SNAKEBITES THE NL CHAMPS: Last season, the D-backs captured their second National League pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth (1999, 2001, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23).

A BOND BEYOND BASEBALL: MLB Network's Anthony Castrovince & Paul Solga teamed up on "A Bond Beyond Baseball," a compelling, heartfelt story about the friendship and working relationship of Arizona Diamondbacks' General Manager Mike Hazen & Manager Torey Lovullo.

LOVULLO REACHES 500: Torey Lovullo, the D-backs longest tenured skipper in his eighth season, earned his 500th career managerial win last night @ Rockies to become the 12th active manager to reach the 500-win club.

STOPPING THE OPPONENT RUNNING GAME: Through 12 games this season, Gabriel Moreno has held opponents to a MLB-low 1 stolen base in 3 attempts (all by Rockies)...Moreno's 40.3 caught-stealing pct. since 2022 is highest among all MLB catchers.

- There has been only 3 stolen base attempts against Arizona over 157 stolen base opportunities.
- The 3 stolen base attempts vs. Arizona is the fewest among all MLB teams...the second fewest is 4 stolen base attempts vs. Dodgers.

ANOTHER FIRST FOR THE KID: Last night, Corbin Carroll hit his first career leadoff home run.

♦ Carroll, at age 23-232, became the youngest D-back in franchise history to hit a leadoff homer, 6 days younger than Chris Young (23-238 in 2007).

FIRST-INNING STRIKERS: The D-backs have scored 2+ runs in the first inning in 8 of their first 12 games this season...no other team has more than 3 instances so far this season [Dbacks.TV].

In the opening frame, the D-backs have scored 2 runs 4 times, 3 runs 3 times and 6 times once, tallying 23 runs on .470 hitting (31-for-66)/1.408 OPS with 7 doubles, 7 home runs and 6 walks.

MARVELOUS MR. MERRILL: Since 2022, Merrill Kelly's 34 starts with 6.0+ innings and 2-or-fewer runs allowed are tied for third most in the Majors, joining teammate Zac Gallen in the top-3...Arizona is the only team to feature 2 starters with 32+ bids reaching the feat: Gerrit Cole (39), Zac Gallen (35), Corbin Burnes (35), Merrill Kelly (34), Logan Webb (32), Kevin Gausman (32), Chris Bassitt (32)

VS. ROCKIES: The D-backs took 3 of 4 vs. Rockies in the season-opening series...went 4-2 @ Rockies last season and are 8-5 in their last 13 road games since Aug. 13, 2022.

Are 15-5 overall vs. Rockies in their last 20 games (10-3 in 2023) and have outscored them 138-84 (+54 run differential) in the span.

WALKER STAYS HOT VS. ROCKIES: Christian Walker has a 23game on-base streak vs. Rockies since August 14, 2022, hitting safely in 21 of those games, and a .411 average (37-for-90)/1.284 OPS with 7 doubles, 9 home runs, 26 RBI and 14 walks.

- Has a 14-game hitting streak vs. Rockies, since May 31, 2023, batting .434 (23-for-53)/1.411 OPS with 3 doubles, 7 home runs, 17 RBI and 9 walks.
- Has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 road games @ Rockies, reaching base safely in all 12 games, at a .479 clip (23-for-48)/1.520 OPS with 5 doubles, 6 home runs, 19 RBI and 9 walks.
- Among all players @ Rockies since 2018 (min. 75 PA), Walker is first in extra-base hits (25), tied for first in home runs (13), second in hits (52), tied for third in doubles (12), fifth in OPS (1.083) and 10th in AVG (.340).

HITTERS VS. STARTERS: D-backs hitters, against opposing starting pitchers, are batting .335 (73-for-218)/.918 OPS with 44 runs, 12 doubles, 10 home runs, 20 walks and 38 strikeouts.

Among all teams' offenses vs. starting pitchers, the D-backs are first with a .335 AVG, .390 OBP, .950 OPS and 115 total bases, tied for first with 10 home runs, and second with a .528 SLG.

EARLY ACTION AT THE DISH: In Innings 1-3, the D-backs' 41 runs, 59 hits and 1.011 OPS lead the Majors:

RUNS: D-backs (41), Padres (33), Cubs (31), Pirates (29)

HITS: D-backs (59), Padres (50), Dodgers (47), Pirates (45) **OPS: D-backs (1.011)**, Cubs (.936), Red Sox (.855), Royals (.846)

RISP-Y BUSINESS: The D-backs' .322 AVG with runners in scoring position is fourth in the Majors, behind the Brewers (.362), Braves (.345) and Rangers (.330).

Arizona's .322 AVG with RISP in their first 12 games of the season ranks second all-time in franchise history, behind 2017 (.340).

DEFENSIVE LEADERBOARD: Christian Walker's 3 DRS lead first basemen ahead of Bryce Harper/PHI (2), Vinnie Pasquantino/KC (2), Joey Gallo/WSH (2) and Ryan Mountcastle/BAL (2), while Eugenio Suárez's 4 DRS are second among third basemen, behind Matt Chapman/ SF (4).

ON DECK - ST. LOUIS CARDINALS: Last season, the D-backs went 3-3 vs. Cardinals (2-1 on the road, 1-2 @ home).

Over 3 games in 2023, Gabriel Moreno hit .429 (3for-7)/1.500 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer and 4 RBI while Corbin Carroll slashed .400/.500/.733 with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 RBI and 4 walks over 6 games.

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (1-0, 5.06) • Went decisionless in his last start @ Braves after allowing 5 runs on 8 hits over 5.2 innings with 7 strikeouts. Will make his first career start vs. Cardinals.

♦ Has gone 3-1 with a 3.81 ERA (11 ER in 26.0 IP), 2 walks allowed and 35 strikeouts over his last 5 starts dating back to Sept. 15, 2023.
