YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles were shut out by the Cubs, 8-0, as they failed to avoid the three-game series sweep...Have been swept for the third time this year, joining May 20-22 at St. Louis (3 G) and June 21-23 at Houston (3 G)...Were swept at home for the first time since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (3 G); snapped a streak of 71 consecutive multi-game home series without being swept, which was the second-longest such streak in team history behind an 85-series streak from September 1978 to June 1982, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Were shut out for the fourth time this season and in consecutive games for the first time since June 23-24, 2021; marked their first time being shut out in consecutive home games since September 11-19, 2022 (2 G), and in consecutive home games in the same homestand since August 4-5, 2020 (2 G)...The O's have only been shut out in three straight games twice in team history: July 29-31, 1957 and September 25-27, 2015.

ALL-STAR: Five Orioles have been selected to the All-Star Game: **Corbin Burnes**, **Gunnar Henderson**, **Adley Rutschman**, **Anthony Santander**, and **Jordan Westburg**...Henderson (SS) and Rutschman (C) won the fan vote and will start for the AL, marking the first time the Orioles have had multiple starters in a Midsummer Classic since **Adam Jones** and **Nelson Cruz** in 2014... Burnes earned his fourth consecutive selection as a result of the Player Ballot...Santander and Westburg were added to the roster as replacements for Houston's Kyle Tucker and Boston's Rafael Devers, respectively...This marks the first time the O's have had five representatives at a Midsummer Classic since 2016, when they sent **Brad Brach**, **Zack Britton**, **Manny Machado**, **Mark Trumbo**, and **Matt Wieters**...Henderson, Santander, and Westburg each earned their first career All-Star nod.

- 👉 Rutschman received 70 percent of the vote to defeat Kansas City's Salvador Perez; he's an All-Star for the second time (2023) and earned his first starting assignment; he'll become the third O's backstop (fourth occurrence) to start an All-Star Game, along with **Gus Triandos** in 1958 and 1959, and **Terry Kennedy** in 1987; Wieters was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).
- 👉 Henderson beat Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. with 65 percent of the vote; he is the first Orioles shortstop sent to the Midsummer Classic since Machado started in 2018.
- 👉 Burnes becomes the first Orioles starting pitcher to be named an All-Star since **John Means** in 2019.
- 👉 Santander joins **Austin Hays** (2023) and **Cedric Mullins** (2021) as outfielders to represent the O's at the All-Star Game in the last four seasons.
- 👉 Westburg is the first Orioles third baseman to be selected to the All-Star Game since Machado in 2016.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 147 home runs, 13 more than the second-place Yankees (134) and 21 more than the Dodgers (126), who are third...The team record for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

- 👉 Baltimore has seven players with at least 10 home runs, tied with San Diego for the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (27), **Anthony Santander** (23), **Adley Rutschman** (16), **Jordan Westburg** (15), **Colton Cowser** and **Ryan Mountcastle** (12), and **Ryan O'Hearn** (11).
- 👉 Henderson and Santander are one of three duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season, along with Cleveland's José Ramirez and Josh Naylor, and New York-AL's Aaron Judge and Juan Soto; only five other teams have one player with at least 20 homers - Braves (Ozuna), Diamondbacks (Walker), Dodgers (Ohtani), Phillies (Harper), and Red Sox (Devers).
- 👉 The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).
- 👉 The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.
- 👉 **Anthony Santander** led MLB with 13 home runs last month, the most in June in team history; he tied with **Nelson Cruz** (13 in May 2014) and **Frank Robinson** (13 in July 1966), and finished behind **Jim Gentile** (15 in August 1961) for the most home runs hit in a month by an Oriole.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** will participate in the 2024 T-Mobile Home Run Derby in Arlington...He will be the third Oriole in the last four seasons to hit in the derby, joining **Adley Rutschman** (2023) and **Trey Mancini** (2021)...Two Orioles have won a Home Run Derby, both shortstops: **Cal Ripken, Jr.** at Toronto's SkyDome in 1991 and **Miguel Tejada** at Houston's Minute Maid Park in 2004.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a six-game homestand tonight with the first of three games against the Yankees, which will conclude the pre-All-Star break schedule...After being swept in three games by the Cubs to open the homestand, the Orioles are guaranteed their first non-winning homestand since September 11-17, 2023, when they went 3-4...At 29-20 (.592), the O's own the fifth-best home record in the AL this year and the ninth-best in MLB...Since the start of 2023, the Birds have gone 78-52 (.600) at Oriole Park, the best home record in the AL and the fifth-best home record in MLB behind the Brewers (.621, 77-47), Dodgers (.633, 81-47), Braves (.638, 81-46), and Phillies (.649, 85-46).

AGAINST THE YANKEES: The Orioles and Yankees begin the third of four series with the eighth of 13 overall matchups this season tonight in Charm City...The O's are currently 2.0 games up on the Yanks in the AL East...The Orioles took three out of four in Baltimore from April 29 to May 2 and two of three in the Bronx from June 18-20, including a 17-5 win in the rubber game of that series...The Birds will travel to Yankee Stadium to conclude the season series from September 24-26 (3 G)...The Orioles won the season series (7-6) against the Yankees last year for the first time since doing so in three straight years from 2014-16...The Orioles are 12-8 (.600) against New York since the start of last season.

AL BEAST: Entering the current series, the Orioles have gone 22 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, going 16-0-6 in series during that time and 49-23 (.681) overall... That is the longest streak by a team against its own division without a series loss since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

- 👉 The O's are 19-7 (.731) against the AL East this year and have gone 51-27 (.654) against division opponents since the start of 2023.
- 👉 The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014; the Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents.

IN THE SPOTLIGHT: Two of Baltimore's next three games will air on national TV broadcasts... Tomorrow's game will air on FS1, with **Jason Benetti** and **Tom Verducci** on the call...Sunday's game will air on Roku MLB Sunday Leadoff, with **Matt Vasgersian** doing play-by-play, **Ben McDonald** and **Jeff Nelson** as analysts, and **Brett Hollander** as the field reporter.

POPULARITY CONTEST: MLB today announced the most popular player jerseys for the first half of the 2024 season...Orioles catcher **Adley Rutschman** - who finished last year at No. 20 on the list - has climbed to No. 16.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his seventh career start tonight against the Yankees...Became the first Oriole pitcher to make his Major League debut this season and fourth Oriole overall, joining INF Jackson Holliday, C David Bañuelos, and INF/OF Connor Norby...Became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL; is the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, joining Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (61) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)...On June 12 vs. Atlanta, he became the 11th Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1IP); at 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest 0's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23y-249d) on August 28, 2011 (61) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Núñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt the loss on July 6 at Oakland after allowing a career-high eight runs on five hits (2 HR) and three walks with one strikeout in 1.0+ inning; surrendered a three-run home run in the first two innings; left with two runners on base who later scored...Marked the shortest start of his career...The 1.0 inning pitched is the shortest start by an Oriole since Keegan Akin on May 31, 2023 vs. Cleveland (also 1.0 IP)...Threw a season-low 43 pitches and a season-low 24 strikes.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Slated to make his second career start against New York-AL...Did not factor in the decision in his sole outing against the Yankees on June 19 at Yankee Stadium after tossing 4.2 innings of one-run ball, allowing one hit and a career-high five walks with one strikeout.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Across two career appearances against the AL East, Povich has gone 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA (7 ER/10.0 IP) with three strikeouts to nine walks...Six of the seven earned runs came in his MLB debut on June 6 at Toronto.

HOME SWEET HOME: Across his three career starts at Oriole Park, he owns a 1-1 record with a 2.70 ERA (5 ER/16.2 IP)...His first career quality start came on June 12 vs. Atlanta at Oriole Park; Povich threw his first career scoreless outing, allowing five hits and one hit batter with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Secured his lone MLB win at Oriole Park on June 29 vs. Texas.

NIGHT OWL: Making his fifth career night start...Has gone 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (6 ER/21.1 IP) in his four prior night outings...Earned his first career win in his last night start on June 26 vs. Texas after allowing two runs on five hits and one hit batter with three strikeouts across 5.0 innings.

HIGHTIDE: Has gone 5-1 with a 3.18 ERA (20 ER/56.2 IP), a 1.11 WHIP, and 75 strikeouts against 21 walks in 11 starts for the Tides this year...At the time of his promotion, he ranked among International League leaders in strikeouts (2nd), opponent average (3rd, .203), ERA (4th), WHIP (4th, 1.11), and wins (T-4th); only trailed teammate RHP Chayce McDermott (82) in strikeouts...His 75 strikeouts were tied for fifth among all minor league pitchers.

PROSPECTING: Currently ranked as the No. 5 Orioles prospect and No. 87 overall by *Baseball America*...He is ranked as the club's top pitching prospect...At 24 years, 91 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and second-youngest player overall behind Gunnar Henderson at 23 years, 13 days old.

APRIL SHOWERS: Named the International League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-1 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) and a league-best 40 strikeouts in five starts...Also named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month after leading O's minor leaguers (min. 20 IP) in ERA, WHIP, and strikeouts...Named International League Pitcher of the Week for April 1-7 after going 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP), three hits, three walks, and 14 strikeouts in two starts at Charlotte during the week.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the season between Double-A Bowie and Triple-A Norfolk...Combined to go 8-10 with a 5.04 ERA (71 ER/126.2 IP) and 106 hits (18 HR), 76 total runs, 66 walks, five hit batters, and 171 strikeouts in 28 games, all starts...Named an *MiLB.com* Organization All-Star...Finished third among all minor leaguers in strikeouts; his 12.15 K/9 ranked third among full-season minor leaguers...Selected as Eastern League Pitcher of the Week three times (5/1, 5/15, & 6/19)...Fanned 10 on April 29 (61) vs. Richmond and May 11 at Harrisburg...Struck out a career-high 13 batters on June 15 vs. Richmond; struck out the first six batters of the game and retired the first 18 hitters of the game; pitched 7.0 innings for the first time and surrendered just one hit...Completed at least 6.0 innings in five starts.
