NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON

The Washington Nationals finish off their season series with the Milwaukee Brewers today in the final game of this three-game set...Milwaukee defeated Washington yesterday, 4-1.

- **Foster Griffin** worked 6.0 innings and did not allow an earned run...He lowered his ERA to 2.27, good for fourth in the National League and 10th in Major League Baseball.
- With a win today, the Nationals would win a season series against the Brewers for just the second time since 2016...The Nationals only other winning season over Milwaukee in the last 10 years was 2024 (4-2).
- The Nationals will enjoy a home off day tomorrow before taking on the Minnesota Twins from Tuesday to Thursday.

HIGH DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

Per Baseball Reference, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.4 runs per game more than the league average team...Washington is tied with Miami for the Major League lead with 22 games against teams .500 or better.

- Including today's game, 13 of the Nationals 16 home games have come against teams .500 or better.
- Washington is 9-13 against teams .500 or better this season and has already played four teams in the top six in wins in Major League Baseball.

START ME UP

Washington's starters have posted a 2.86 ERA (14 ER/44.0 IP) with 47 strikeouts and 12 walks across the last eight games since April 23...Their ERA is good for third in the National League (6th in MLB) during that span.

- **Foster Griffin** has pitched to a 2.27 ERA with 33 strikeouts in seven starts this season...He has not allowed an earned run in back-to-back starts...Griffin set career-highs in both innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (8) in his scoreless start against the White Sox on April 26.
- **Cade Cavalli** struck out at least 10 batters for the second consecutive start...He has struck out 25 batters with just two walks over his last three starts.
- **Jake Irvin** has 18 strikeouts against four walks in his last three starts.

HOME SWEET HOMERS

The Nationals are averaging 1.40 home runs per game at home, good for fifth in Major League Baseball and third in the National League...Washington is tied for ninth in MLB in home runs at home with 21 despite playing only 15 games at Nationals Park.

- **James Wood's** eight home runs at home are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with **Kyle Schwarber's** eight at Citizens Bank Park and **Byron Buxton's** eight at Target Field.

ROAD WARRIORS

Washington is 12-7 on the road this season and have taken at least a share of five of their first six series away from home, including four straight...The Nationals 12 wins on the road are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with the Yankees and Braves.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with 177 runs, tied for the second most by a Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) through its first 34 games with the 2009 Nationals and behind the 2017 National League East champion Nationals (209).

- Washington has scored 32 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have scored 65 runs in the seventh inning or later, the second most in MLB and most in NL.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 21 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

WHAT A RELIEF

Washington's bullpen ranks fourth in Major League Baseball and second in the National League with a 1.35 ERA since April 25...In all they are 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (4 ER/26.2 IP) and 20 strikeouts in the last seven games...They are also one of just four bullpens to not allow a home run since April 25.

- **Brad Lord** has allowed just two earned run with six strikeouts and two walks in his last five games (11.0 innings)...He has allowed two or fewer baserunners in four of those outings.
- **PJ Poulin** is 2-0, allowing three earned runs on nine hits with four strikeouts in his last 10 games (three starts)...Eight of the 10 games have been scoreless.
- **Paxton Schultz** recorded his first career save on April 26 at Chicago (AL).
- Over his last nine games, **Gus Varland** has pitched to a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) with nine strikeouts...He has recorded his first three career saves during this span.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood has placed himself among the league leaders...See chart to the right.

- Wood leads Major League Baseball in on-base percentage (.455) and runs (26) since April 5...He also ranks tied for second in home runs (9) and third in OPS (1.072) during that span. This comes after starting the season 4-for-26 (.111) in eight games from March 26 to April 4.

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 26 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 60 starts and maintain an ERA under 4.05 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-27 with a 3.99 ERA in 80 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.
- His 4.2% walk rate since the start of 2023 is the third-best mark in MLB.

LAST START

Littell allowed four earned runs on five hits (2 HR) with a strikeout and three walks in 3.2 innings of work on April 28 against the New York Mets.

vs. MILWAUKEE

Littell is set to make his fifth career start against the Brewers...He has made 14 total appearances against Milwaukee.

- He has gone 0-1, holding a 2.35 ERA on 26 hits and eight earned runs through 30.2 innings.

2025

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).
- Made his Reds debut on Aug. 5 at Chicago (NL)...Became the fifth pitcher in Reds history with at least 7.0 innings, one run or fewer allowed and at least eight strikeouts in his team debut (also: Brady Singer, 3/31/25 vs TEX; Johnny Cueto, 4/3/08 vs AZ; Mo Sanford, 8/9/91 at SD; Tom Seaver, 6/18/77 at MON).
- 2025 Pitch Mix:** Slider (27.5%) Split Finger (27.3%) Four Seamer (23.8%) Sinker (16.0%) Sweeper (5.4%)

2024

In his first full season as a starter, went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA in his seventh Major League season.

- Led the Rays in wins (T1st, 8), innings (156.1), starts (29) and quality starts (T1st, 10)...All were career highs.
- From April 17-May 4, recorded at least six strikeouts without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...On May 11 vs. New York (AL), he walked Anthony Rizzo in the second inning to end a streak of 123 BF without walk, the fourth longest in franchise history.
- Went 5-3 with a 1.82 ERA (10 ER/49.1 ER) over his final nine starts from July 27 on and ranked second in the AL (4th in MLB) in ERA.
- Received two or fewer runs of support in 22 of 29 starts, including 17 of his final 20...His 3.22 run support average was the lowest in MLB and lowest in Rays history (prev. Tony Saunders, 3.51 in 1998).
- 2024 Pitch Mix:** Slider (34.8%) Split Finger (23.2%) Four Seamer (22.3%) Sinker (14.6%) Sweeper (5.1%)

2023

Appeared in 28 games (4 starts) between the Red Sox and the Rays...Converted to the starting rotation with the Rays on July 19.

- Ranked among MLB leaders after the All-Star break in walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 0.89), walk rate (2nd, 2.4%) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 7.86).
- In 14 starts, went 3-5 with a 3.41 ERA (27 ER/71.1 IP) and 1.05 WHIP.
- Pitched in Game 2 of the AL Wild Card vs. Texas...Tossed 2.0 hitless innings and struck out three while hitting one batter
