TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants returned home from a seven-day, six-game road trip to Arizona (1-2) and Texas (2-1) to open a six-game homestand against the Astros (today-Wednesday) and Angels (Friday-Sunday).

- ▶ Despite their recent season-high six-game losing streak from May 29-June 4, the Giants have still won 13 of their last 22 games...their 5.36 runs per game ranks fourth in MLB, .591 winning percentage is tied for fifth and their .747 OPS ranks eighth in the Majors over that span (since May 15).

HOUSTON, WE HAVE A PROBLEM!: The Giants took two of three games from the Astros when the teams met last year in Houston...San Francisco is looking for its third straight series win in the matchup after losing three straight prior to that.

- ▶ Dating back to August 11, 2020, the Giants have won five of their last eight games against Houston, despite a -2 run differential (36-38).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: San Francisco is currently in a stretch where they face American League teams for four of five series, including its current nine-game stretch against Texas, Houston and Los Angeles-AL.

- ▶ The Giants are 4-8 in Interleague play early this season... they had only faced two American League opponents (Tampa Bay and Boston) all season prior to this stretch.

A HAPPY HOME: The Giants are 17-14 at home this season, compared to a 15-20 record on the road...however, SF has dropped each of their last four games at Oracle Park.

- ▶ Giants pitchers have posted a 3.88 ERA with a .251 opponents average over 31 games on the Shores of McCovey Cove, compared to a 4.94 ERA with a .262 opponents average over 35 road games.
- ▶ Offensively, SF has an OPS of .719 on the road this season and .672 at home...that is the second-largest such split (road higher) in the Majors this season (Mets, +.129) (*Stats, LLC*).

ADIÓS PELOTA: The Giants have now homered in eight straight games, dating back to June 1...SF's 13 home runs in June are the most in the National League, and rank fourth in the Majors behind Baltimore (23), Houston (16) and Chicago-AL (14).

- ▶ The Giants have scored 14 of their last 19 runs via homers, dating back to June 5 at Arizona.
- ▶ The Giants have 43 home runs on the road, which are the most in the National League and third-most in MLB behind New York-AL (51) and Baltimore (51).
- ▶ SF has just 21 homers at home this season, which is the fewest by a team at home in the Majors.

VAMOS RAMOS: OF Heliot Ramos has been a bright spot for SF since his call-up on May 8...since June 1, he is batting .400 (12x30) with six runs, a double, four home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.347 OPS in eight games.

- ▶ He has reached base in 26 of his 29 games this year, and is slashing .314/.405/.533 with 13 runs, five doubles, six home runs and 23 RBI.
- ▶ In the 28 games Ramos has started, the Giants are averaging 5.2 runs per game and hitting .256, compared to 3.6 runs per game and a .237 average when he doesn't (*SIS*).

HARRY'S GOT STYLE: LHP Kyle Harrison takes the hill tonight for his 14th start of the year.

- ▶ The Giants are 9-4 (.692) overall this season when Harrison starts and 23-30 (.434) when anyone else does...last season, San Francisco was 3-4 (.429) in his starts.
- ▶ However, Harrison has lost back-to-back starts against the Phillies and D-Backs...over those two outings, he's posted a 5.73 ERA (7er, 11.0ip) with a .400 opponent batting avg.

CHAPSTICK: IF Matt Chapman enters tonight's game with a 25-game on-base streak...the streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors behind NYY's Aaron Judge (35), TEX's Corey Seager (28) and STL's Paul Goldschmidt (26).

- ▶ The 25-game streak is the longest by a Giant since **IF Eduardo Núñez** reached base in 33 straight games from May 12-July 16, 2017.
- ▶ He has a slash line of .295/.407/.526 with 22 runs, four home runs and 14 RBI over the streak...his 10 doubles in that span (since May 11) are tied for the third-most in MLB.
- ▶ Chapman is tied for the team lead in hits (59), home runs (8) and stolen bases (5)...there are three other players leading their teams in all three categories this season (Elly De La Cruz, Jose Ramirez and Bobby Witt Jr.) (*Stats, LLC*).

LATE NIGHT HEROICS: In the seventh inning or later this season, the Giants have a team batting average of .265 with 195 hits...both of those marks are the best in the majors in 2024 (*Stats, LLC*)...in comparison, SF is hitting .236 over inning 1-6.

DOWN ON THE FARM: The Giants organization had two minor league players named pitchers of the week for their respective leagues last week:

- ▶ **RHP Tommy Romero** was named pitcher of the week in the PCL after two outings against Albuquerque where he combined to toss 11.2-scoreless innings with 10 Ks...his 2.83 ERA this year is tied for the lowest figure across all Triple-A.
- ▶ **LHP Dylan Carmouche** was named pitcher of the week for the California League after earning the win at Stockton on June 8...he tossed 50-scoreless innings, allowing just two hits with eight strikeouts.

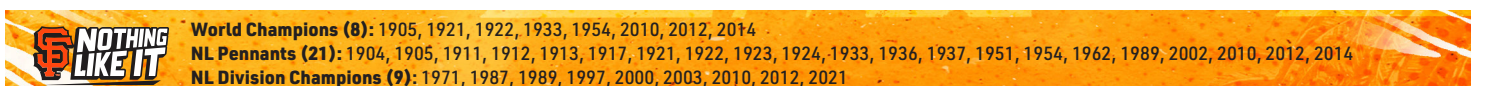
This Date in Giants History

TODAY'S START: Harrison is scheduled to make his 14th start of the season today in the first game of this three-game series against the Astros...Harrison is 4-3 with a 4.18 ERA (33er, 71.0ip) in his 13 starts this season...**the Giants are 9-4 in his starts this season, losing each of his last two after having won his previous eight.**

LAST TIME OUT: Was charged with his third loss of the season last Tuesday at Arizona in SF's 8-5 defat to the Diamondbacks...gave up four runs (three earned) on eight hits in 6.0 innings...his fast-ball topped out at 95.3 mph, but six of his eight hits allowed came when he was ahead or even in the count.

SNAP THE STREAK: Harrison has lost back-to-back starts to the Phillies and Diamondbacks, allowing seven earned runs on 20 hits in 11.0 innings (5.73 ERA, .400 opp. AVG).

NO FREE PASSES: Has limited his walks thus far this season, allowing 22 free passes in 71.0 innings (2.79 BB/9)...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings.

FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues...opposing hitters are 34-for-110 (.309) with five homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball...they're 43-for-168 (.256) in at-bats ending with the four-seam...last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 63.1% of the time, highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 400 pitches.

3RD TIME THE CHARM: When he's gotten to the third time through the batting order, it's gone very well...batters are hitting .221 (15-for-68) off him with just six RBI.

GETTING THAT LAST ONE IS TOUGH: Opponents have a slash line of .319/.385/.511 off Harrison with two outs.

2023 SEASON: Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A...Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia.

ABOUT KYLE: Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 6/8 at TEX, SV, 1.0ip, h, bb (22 pitches)

- ▶ Converted his 11th save of the season Saturday night.
- ▶ Issued 18 walks in 25.1ip...his 15.4% walk rate is in the bottom 4% of the league.
- ▶ Over his last six games dating to May 24, he's allowed five runs on eight hits in 5.2 innings (7.94 ERA) while converting three of four save opportunities.
- ▶ Has struck out 31 batters over 25.1 innings of work (11.01 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 17 of his 31 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Lefties are hitting .294 (15-for-51) off him.
- ▶ In 13 non-save situations, he is 2-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip), eight hits allowed (two homers), 11 walks and 16 strikeouts.

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Cutter, Changeup, Knuckle Curve

Last Game: 6/5 at ARI; W, 1.1ip, h, r, er, hr, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last four outings, he's thrown 6.2 innings and allowed just one run (solo HR) on two hits with four strikeouts.
- ▶ Has recorded at least five outs in 10 of his 17 games w/SF.
- ▶ Since April 30, Hjelle has a 2.11 ERA (5er, 21.1ip) with 23 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has a 64.4% ground ball rate this year.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 6/9 at TEX; 1.0ip, h (8 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed nine runs in 9.2ip over his last 10 games dating to May 13...four of those nine runs came on June 4 at Arizona.
- ▶ Allowed all four of his inherited runners to score so far in 2024.
- ▶ Lefties are 10-for-29 (.345) off him with six RBI...righties are just 9x41 (.220).
- ▶ Has a 9.64 ERA on the road (9.1ip) and a 2.08 ERA at home (8.2ip).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 6/8 at TEX; W, 1.0ip, h, 2k (19 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his first career Major League win Saturday night after throwing 1.0 scoreless inning with two strikeouts.
- ▶ Has served as an opener four times this season...allowed one run on two hits in 4.2 innings in those four starts (1.93 ERA).
- ▶ Over his last 11 games dating to May 15 he's allowed two runs (one earned) in 9.2 innings (0.93 ERA) with 14 strikeouts.
- ▶ LHBs are 5-for-38 (.132) off him and RHBs are 14-for-66 (.212) with five home runs (one inside the park) and nine RBI.
- ▶ Opponents are 7-for-46 (.152) off his changeup with 13 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has allowed 15 walks in 30.0 innings.

#73 RANDY RODRÍGUEZ ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 6/9 at TEX; 1.2ip, h, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and made his MLB debut on May 4 at Philadelphia.
- ▶ Has held hitters scoreless in eight of his last 10 appearances dating to May 17...allowed just four runs with 13 strikeouts in that stretch (12.2ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are just 3-for-their-last-27 (.111) off him.
- ▶ Has thrown 4+ outs in seven of his 13 MLB outings...had only pitched more than 1.0ip in two of his 10 Triple-A appearances this season.
