BIRDLAND BITES: The Birds continue a six-day, six-game road trip this afternoon against the Mariners (2-0, 1 to play) and Athletics (3 to play)...The O's have won eight of their last 10 games after going 3-16 in their previous 19.

- Baltimore has won a season-best five straight games, its longest streak since June 7-12, 2024 (6 G).
- Last night marked the Birds' second win of the season when trailing after six innings, joining May 21 at Milwaukee (trailed 2-1, won 8-4 in 11 innings).
- With a win today, the O's can earn their second sweep of the year, including their first sweep of the Mariners since August 28-30, 2017...The Birds have not swept a series at T-Mobile Park since September 17-19, 2012.
- The O's have allowed two runs or fewer in a season-best five straight games, their longest single-season run since June 8-12, 2024 (5 G)...They last did so in six straight games from April 29-May 5, 2024 (7 G).
- Prior to last night's victory, Baltimore was 2-10 this season when recording four hits or fewer, with wins on April 12 vs. Toronto (4 H, 5-4) and April 24 at Washington (4 H, 2-1).
- Baltimore has won four straight road games and is 7-5 away from Camden Yards since May 9 after dropping six straight from April 26-May 8...The Birds last won five straight on the road from May 23-June 4, 2024 (6 G).
- Oriole pitching has struck out 8+ batters in a season-high nine straight games, marking the clubs' longest run since June 7-16, 2024 (10 G)...It is the longest active streak by any team in MLB, and is tied for the fourth longest overall by any club in 2025 behind the Astros (12 G) and Giants/Yankees (both 10 G).
- The Orioles have drawn at least one walk in 138 straight games since July 2, 2024, the longest active stretch in the majors ahead of the Braves (82 G) and Cubs (63 G)...It's the second-longest such streak in franchise history behind a 155-game stretch from June 23, 1955-June 24 (G1), 1956.

NIP AND TUCK: The O's have won each of their last four one-run affairs since May 24 (G2) at Boston and are 8-7 overall in such contests this season...It marks the first time Baltimore has won four straight one-run contests since June 28-July 14, 2024...The Birds last won five in a row from July 2-24, 2023 (6 G).

- Their 15 one-run games are tied with Cincinnati for the third fewest in MLB, ahead of the Angels (14 G) and Cubs/Guardians (both 13 G).

SEATTLE SNIP-ITS: Colton Cowser has reached base safely in each of his first eight career games against Seattle, going 9-for-23 (.391) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, and eight walks...He is the first Oriole to reach safely in each of his first eight career games against the Mariners since Manny Machado (9 G) from September 17, 2012-August 4, 2013.

- Through two games this series, **Adley Rutschman** is 4-for-9 (.444), including a game-tying homer last night...Prior to that, he was 5-for-56 (.089) with one double, one home run, and four RBI in 14 career games opposite Seattle to open his career.

START ME UP: In 14 games since May 20, Baltimore starters have gone 6-1 with a 2.47 ERA (21 ER/76.2 IP), the fifth-lowest ERA by any starting staff in the majors during that period...The O's rotation entered that stretch with a 6.03 ERA (175 ER/226.2 IP), second highest in MLB ahead of the Rockies (6.95).

- Overall, Baltimore pitching owns a 4.02 ERA (60 ER/134.1IP) since May 19, ranking 18th in the majors...Removing infielder **Emmanuel Rivera**'s outing (1.0 IP, 8 ER) on May 23 at Boston, however, the collective ERA falls to 3.51, which would rank 11th in MLB.

A MAY TO REMEMBER: **Ryan O'Hearn** slashed .365/.450/.542 (35-for-96) with five doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, and 13 walks in 26 games last month, ranking among MLB leaders in batting average (5th) and on-base percentage (7th), while his .992 OPS ranked sixth in the AL...His .365 batting average and .450 on-base percentage were each the highest marks by an Oriole in the month of May (min. 100 PA) since **Brian Roberts** (.385, .485) in 2007.

- Despite seeing his career-best 19-game on-base streak come to an end yesterday, it matched **Gunnar Henderson** (4/23-5/14) for the longest run by an Oriole this season.
- O'Hearn has an MLB-best four games with 3+ hits since May 21, outpacing CLE's Steven Kwan, ATH's Brent Rooker, and ATH's Jacob Wilson (each 3 G)...He has five such performances overall in 49 games this year after having two across 142 games in 2024.
- Overall, O'Hearn ranks among MLB leaders in batting average (4th, .328), on-base percentage (5th, .415), and OPS (7th, .940).

ROLE REVERSAL: The Birds have permitted 89 home runs, the second highest mark in the majors behind the Athletics (96 HR)...Over their last 10 games, however, they have only allowed seven long balls after allowing 26 over their previous 13 games.

- The O's have allowed one or zero home runs in six straight games, matching their season-long six-game stretch to open the season from March 27-April 2...They last went seven straight games with allowing one or zero long balls from August 4-15, 2024 (10 G).

RISPY BUISNESS: O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .195 (16-for-82) clip with runners in scoring position since May 24, the fifth-lowest mark in the majors during that period behind the Mets (.147), Rays (.170), Brewers (.183), and Rangers (.191)...Baltimore entered that period with a .290 opponent RISP average, fourth highest in MLB ahead of Colorado (.299), Miami (.298), and Washington (.294).

- Offensively, the Birds have totaled 229 at-bats with runners in scoring position since May 8, second most in MLB behind the Sox (234 AB)...Their .231 RISP average during that period ranks 19th in MLB.

EMERALD CITY CLASH: The O's and Mariners continue a six-game season set today in Seattle...The clubs will meet for a three-game series at Oriole Park at Camden Yards from August 12-14...Baltimore is 10-3 against Seattle since June 24, 2023, including a 6-2 mark at T-Mobile Park.

- Birds outfielder **Heston Kjerstad** was originally selected by the Mariners in the 36th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign.
- Baltimore Pitching Strategy Coach **Ryan Klimek** was a Minor League Video Intern with the Mariners in 2015.
- Orioles Director, Pitching Development **Forrest Herrmann** was a Pitching Strategist with Seattle in 2019.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his fifth start since being placed on the 15-day Injured List (right lat strain) on April 9, retroactive to April 8...Has recorded a 5.64 ERA (14 ER/22.1 IP) in four starts since returning from the IL...Made one rehab appearance with High-A Aberdeen on May 4 and tossed 4.0 scoreless innings, scattering two hits and two walks with four strikeouts...Was acquired by the O's from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Jackson Baumeister, INF/OF Mac Horvath, and OF Matthew Etzel on July 26, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on May 30 vs. Chicago-AL after tossing a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings on four hits and one walk with a season-high six strikeouts... Notched his ninth career start of 7.0+ scoreless innings (last: 8/9/24 at TB)...Threw a season-high 99 pitches, 67 strikes.
👉 Is the second Oriole this season to record 7.0 scoreless frames, joining Dean Kremer (5/2 vs. KC).

NOW YOU SEA ME: Eflin has made two career starts opposite the Mariners, going 1-0 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER/11.0 IP)...Last faced the club on September 10, 2023 at Tropicana Field with Tampa Bay, securing the win after allowing three runs on seven hits and two walks with six strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
👉 Through 13 career appearances (12 GS) against the AL West, he has gone 6-3 with a 3.86 ERA (31 ER/72.1 IP) and 68 strikeouts against 15 walks.

IN CONTROL: Eflin has walked six batters across 40.1 innings, producing a 3.73 percent walk rate, the fifth-lowest mark among all MLB starters (min. 150 BF) behind DET's Tarik Skubal (2.47%), SEA's Bryan Woo (3.26%), STL's Matthew Liberatore (3.46%), and TB's Zack Littell (3.70%).
👉 He produced a 3.51 pct. walk rate in 2024, fourth lowest among all qualified MLB pitchers behind SEA's George Kirby (2.96%), CIN's Nick Martinez (3.16%), and STL's Miles Mikolas (3.47%).
👉 From June 14, 2022-July 10, 2024, Eflin issued two walks or fewer in 51 consecutive starts, the eighth-longest such streak in MLB since 1901 behind MIN's/PHI's Carlos Silva (99), BOS' Cy Young (85), SEA's George Kirby (64, active), MIN's Phil Hughes (64), MIN's Brad Radke (62), NYG's Carl Hubbell (61), and BOS/SD's David Wells (59).

OUT OF THE HOLE: This season, batters in the first to sixth holes are batting .229/.265/.486 (25-for-109) with 14 extra-base hits (7 2B, 7 HR) while batters seven through nine are slashing .310/.341/.548 (13-for-42) with six extra-base hits (4 2B, 2 HR)...Nineteen of his 24 punchouts on the year have come against the first six hitters in the order.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: From July 24, 2024, to May 11, 2025, Eflin allowed three runs or fewer in a career-best 14 straight starts...Before his streak was snapped on May 18, the 14-start stretch tied with SD's Michael King for the longest active streak in the majors...During that stretch, he went 8-3 with a 2.79 ERA (26 ER/84.0 IP).

FOLLOW THE LEADER: In 15 starts since joining the O's, Eflin is 9-4 with a 3.39 ERA (36 ER/95.2 IP), with the Birds going 11-5 in his starts...Through his first 13 starts with the Orioles, he held a 2.76 ERA, which was the 15th lowest by an Oriole starter through their first 13 starts with the club in franchise history (since 1954), including the fifth lowest since 2000 behind **Jeremy Guthrie** (2.16, 2007), **Corbin Burnes** (2.26, 2024), **John Means** (2.65, 2019), and **Austin Voth** (2.67, 2022).

OPENING DAY RECAP: Eflin became the 44th Opening Day starter in Orioles history (since 1954)...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he became one of six starting pitchers since 1882 to make back-to-back Opening Day starts against the same opponent as a member of two different teams, joining Madison Bumgarner (2019 w/SF & 2020 w/AZ vs. SD), Wes Ferrell (1937 w/BSA & 1938 w/WAS vs. PHA), Sad Sam Jones (1921 w/BSA & 1922 w/NYY vs. WAS), Duke Esper (1894 w/WAS & 1895 w/BAL vs. PHI), and George Derby (1882 w/DET & 1883 w/BUF vs. CLE).

vs. ATHLETICS: Set to make his third career start against the Athletics...Has pitched to a 5.23 ERA (6 ER/10.1 IP) through his previous two outings against the club...Last faced the Athletics on April 12, 2023 at Oriole Park, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR), two walks, and one hit batter with one strikeout in 4.1 innings.
