THE TWINS: Completed their three-game series/homestand with the Yankees by getting swept in three games...tonight, they will begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Guardians over the weekend, followed by three against the Nationals from Monday-Wednesday.
 ☞ Twins have won 17 of their last 23 games...since April 22, the Twins are tied with the Phillies (17-6) for the most wins in baseball.
 ☞ Twins are looking to avoid losing four consecutive games for the first time since dropping five-straight from April 14-19.

TWINS SWEEPED OUT OF MINNEAPOLIS: The Twins were shut out by the Yankees yesterday afternoon for the second consecutive game and third time this season, losing by a score of 5-0 at Target Field...Joe Ryan (2-3) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR) in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the offense recorded just three hits, drew zero walks and put one man in scoring position...Carlos Correa recorded the club's only extra-base hit with a double, his seventh of the season.

WRONG END OF A STREAK: The Twins enter tonight riding a scoreless inning streak from their offense of 26 innings...their last run scored was a Ryan Jeffers leadoff homer on Tuesday night in Game 1 of the Yankee series...it is tied for the fifth-longest scoreless streak in club history (since 1961)...the other six streaks as long are: 34 from 2014-15, 29 in 1964, 29 in 1978, 27 in 1968, 26 in 1981 and 26 in 1994 (*Elias Sports Bureau*).

"SOMEHOW I MANAGE" BY MICHAEL-SCOTT ROCCO BALDELLI: Rocco Baldelli enters today with 399 career managerial wins...since becoming the Twins manager in 2019, only two AL managers have won more than Rocco: Kevin Cash (444-309) and Aaron Boone (439-314)...14 active managers have reached the 400 wins mark (Bruce Bochy, Bob Melvin, Bud Black, A.J. Hinch, Dave Roberts, Cash, Craig Counsell, Ron Washington, Brian Snitker, Scott Servais, Boone, Torey Lovullo, Alex Cora and Dave Martinez)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial win leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

TWINS AND GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the third of 13 times in 2024...these two last met for what was scheduled as a three-game series at Target Field but was cut short due to rain in Game 3 and postponed/rescheduled as part of a doubleheader for August 9...Cleveland took the first two games on April 4 and 6.

☞ Twins went 3-3 at Progressive Field last season...they won their last series here two games to one from September 4-6, outscoring the Guardians 29-11 in those three games.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .308 (33-for-107) with seven home runs, 14 RBI, a .383 on-base percentage, a .523 slugging percentage and a .907 OPS in 28 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022.
 ☞ Correa has five hits in 14 career at-bats (.357) vs. Triston McKenzie, including two home runs...those homers came on June 22, 2022 at Target Field, one of Correa's 11 career multi-homer games.
 ☞ Christian Vázquez is hitting .306 (33-for-108) with eight doubles, 11 walks and an .805 OPS in 34 career games vs. the Guardians.
 ☞ In his last seven games at Progressive Field, Willi Castro is hitting .421 (8-for-19) with a 1.110 OPS.

SANTANA, LIVE IN CLEVELAND: Carlos Santana has hit .247 (589-for-2385) with 122 doubles, seven triples, 111 home runs, 335 RBI and an .807 OPS in 679 career games at Progressive Field...he made his major league debut in this ballpark on June 11, 2010 vs. Washington, going 0-for-3...he homered, doubled and drove in three the next day...since leaving Cleveland, he has slashed .131/.236/.197 against Guardians pitching...he has five hits in 45 at-bats at Progressive Field since departing, two of which are homers - both of which were in one game for the Royals on July 8, 2021 (off Plesac and Karinchak)...below are all-time Progressive Field ranks:

HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES: The Twins have gone 8-1 in their last nine road games after starting the season 5-7 in their first 12 away from Minneapolis...over the last nine road games, the Twins have hit .295 (96-for-325) with 27 doubles, 10 home runs, 31 walks, a .363 on-base percentage, a .483 slugging percentage, an .846 OPS and 7.4 runs-per-game.

SANTANA PLAYING THE HITS: In his last 20 games (roughly since he and Glen Perkins shook hands pregame in the Anaheim visiting clubhouse), Carlos Santana has posted a .923 OPS with three doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .603 slugging percentage and a 14.1% strikeout rate...in his previous 20 games, he posted a .407 OPS with two doubles, no home runs, three RBI and a 22.5% strikeout rate.

- ⚡ Making sixth MLB start of 2024 and seventh of career (8th appearance)...last pitched May 11 at Toronto, allowing five runs on a career-high eight hits (2 HR) in 4.1 innings with one walk and two strikeouts...didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 10-8 loss.
- ⚡ Has never faced Cleveland or any active Guardians hitters at the MLB level.
- ⚡ His 3.24 ERA ranks third among American League rookies with 25.0-or-more innings pitched this season...tied for fifth on that list with 23 strikeouts.

TROUBLE IN TORONTO: Last pitched May 11 in Toronto, opposite Kevin Gausman, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 10-8 loss...allowed five runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 4.1 innings, with one walk and two strikeouts...allowed a solo home run to Bo Bichette in the second...gave up three-straight hits and two runs to begin the third...Davis Schneider added a solo shot to lead off the fifth...Woods Richardson was pulled from that inning with a runner on first and one out; Cole Sands entered and allowed that inherited runner to score.

- ⚡ Eight hits and two home runs allowed are both MLB career highs.
- ⚡ Induced 10 whiffs on 48 swings (20.8%)...his 19.1 percent whiff rate ranks in MLB's 12th percentile.
- ⚡ Allowed eight hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...Toronto went 6-for-8 with two doubles and a home run (Bichette, 105.3 mph) on those swings...Woods Richardson's 45.3 percent hard-hit rate ranks in MLB's 15th percentile.
- ⚡ Threw the two fastest pitches of his career – 95.4 and 95.3 mph 4-seam fastballs to Cavan Biggio and Justin Turner.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 6 vs. Seattle, opposite Luis Castillo, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-1 victory...allowed one hit in 6.0 scoreless innings with one walk and an MLB career-high eight strikeouts...struck out the first three batters and five of the first six...only baserunners were Mitch Garver (third-inning leadoff single) and Cal Raleigh (fifth-inning leadoff walk).

- ⚡ Generated 10 whiffs on 37 swings (27.0%).
- ⚡ Allowed six hard-hit balls – two lineouts and four flyouts.

ANOTHER NEW OPPONENT: Has never faced Cleveland or any of its active hitters at the MLB level.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Making fourth road start of the season...has gone 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA (14.0 IP, 7 ER), four walks and nine strikeouts on the road, compared to 0-0 with a 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER), two walks and 14 strikeouts in two home starts...has allowed a .304 batting average (17-for-56), .326 BABIP (batting average on balls in play) and .826 OPS on the road, compared to .200 (8-for-40), .296 BABIP and .458 OPS at home.

REVERSE SPLITS: On May 11, Toronto's left-handed hitters went 1-for-4 with a double, a walk and a strikeout vs. Woods Richardson, while its righties went 7-for-16 with a double, two home runs and a strikeout...through five games vs. Woods Richardson this season, left-handed hitters have hit .229 (8-for-35) with a .565 OPS and 23.1 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .279 (17-for-61) with a .735 OPS and 21.5 percent strikeout rate.

- ⚡ Cleveland has hit .227 (247-for-1087) vs. right-handed pitching this season, tied with Baltimore and Chicago-NL for 19th in baseball.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson has used a four-pitch mix in his first five MLB starts this season... here is his 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚡ On May 11, Toronto went 4-for-7 vs. the 4-seamer with an average exit velocity of 99.3 mph...the pitch has allowed a 65.4 hard-hit percentage, the fourth highest in baseball (min. 25 PA).
- ⚡ Toronto hit both home runs off the changeup...Woods Richardson's changeup has allowed an .824 slugging percentage, tied for the eighth highest of 174 pitchers (min. 10 PA).
- ⚡ Slider has allowed an 82.9 mph average exit velocity...Woods Richardson ranks in MLB's 93rd percentile with a breaking ball run value of 4.

GETTING AHEAD: Among the 159 pitchers who've faced 100-or-more batters in 2024, Woods Richardson ranks 13th with a 69.2 first-pitch strike percentage...when he gets ahead 0-1 in the count, opponents have hit .258 (16-for-62) with a .669 OPS and a 23.4 percent strikeout rate...when the count begins 1-0, opponents have hit .231 (6-for-26) with a .644 OPS and 25.0 percent strikeout rate.

- ⚡ MLB average after a first-pitch strike: .211 with a .587 OPS.
- ⚡ MLB average after a first-pitch ball: .250 with a .782 OPS.

ROOKIE RANKS: Among American League rookies who've pitched 25.0-or-more innings, he ranks third with a 3.24 ERA, fourth with a 1.24 WHIP and second with a 3.83 strikeout-to-walk ratio...is tied for fifth (with Emerson Hancock) with 23 strikeouts.

OFF THE GROUND: Has produced a 32.0 percent ground ball rate, 11th lowest in baseball among the 159 pitchers who've faced 100-or-more batters...his 33.3 percent fly ball rate is 18th highest on that list...Minnesota's pitching staff has a 38.4 percent ground ball rate, the fourth lowest in baseball...the staff has allowed 1.2 home-runs-per-9.0-innings, tied for the fourth highest in baseball.

2023 NOTES:

- ⚡ Pitched in Twins spring training for first time in career and was optioned to Triple-A on March 11.
- ⚡ Made two starts for St. Paul from April 9-15...was recalled by Minnesota on April 21 and made a relief appearance for Twins on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts.
- ⚡ Optioned back to St. Paul on April 23.
- ⚡ Pitched a professional career-high 7.0 innings April 28 at Rochester, allowing two runs on three hits.
- ⚡ Earned first win of the season on July 2 vs. Gwinnett, his first of four-straight winning decisions.
- ⚡ Struck out a season-high seven batters July 8 at Iowa (5.0 IP).
- ⚡ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on September 10 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- ⚡ Went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
- ⚡ Made 22 starts and three relief appearances for St. Paul...went 5-6 with a 5.21 ERA (103.2 IP, 60 ER) as a starter, and 2-0 with a 4.30 ERA (14.2 IP, 7 ER) as a reliever.
- ⚡ Ranked second on Saints staff in innings pitched (113.2) and starts (22), and third in strikeouts (96).
- ⚡ Entering 2024, ranked as 24th-best prospect in Twins organization by MLB.com and 29th-best prospect in Twins organization by *Baseball America*.
