LAST TIME OUT: Faced the Detroit Tigers for the fist time this season, earned his second consecutive quality start of the year...Ryan did not factor in the decision for the second time in three starts this year...allowed six hits (1 HR), one walk, three runs (1 ER); two unearned runs scored in the firstinning, two-run home run by Kerry Carpenter after a lose Miranda throwing error...Ryan also had a career high 12 strikeouts in 6.0 innings..the Twins would go on to win in 12 innings, 11-5 and are now 2-1 on the year in games Ryan starts. � Generated 19 whiffs on 96 pitches thrown. (19.7%)

TWO STARTS AGO: First home start of the season came against the Cleveland Guardians on April 6... recorded his 27th career quality start after going 6.0 innings and allowing five hits, seven strikeouts and a three-run home run in the top of the second inning to David Fry...picked up his first loss of the season in a 3-1 final...it was the fourth loss of his career to the Guardians.

JOE VS. THE TIGERS AGAIN: Facing the Tigers for the eighth time in his career and second consecutive this season...in the previous seven starts he is 4-1, 3.27 ERA (41.1 IP, 15 ER), 17 hits, six walks, 57 strikeouts, 0.92 WHIP and a .205 (32-for-156) opponent batting average...his last win against the Tigers came on September 30, 2022 at Detroit, where he tossed 6.0 shutout innings, five hits, one walk and five strikeouts.

- $m{\Phi}$ His 41.1 innings pitched against the Tigers are now tied with Kansas City Royals for the second most vs. any team in his career.
- # Has 57 career strikeouts vs. Detroit Tigers...are the most against any opponent...has struck out at least eight batters in four of his seven career starts vs Detroit.

HOME COOKING: Through one start in 2024 at home vs. Cleveland Guardians, Ryan has logged 6.0 innings, five hits seven strikeouts and one home run that gave up three runs...Ryan earned his first and only loss this year thus far.

- Fin 33 career home starts, he is 14-10, 3.68 ERA (186.0 IP, 76 ER), 146 hits, 48 walks and 223 strikeouts...Twins are 19-14 in Ryan's 33 home starts.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLIT: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .231/.268/.333, two extra-base hits and one walk in 41 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .179/.207/.393,
