TWINS SWEPT OUT OF MINNEAPOLIS: The Twins were shut out by the Yankees yesterday afternoon for the second consecutive game and third time this season, losing by a score of 5-0 at Target Field...Joe Ryan (2-3) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR) in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the offense recorded just three hits, drew zero walks and put one man in scoring position...Carlos Correa recorded the club's only extra-base hit with a double, his seventh of the season.

WRONG END OF A STREAK: The Twins enter tonight riding a scoreless inning streak from their offense of 26 innings...their last run scored was a Ryan Jeffers leadoff homer on Tuesday night in Game 1 of the Yankee series...it is tied for the fifth-longest scoreless streak in club history (since 1961)...the other six streaks as long are: 34 from 2014-15, 29 in 1964, 29 in 1978, 27 in 1968, 26 in 1981 and 26 in 1994 (*Elias Sports Bureau*).

♣ Iwins went 3-3 at Progressive Field last season...they won their last series here two games to one from September 4-6, outscoring the Guards 29-11 in those three games.
