major League win as a starter in his first career start on March 30 at Philadelphia...He threw 5.0 innings allowing just two earned runs on five hits with five strikeouts and no walks.

- It was his first Major League appearance since Sept. 22, 2022 at Tampa Bay and first Major League start after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball.

LUCKY 7

Griffin has the ability to throw seven pitches, including: cutter (30.0%), four seamer (15.5%), sweeper (12.6%), changeup (12.1%), curveball (8.5%), split finger (9.4%) and sinker (11.9%).

2026 SPRING TRAINING

Made two starts allowing four earned runs on eight hits striking out nine batters across 8.0 innings.

NPB Central League All-Star in 2025...Went 6-1 with a 1.52 ERA, 87 strikeouts, 22 walks and just one home run allowed in 89.0 innings across 17 starts.
