St. Louis is scheduled to play 97 games before the All-Star break, tying the 1969 Cardinals (49-48 record) for the most in franchise history before the break ... A win tonight would give St. Louis 50 wins before the Break for the 2nd-consecutive season and 16th time in franchise history.

NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOES: Alec Burleson (.290, T-8th) and Brendan Donovan (.294, T-5th) are aiming to become the first pair of Cardinals to rank in the National League Top 10 in batting at the All-Star break since 2013: Yadier Molina (.341, 1st) and Allen Craig (.333, 2nd).

HERRERA BEGINS REHAB: C/DH Iván Herrera is scheduled to begin an injury rehabilitation assignment tonight with Memphis (AAA) at AutoZone Park ... Herrera has missed the previous 18 games due to a left hamstring strain suffered on June 19 at the Chicago White Sox.

ON-BASYN WINN: Masyn Winn has reached base safely in his last 16 home games (June 5-present), tying Willson Contreras (April 25-June 6) and Brendan Donovan (April/11-May/19) for the longest such home streak on the team this season.

BURLY YOU CAN'T BE SERIOUS: Alec Burleson has reached base safely in his first 13 career games vs. Washington, longest streak by a Cardinal to begin their career against the Expos/Nationals in franchise history.

Day One features the first 105 selections (Rounds 1-3) and begins at 5:00 p.m. CT on ESPN and MLB Network . Day Two on Monday includes Rounds 4-20 and starts at 10:30 a.m. CT.

- St. Louis has 21 overall selections over the two-day period, including four picks on Day One: #5 (1st round), #55 (2nd round), #72 (Competitive Balance Round B), and #89 (3rd round).
- St. Louis drafted INF JJ Wetherholt with the 7th overall pick from West Virginia last season, while Sunday's 5th overall pick is the franchise's highest since J.D. Drew (#5 in 1998) and marks the first time in franchise history having consecutive top 10 selections.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Makes his 200th career start with 190 of those coming with the Cardinals. This marks his 18th start of the season.
- Surrendered a franchise record six home runs in his last start vs. CHI (7/4) at Wrigley Field en route to a franchise record eight total home runs (King - 2) allowed by the Cardinals.

- Five of the six home runs allowed were solo home runs. Of pitchers who have allowed six home runs in MLB history, pitched the longest outing (6.0) since Tommy Thomas of the St. Louis Browns (6/27/1936) vs. NYY.
- Trails Dizzy Dean (1930-37) by six starts for 12th place all-time in Cardinals history.
- St. Louis is 8-9 in his starts this season. The Cardinals lost each of his first 5 games started to begin the season, then won 7-straight from April 30-June 5.
- Mikolas is one of just 3 MLB pitchers to have made as many as 189 starts exclusively with one team since he joined the Cardinals in 2018; also Aaron Nola, PHI & Kyle Freeland, COL
- Receiving an average of 3.43 run support per game, 6th-lowest in MLB.
- Opened the season with 29.0 homerless IP (March 31-April 30); averaged 2.31 HR/9 IP since May 1.
- 13 of his 20 walks (65.0%) issued this season and 14 of his 60 strikeouts have come on 3-2 pitches.
- At age 36 (turns 37 on August 28), Miles is the oldest player on the team's active roster.
- Has entered his 8th season (was injured for all of 2020) with the Cardinals in 2025; Leads active pitchers in innings pitched (1,086.0), wins (64), strikeouts (789) and games started (188) as a Cardinal.
- The Cardinals are 103-89 in his 188 career starts with St. Louis and Miles holds a 64-64 mark as a Cardinal.
