RAYS REPORT—The Rays open a four-game road trip against the Astros tonight in Houston...are coming off a 7-2, nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Astros (2-1), Blue Jays (3-0) and Twins (2-1)...was their fifth time recording seven wins or more on a nine-game homestand, first since going 8-1 from June 22–July 1, 2018 (Stats Perform)...are 7-1 in their last eight games, 9-4 in their last 13, 12-6 in their last 18, 14-9 in their last 23 and 19-13 in their last 32...have gone 10-5 on a stretch of 19 games in 20 days (May 13–June 1) and 7-2 over a span in which 15 of 19 games will take place at home (May 19–June 8)...following the latter stretch, 59 of their remaining 97 games (60.8%) will be on the road...have already played a majors-most 37 home games...are second in the AL East, a season-high-tying 7.0 GB the first-place Yankees (35-20)...have spent two days in first, eight in second, 18 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ★ The Rays registered their second shutout win in their last four games and fifth of the season in yesterday's 5-0, rubber-game win over the Twins, tied for fourth most in the AL behind the Guardians (7G), Royals (6G) and Rangers (6G).
- ★ Tampa Bay has won a season-high three straight, five of six and eight of its last 11 series...it has won four straight home series and four of its last five on the road.
- ★ Entering tonight's contest, the Rays have been ahead or tied at the end of 56 of their last 65 innings dating back to the 8th frame on May 20 vs. HOU...they have not faced a deficit in five of their last six games.
- ★ Tampa Bay has allowed two runs or fewer in six of its last eight games, including four games with one or zero runs...the staff has pitched to a 1.63 ERA (72.0IP, 13ER), 0.93 WHIP and .191/.261/.295 (48-for-251) opp. slash line in that timeframe.
- ★ The Rays have committed only one error in their last nine games...their 36 defensive runs saved are second most in the majors behind the Rangers (38)...over a third have come from major league leader **Taylor Walls** (13).
- ★ The Rays have scored first in five of six, seven of 11 and 11 of their last 16 games compared to only 12 of their first 39 games...they are 17-6 when scoring first, including five straight wins.
- ★ With a win tonight, the Rays would move multiple games over .500 for the first time since entering play on April 4 (4-2).
- ★ Tampa Bay has won back-to-back series openers for the third time this season...its last longer streak was three straight from Sept. 12-22, 2024.
- ★ Houston native **Shane Baz** will make his third career start vs. the Astros and second at Daikin Park...he grew up in nearby Cypress and is a Tomball High School graduate.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, the Rays reinstated **RHP Kevin Kelly** (left gluteal strain) from the 15-day IL and optioned **RHP Connor Seabold** to Triple-A Durham.

- ★ Yesterday, the Rays signed 13-year MLB veteran **RHP Kyle Gibson** to a minor league contract...he will report to Durham.

PITCH PERFECT—Rays pitchers have allowed 3 ER or fewer in six straight games, their longest streak since Sept. 15-24, 2024 (8G)...the staff has turned in a 1.17 ERA (54.0IP, 7ER) over that stretch, its lowest over any six-game span since June 3 (G2)–8, 2023 (1.17)...overall, the Rays have permitted four runs or fewer in a season-best nine straight games, their longest single-season streak since Aug. 28–Sept. 9, 2022 (10G)...Tampa Bay has the most efficient pitching staff in the majors, averaging the fewest pitches per inning at 15.5, which would surpass 2022 (15.8) for the lowest mark in team history and mark the lowest figure in MLB since the 2015 Mets (15.4)...the club has thrown fewer than 130 pitches in five straight games (127, 123, 103, 126, 124), tying the longest streak in Rays history (also: June 23-27, 2010).

- ★ The rotation has permitted 2 ER or fewer in eight straight outings, their longest streak since a 12-start run from Sept. 11-24, 2024...they own a 0.95 ERA (38.0IP, 4ER) across their last six starts, yielding one or zero runs in five of them.
- ★ The Rays 28 quality starts are tied with the Royals for second most in MLB behind the Phillies (30)...nine of their last 11 starts have been quality...they rank fifth among MLB rotations with 310.1 IP on the season—Rays starters are on pace for 214.0 IP, which would mark their most innings since 2016 (920.0IP).
- ★ The Rays bullpen has logged an AL-leading 1.74 ERA (31.0IP, 6ER) over their last 11 games since May 17, second in the majors behind the Cubs (1.13).

HOME RUN RAY-SURGENCE—The Rays have launched 13 HR over their last seven games, recording five multi-homer efforts in that span while outhomering opponents, 13-6...in their first 48 games of the season, they had seven multi-homer performances and were outhomered, 67-40 (-27)...the Rays have hit 21 HR in their last 15 games dating back to May 13, tied with the Astros for second most in the AL behind the Angels (24HR).

- ★ **Brandon Lowe** has 6 HR over his last 13 games since May 15, tied with **SEA Cal Raleigh** and **SD Gavin Sheets** for second most in the majors over that span behind **LAD Shohei Ohtani** (7HR)...the Rays are 9-1 when Lowe homers this season, including seven consecutive wins, and 94-34 in his career.
- ★ **Junior Caminer**'s 10 HR are the most in MLB among players age 22 or younger, outpacing **MIL Jackson Chourio** (8HR)...the 21-year-old's 17 career homers are already the most in club history before turning 23, outpacing **Delmon Young** (15HR).
- ★ **Jonathan Aranda**'s 7 HR are a career high and three shy of his career total entering the season (10HR)...he is 7-for-15 (.467) with 1 2B, 1 HR and 6 RBI during a four-game hitting streak...his .900 OPS on the season ranks seventh in the AL.
- ★ The Rays have homered in 22 of their 28 wins, including each of their last six...they are 13-1 when outhomering an opponent, 9-6 when home runs are even and 6-20 when recording fewer long balls than their opponent.

MEN OF STEAL—The Rays have swiped multiple stolen bases in nine of their last 13 games, going 28-for-31 (90.3%)...their 76 SB on the season lead the majors and are second most through their first 55 games of a season in club history, trailing 2009 (88SB)...the 2025 and 2009 Rays are one of four major league clubs since 2000 with 75 SB or more through 55 games, joining the 2024 Nationals (93SB) and 2024 Reds (84SB)...**José Caballero** has been successful on eight straight stolen base attempts, bringing his season total to 17 SB, third in the AL...since his April 19 major league debut, **Chandler Simpson**'s 16 SB lead the majors—they are also fourth most in the AL all season long (see table to the right)...the club rookie record for a full season is 27 SB, set by **Rocco Baldelli** in 2003.

DAWG POUND—**Brandon Lowe**'s 11-game hitting streak is the second longest of his career, trailing a 12-game run from April 22–May 8, 2019, and is tied for the fourth longest active streak in the majors...during the streak, Lowe is 15-for-39 (.385) with 3 2B, 4 HR, 6 RBI, 3 BB and 5 SO...he has recorded a hit in 14 of his last 15 games overall, slashing .393/.433/.786 (22-for-56) with 10 XBH and 12 RBI...over that span (since May 13), he leads the majors in OPS (1.219), slugging pct. and total bases (T1st, 44) while tying for third in home runs (6HR) and ranking fourth in both hits (22) and batting average.

- ★ Lowe has 112 career doubles, tied with **Toby Hall** for 10th in team history and one shy of **Randy Arozarena** and **Carlos Peña**, who are tied for eighth with 113 apiece.

FROM A LAND DOWN UNDER—**Curtis Mead** is batting .391 (9-for-23) with 1 2B, 3 HR and 4 RBI during a career-high eight-game hitting streak...the streak includes a run of three consecutive games with a homer from May 21-25—he entered that stretch with 2 HR in his first 90 career games.

ASTROWORLD—The Rays and Astros open the second of two series in 2025 this evening...paired with a three-game set at Steinbrenner Field from May 19-21 (2-1 TB), the clubs will complete a seven-game season series over 14 days from May 19–June 1...winners of back-to-back games against Houston (May 20-21), the Rays are looking to claim three straight victories over the Astros for the first time since March 29-31, 2019...they are 11-19 (.367) vs. Houston since that streak concluded, their worst record against any AL opponent in that span...the Rays have won back-to-back series at Daikin Park (2023-24), going 4-2 in those games...they lost four straight series here from 2018-22 (4-8)...with a split this weekend, the Rays would claim their first season series win over the Astros since 2019 (4-3) after going 0-3-1 in the last four (clubs did not meet in 2020).

REHAB UPDATES—**INF Ha-Seong Kim** (recovery from right shoulder surgery) is 2-for-6 (.333) with 1 2B through two games of his rehab assignment with Triple-A Durham. **OF Jake Mangum** (left groin strain) is 6-for-15 (.400) with 1 2B and 3 BB over four games with the Bulls. **OF Travis Jankowski** (left groin strain) began his rehab assignment with Durham last night, going 2-for-2 with 1 2B and 1 BB.

TONIGHT’S START–Shane Baz will take the mound tonight for his 11th start of the year and his first against the Astros...marks his 34th career start and his third against Houston...his 52 strikeouts are tied for the second most among Tampa Bay pitchers...originally acquired from the Pirates as a player to be named later (Aug. 14, 2018) along with **RHP Tyler Glasnow** and **OF Austin Meadows** for **RHP Chris Archer** on July 31, 2018.

LAST TIME OUT–Baz earned the win behind 5.2 innings of one-run ball on May 24 vs. TOR, snapping a streak of three straight losing decisions... he allowed four hits and three walks with four strikeouts in the outing... the lone run came on a **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** homer in the 6th inning... prior to the home run, he had retired nine of the previous 11 batters to come to the plate...he allowed one run or fewer for the fourth time this season and for the first time since April 25 at SD (OR)...

- ✦ He has allowed a home run in five consecutive starts, the longest streak of his career and the longest by a Ray since Taj Bradley allowed a home run in six straight starts (Aug. 12–Sept. 10, 2024).
- ✦ He received three runs of run support in the contest, his second start with two runs of support or more in his last seven...he holds a 5.76 RSA this season with 35 total runs of support...15 of those runs came on April 14 vs. BOS–without that start his RSA is 2.22.

HOUSTON HOMECOMING–The Houston native will be making his third career start against the Astros and second at Daikin Park...in his only previous start in Houston on Aug. 2, 2024, he went 5.1 innings and allowed six hits, two runs and one walk with five strikeouts in a no-decision...his last start against the Astros came on Aug. 13, 2024 when he suffered the loss, despite a quality start with three runs allowed over 7.0 innings...including one start at TEX on July 5, 2024, he has allowed three runs or fewer in all three career starts against teams from Texas.

- ✦ Baz is 1-2 in five career starts against the AL West despite recording four quality starts and allowing three runs or fewer in all five outings...in those starts, he holds a 2.73 ERA (33.0IP, 10ER) with a .217 (26-for-120) opp. average.

MAY-HEM–This season marks the first time in Baz’s career he has pitched before June...he has recorded a 7.82 ERA (25.1IP, 22ER) over five starts in May, allowing opponents to slash .330/.407/.612 (34-for-103)...his 2.45 ERA (29.1IP, 8ER) across five starts in April was 11th lowest among qualified AL pitchers...opponents hit .194/.272/.282 (20-for-103) against him last month.

THE GRAND TOUR–In three road starts this season, he is 1-1 with a 4.08 ERA (17.2IP, 8ER) and 14 strikeouts...he has allowed two home runs in each of his last two road starts...he is 4-5 across 16 career road starts with a 4.00 ERA (81.0IP, 36ER) and a .239 (72-for-301) opp. average...seven of those 16 have been quality starts, and he has allowed three runs or fewer in 12 of 16.

FOILED IN THE FOURTH–He has permitted 12 earned runs in the 4th inning, pitching to a 12.46 ERA (8.2IP, 12ER)...in all other frames, Baz has recorded a 3.52 ERA (46.0IP, 18ER)...opponents are batting .186 (13-for-70) against him in the first two innings compared to .301 (41-for-136) from the 3rd inning on.

GRADING ON A CURVE–Opposing hitters are batting .218 (17-for-78) against his knuckle curve...min. 50 AB, it marks the fifth-lowest average on any pitcher’s curve in the AL, trailing TOR **Brendon Little** (.137), DET **Jack Flaherty** (.145), LAA **José Soriano** (.191) and HOU **Framber Valdez** (.214)...in his career, opponents are 36-for-178 (.202) in at-bats ending with Baz’s curve.

NIGHTRIDER–Baz is 4-1 with a 2.95 ERA (39.2IP, 13ER) in seven starts at night this season, compared to 0-2 with a 10.20 mark (15.0IP, 17ER) in three daytime starts...has allowed more than three runs just once in a night outing (6ER on May 7 vs. PHI) and has conceded five runs or more in all three of his day starts...in his last 11 starts at night dating back to Aug. 20, 2024 at OAK, he holds a 2.47 ERA (65.2IP, 18ER) with 65 SO and a .183 (42-for-229) opp. average...the Rays have gone 7-4 in those starts.

GETTING AHEAD. STAYING AHEAD–Baz is throwing a strike on the first pitch to a 61.4 clip this season, his second straight season above 60 pct. (2024: 63.0%)...opposing hitters are batting .217 (23-for-106) after being in an 0-1 count compared to .282 (20-for-71) after a 1-0 count... opposing hitters are also 11-for-29 (.379) when putting the first pitch in play.

10 FOR 10–Baz struck out a career-high 11 batters on April 14 vs. BOS... paired with his start on April 1 vs. PIT, he became the fifth pitcher since 1901 to record 10 SO or more with no walks in two of his first three starts of a season, joining MIL **Corbin Burnes** and CWS **Lance Lynn** in 2021, WSH **Stephen Strasburg** in 2010 and AZ **Randy Johnson** in 2000 (Stats Perform).

GOING STREAKING–Baz threw 6.0 IP or more with two runs or fewer in six consecutive starts from Sept. 17, 2024–April 14, 2025, tying the longest streak in franchise history (6GS, 5x, last: **Shane McClanahan**, June 20–July 26, 2022)...he was 4-0 with a 1.89 ERA (38.0IP, 8ER) and 0.74 WHIP during the streak, holding opponents to a .160/.218/.252 (21-for-131) slash line with 46 SO and 7 BB.
