THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY
On this date in 1997, the Orioles became the sixth team in Major League history to lead wire-to-wire as they defeated Toronto, 9-3, to clinch their first American League East title in 14 years...The feat came on the anniversary of their 1971 American League East title, when LHP Mike Cuellar and RHP Pat Dobson each won their 20th game in a doubleheader sweep over Cleveland.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Despite outhitting the Red Sox 11 hits to 10, Baltimore fell to Boston on Wednesday night by a score of 9-1...The O's are now 1-22 when scoring three-or-fewer runs and have also lost six of their last seven games.

- ⚾ **OF Austin Hays** went 3-for-4 with a home run and his now hitting .371 (13-for-35) with a .421 OBP in 10 games since returning from the Injured List on September 14.
- ⚾ **INF Pat Valaika** went 3-for-4 on Wednesday and is now batting .298 (17-for-57) with five extra-base hits in 20 games during the month of September.
- ⚾ **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle** also went 3-for-4 on Wednesday has now reached base safely in 22 of his first 31 games and is batting .330 (36-for-109) with 12 multi-hit games.
- ⚾ **LHP Bruce Zimmermann** made his first career relief appearance and fanned five over 4.0 IP.
- ⚾ The Orioles continue their season-ending, six-game road trip to Boston (0-2) and Buffalo (three games vs. Toronto)...The O's opened the 2020 season with a three-game series win (2-1) in Boston and previously visited Buffalo for a four-game series (1-3) from July 28-31.

ROAD WARRIORS: At 10-13 (.435), the O's own the sixth-best road record in the AL and their road record ranks 16th-best in the majors...O's hitters rank first in the AL and third in the majors with a .267 team batting average on the road...The Orioles rank third in the AL and rank ninth in the majors with a .746 team OPS on the road...O's pitchers own a 4.67 ERA (102 ER/196.2 IP) in 23 games on the road this season to rank seventh in the AL and 16th in the majors.

WAKE ME UP WHEN SEPTEMBER ENDS: According to *teamrankings.com* the O's 2020 strength of schedule (as of September 24) ranks as the toughest in the AL and fourth-toughest in the majors.

- ⚾ During the month of September, O's hitters rank seventh in the AL in OPS (.714), rank seventh in batting average (.249), and are tied for eighth in the AL in home runs (26).
- ⚾ **OF DJ Stewart's** seven home runs are tied for seventh in the AL in September and **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle** is tied for seventh in the AL with 17 RBI, Stewart is tied for 11th in the AL with 15 RBI, and **INF Rio Ruiz** is tied for 21st in the AL with 13 RBI during the month.
- ⚾ The O's 4.32 ERA (87 ER/181.1 IP) during September ranks seventh-best in the AL...O's pitchers have allowed 87 earned runs during the month to tie for sixth-fewest in the AL.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: On the first pitch of a plate appearance, the Orioles rank first in the AL and second in the majors in batting average (.412), and rank second in the AL and fifth in the majors in OPS (1.085), while ranking tied for seventh in the majors in extra-base hits (30)...The Orioles are rank second in the AL and are fourth in the majors in doubles (19), and rank second in the AL in hits (82) as a team on the first pitch.

SMALL BALL FOR ALL: The O's lead the majors with 16 bunt hits this season...**OF Cedric Mullins** leads the majors with nine bunt hits, while **INF Hanser Alberto** is tied for third in the majors with five bunt hits and **INF/OF Andrew Velazquez** is tied for 12th in the majors with two bunt hits.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: Orioles pitchers have allowed just eight runs in the seventh inning this year for a 1.38 ERA (8 ER/52.0 IP)...It is the fewest runs allowed in the seventh inning in the majors, with the second-closest team (Atlanta) allowing 15 runs.

- ⚾ **LHP Tanner Scott** has made nine appearances in the seventh inning (6.1 IP) without allowing a run, while **LHP Paul Fry** has made eight appearances in the seventh inning (6.1 IP) without allowing a run.
- ⚾ On the offensive side, the Orioles have scored 31 runs in the seventh inning, tied for fifth-most in the AL and tied for 10th-most in the majors.

LEADER IN THE CLUBHOUSE: **INF José Iglesias** is hitting .377 (49-for-130) through his first 36 games with the Orioles...Among players with at least 120 at-bats, Iglesias' .377 average leads the majors...**DJ LeMahieu** of the New York Yankees ranks second in the majors with a .360 mark (min. 120 AB)...The last player in the majors to hit over .390 in a season was San Diego's **Tony Gwynn**, who hit .394 during 110 games of the strike-shortened 1994 season.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Since the start of the 2019 season, **INF Hanser Alberto** leads the majors with 104 hits off of left-handed pitching...In that time, he leads the majors with a .391 (104-for-266) average against lefties...This season, Alberto is tied for 15th in the AL among qualifying hitters with a .286 (58-for-203) average against all pitchers.

#F16HT AGAINST COLON CANCER: **INF/OF Trey Mancini** has teamed up with the Colorectal Cancer Alliance to raise awareness for colon cancer...Mancini participates in the organization's "Never Too Young" advisory board, which advocates for all young-onset patients and survivors.

INJURED LIST: Seven players are on the Injured List...**INF Chris Davis** (left knee patellar tendinitis), **RHP Evan Phillips** (right elbow inflammation), **OF Anthony Santander** (right oblique strain), and **RHP Dillon Tate** (retroactive to 9/21; right finger sprain) are on the 10-day Injured List...**LHP Wade LeBlanc** (left elbow stress reaction), **INF/OF Trey Mancini** (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment), and **INF Richie Martin** (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL.

COACHING STAFF: The O's named **Fredi González** as Major League Coach, **Darren Holmes** as Bullpen Coach, and **Anthony Sanders** as First Base Coach...**José Hernández** shifted from Major League Coach to Assistant Hitting Coach...All other coaches remained in their same positions from the 2019 season: **Doug Brocail** as Pitching Coach, **Tim Cossins** as Major League Field Coordinator/Catching Instructor, **José Flores** as Third Base Coach, and **Don Long** as Hitting Coach.

THE SKIPPER: **Brandon Hyde** was named the 20th manager in O's history on December 14, 2018...He began his first Major League managerial role following 16 professional seasons in the coaching ranks and four as a player...Most recently, Hyde served as bench coach for the Chicago Cubs in 2018, his second season in that role (also 2014)...Hyde spent three seasons as the Cubs first base coach from 2015-17, and previously served as Chicago's Director of Player Development from August 2012-2013, after joining the Cubs in December of 2011 as their Minor League Field Coordinator...Prior to joining the Cubs, Hyde spent nine seasons in the Marlins organization.

LAST START: Was dealt his fifth loss after tossing 6.0 innings; only the second time this season that he has thrown 6.0-or-more innings...Was his first Quality Start of the season...Threw a season-high 91 pitches, with 51 for strikes... Allowed two runs on four hits and three walks while tallying five strikeouts... Threw a nine-pitch second inning that featured two one-pitch outs...Recorded a strikeout in each of his first five innings...Since joining the Orioles in March 2018, Cobb has been held winless at Oriole Park, pitching to a 0-11 record with a 5.29 ERA (57 ER/97.0 IP) through 18 starts.

CAREER VS. BOSTON: Has appeared in 19 career games (all starts) against the Red Sox, and owns a 8-6 record with a 3.73 ERA (45 ER/108.2 IP) in these outings...Last faced Boston on 8/22 at Camden Yards and took a no-decision after allowing two runs on six hits (one home run), with one walk and one strikeout over 5.0 innings...Also faced the Red Sox in his first start of this season on 7/25 at Fenway Park, where he earned the win after allowing just one run on four hits, including one home run, and no walks with six strikeouts through 5.1 innings of work.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Owns a career record of 24-24 with a 3.69 ERA (164 ER/399.2 IP) in 69 starts against AL East opponents...He has recorded 34 Quality Starts against AL East foes...Has thrown 6.0-or-more innings in 37 of 69 starts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Cobb is a career 31-27 in 79 road starts with a 4.22 ERA (214 ER/456.1 IP)...Opponents have batted .273 (488-for-1790) against Cobb on the road in his career, while batting just .235 (399-for-1696) against him at home...Each of Cobb's last eight wins have come on the road, with his last home victory coming nearly three years ago on 9/4/17 vs. MIN.

THE TERRIBLE THREES: This season, Cobb has posted a 7.00 ERA (7 ER/9.0 IP) with 14 hits (two doubles, one triple, one home run) and five walks in the third innings of his first nine starts...In his career, he owns a third-inning ERA of 4.80 (80 ER/150.1 IP), which is his highest mark of any inning (min. 50.0 IP).

FINISHING STRONG: In his only full season with the Orioles in 2018, Cobb posted a 2.56 ERA (17 ER/59.2 IP) in the second half of the season, compared to his 6.41 ERA (66 ER/92.2 IP) in the first half...Opponents batted .232 (51-for-220) against Cobb in the second half of 2018, compared to .313 (121-for-386) in the first half...**In his career, Cobb has posted a 12-8 record and 3.66 ERA (65 ER/160.0 IP) through 29 outings (28 starts) in the months of September and October.**

AS AN ORIOLE: Since signing with the Orioles in March 2018, Cobb has started 40 games and pitched to a 6-22 record with a 5.23 ERA (122 ER/210.0 IP) and 144 strikeouts...In his 40 starts, opponents have batted .282 (239-for-847) with 98 extra-base hits (51 doubles, six triples, and 41 home runs)...Through the first six seasons of his career with the Tampa Bay Rays, Cobb owned a 48-35 record and 3.50 ERA (272 ER/700.0 IP) with 570 strikeouts, and held opponents to a .246 (648-for-2639) clip.
