THE TWINS: Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4, getting swept in three games by the Guardians in Cleveland, followed by a series win in Washington D.C. tonight, Minnesota will begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Rangers over the weekend, followed by four against the Royals from Monday-Thursday. The Twins are 11-11 at home this season...in their last series here, they were swept in three games by the Yankees from May 14-16...prior to that, they were 9-2 in their previous 11 games here. Minnesota has gone 19-10 in their last 29 games since April 22, tied with Kansas City (19-10) for the fourth-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (23-6), Los Angeles-NL (20-8) and New York-AL (20-10).

BLOCK PARTY: Tonight's start time vs. the Rangers was recently shifted to 6:10 pm (CT), rather than 7:10 pm as previously scheduled...the Target Field gates will open at 4:30 pm...moving first pitch time up by one hour was done to help accommodate ingress and egress to downtown Minneapolis throughout what is expected to be a busy evening, with Game 2 of the Western Conference Finals between the Minnesota Timberwolves and Dallas Mavericks scheduled for a 7:30 pm tip at Target Center.

SERIES WINNERS IN WASHINGTON: The Twins beat the Nationals on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 3-2, winning the series two games to one...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 4.2 scoreless innings, with three hits allowed, one walk and one strikeout...Minnesota used five relievers as Steven Okert earned his first win as a Twin with 1.1 perfect innings of relief...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by Max Kepler, who went 2-for-4 with a solo home run (4) and a double (1)...Carlos Correa also added a home run, hitting his fourth of the season and second of the series.

JORGE FOR THE BOZ: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcalá from Triple-A St. Paul...Alcalá has worked 4.2 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, four walks and seven strikeouts in four May appearances for the Saints...this marks his third stint with the Twins this season, previously being with the club from Opening Day-April 14 and May 3-8, and going 1-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER), two holds, six walks and 10 strikeouts in eight appearances across those stints...to make room for Alcalá on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Caleb Boushley to Triple-A St. Paul...Boushley made one appearance during his latest major league stint, working 2.0 innings of relief (3 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 1 K) on Monday in Washington, D.C.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins went 5-2 against the Rangers last season, going 3-1 at Target Field from August 24-27 and 2-1 at Globe Life Field from September 1-3...it was their most wins over Texas since going 6-1 in 2019...Minnesota outscored Texas 47-33 in 2023. Since the start of 2021, 17 of 21 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 10 games have been decided by one run. Since the start of 2019, the Twins have scored 5.6 runs-per-game in 28 games against the Rangers...marks the second most against any AL club in that span, trailing Seattle (5.9). Carlos Correa has 21 career home runs vs. the Rangers (105 games), his most against any opponent...21 homers are the fourth most among actives, trailing Mike Trout (44), Jose Altuve (34) and George Springer (28). Max Kepler is hitting .373 (19-for-51) with a .958 OPS in his last 15 games vs. Texas. Ryan Jeffers is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with one double, three home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.094 OPS in nine career games vs. Texas...he hit a go-ahead, pinch-hit, two-run homer off Will Smith on August 24, 2023, giving the Twins a 7-5 victory.

KEP ON KEPPING ON: Max Kepler is hitting .373 (31-for-83) with 12 doubles, four home runs, eight walks, 18 RBI, a .430 on-base percentage, a .663 slugging percentage and a 1.093 OPS in his last 26 games, dating back to April 22...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in batting average, third in OPS and slugging percentage, and sixth in on-base percentage. Kepler has 10 doubles this month, trailing only Aaron Judge (11) for the most in baseball. He is hitting .333 (18-for-54) with a .964 OPS in 16 home games this season.

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: Carlos Correa has reached safely in 13 straight games since May 8...in that span, he has posted a .346 on-base percentage, with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, five RBI, five walks, nine runs scored and a .921 OPS.

FOR STARTERS: Twins starters enter tonight's game carrying an 12.0-scoreless inning streak — Joe Ryan 7.0-scoreless on Tuesday night, followed by Simeon Woods Richardson 4.2-scoreless Wednesday afternoon...12.0-straight scoreless marks the longest stretch by Twins starters this season...additionally, in their last 19 games, Twins starters have gone 7-6, 3.39 ERA (109.0 IP, 41 ER) with 15 walks, 109 strikeouts and a .239 opponent batting average.

- ☞ Making 10th start of season and 67th of career...has allowed 15 earned runs in 39.1 innings (2.96 ERA) across eight starts since eight-run season debut March 31 in Kansas City.
- ☞ Last pitched on May 18 at Cleveland, allowing five runs on eight hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings...ended his four-game win streak and picked up his second loss of the season.
- ☞ Has made one career start vs. Texas Rangers, allowing five runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in a 4.0-inning no-decision on August 27, 2023 at Target Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on May 18 against the Cleveland Guardians...ended his career-high four game win streak allowing five runs on eight hits (1 HR), one walk and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings... took his first loss since March 31 at Kansas City, when he allowed eight runs in 1.1 innings...gave up a two-run home run to José Ramírez in the first-inning that traveled 346 feet and had an expected batting average of .160 per Baseball Savant.

- ☞ Per Baseball Savant, the José Ramírez home run would have been a home run in 15 of 30 ballparks, but not Target Field.

TWO STARTS AGO: Faced the Blue Jays on May 12 and tied a career-high streak with four consecutive wins in a 5-1 Twins win...allowed a season-low one hit, no runs and a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts in 6.1 innings...was perfect through 3.2 innings until Vladimir Guerrero recorded the only hit given up by Ober, on a single in the fourth inning...first start of his career where he went 6.0-plus innings allowing one-or-fewer hits and zero runs.

- ☞ Last 10 strikeout game was on September 27, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL...earned the victory, allowing two hits, no runs, one walk in a career-high 7.1 innings.
- ☞ Recorded 15 swings and misses in 67 strikes thrown (22.3%).

HITTING HIS STRIDE: Since April 8, Ober has gone 4-1, 2.96 ERA (45.2 IP, 10 ER) with eight walks and 48 strikeouts...since that date, he ranks among qualified AL pitchers in opponent batting average (.181 2nd), WHIP (0.81, 1st), baserunners-per-9.0 IP (7.49, 1st), fFIP (2.40, 7th) and ERA (2.96, 15th).

VS. TEXAS: Has made one career start vs. Texas on August 27, 2023 at Target Field, allowing five runs on five hits (2 HR), one walk and four strikeouts...Texas hitters hit .294 (5-for-17) with a .706 slugging percentage and a 1.039 OPS.

- ☞ Has faced seven active Ranger hitters coming for a batting average of .440 (11-for-25), three home runs, one walk and two strikeouts...two of the three home runs have come from Marcus Semien.

RELAXED AT HOME: Making his fourth home start of the season today...in previous three, has gone 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks, 20 strikeouts, a 0.75 WHIP and a .151 (8-for-53) opponent batting average...compared to six road starts, he is 3-2, 5.52 ERA (31.0 IP, 19 ER), five walks, 29 strikeouts, a 1.13 WHIP and a .252 (30-for-119) opponent batting average

- ☞ Has gone 8-4 with a 3.45 ERA (164.1 IP, 63 ER) in 32 career home starts compared to a 9-10 with a 4.00 ERA (175.1 IP, 78 ER) in 34 career road starts
- ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is tied for fourth in home wins with eight, with former teammate Sonny Gray.

REVERSE SPLITS: On May 18, Cleveland left-handed hitters went 3-for-4 with one strikeout against Ober, while righties went 3-for-4 with one strikeout...through nine games this season, lefties have hit .211 (16-for-76) with a .639 OPS and a 26.3 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .229 (22-for-96) with a .712 OPS and a 30.2 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Lefties have a 24.1 percent whiff rate and 86.9 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 24.3 percent whiff rate and 90.2 mph average exit velocity.
- ☞ In one career start, Texas left-handed hitters have hit .231 (3-for-13), with three extra-base hits one double and two home runs with three strikeouts and a 1.055 OPS, while righties have hit .500 (2-for-4), one strikeout and an 1.000 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...uses 4-seamer and cutter against both left- and right-handed hitters...predominantly throws changeup and curveball to lefties, slider to righties. Here's his pitch usage through eight starts:

- ☞ In his last start Guardians hitters went 6-for-9, two doubles with one strikeout against the 4-seam fastball.
- ☞ In his last start against the Guardians, threw 17 cutters with 16 of them being to left-handed hitters.

CAREER-HIGH-TYING STREAK IS OVER: With a loss in his last start on May 18 at Cleveland, he ended his career-high streak of four consecutive wins dating back to April 20 against Detroit...his last four-game win streak was from September 27, 2022-May 16, 2023...during the four-game win-streak he beat Detroit, Los Angeles-AL, Chicago-AL and Toronto.

NIGHT NIGHT: In four night games this season, he is 1-1, 4.22 ERA (21.1 IP, 10 ER), seven walks, 26 strikeouts and a .227 (17-for-75) opponent batting average...this compares to 3-1, 4.56 ERA (25.2 IP, 13 ER), two walks, 23 strikeouts and a .216 (21-for-97) opponent batting average in five day game starts.

2023 RECAP:

- ☞ Was Triple-A St. Paul's Opening Day starter and pitched in four games for Saints to begin the season, posting a 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts.
- ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on April 23 after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings.
- ☞ Recalled by Twins on April 23 and made season debut that day against Washington, allowing one run on three hits in 5.2 innings, earning the win.
- ☞ Posted a 1.82 ERA (24.2 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 24 strikeouts over his next four starts with the Twins.
- ☞ Pitched 7.0 shutout innings twice: May 5 at Cleveland and July 1 at Baltimore.
- ☞ Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 15 of first 16 starts with Twins from April 23-July 23.
- ☞ Posted career-best four-start stretch (July 18-August 4) without issuing a walk.
- ☞ To limit innings, returned to Triple-A from August 28-September 15 and started once in that span.
- ☞ Set career highs in wins (8), innings pitched (144.1), starts (26) and strikeouts (146).
- ☞ Ranked fourth on Twins staff in starts, innings and strikeouts.
- ☞ Left off AL Wild Card Series roster vs. Toronto but added to ALDS roster vs. Houston.
- ☞ Made Postseason debut and started Game 1 at Houston, allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 3.0 innings...was dealt the loss in a 6-4 Twins defeat.
- ☞ Made second appearance in relief in Game 3 vs. Houston, allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 1.1 innings of Minnesota's 9-1 defeat.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS PADDACK (2024: 4-2, 4.47 ERA // CAREER: 26-23, 4.25 ERA)

Right-handed pitcher Chris Paddack is set to pitch the second of a three-game series tomorrow afternoon against the Texas Rangers...in his last start against the Cleveland Guardians on May 19, picked up a no-decision, he allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR), no walks and six strikeouts in 8.0 innings - his 8.0 innings pitched were a career high surpassing his 7.2 innings pitched on May 6, 2019 against New York-NL when he was a member of the San Diego Padres...facing the Rangers for the third time in his career; in his prior two starts he is 0-0, 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER), three walks, eight strikeouts, a 1.10 WHIP and a .216 (8-for-37) opponent batting average.

CAREER NOTES

- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3.
- In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
