FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude the first leg of their season-ending six-game road trip with today's series finale against the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field ... The Redbirds travel to San Francisco after today's game, starting and finishing their regular season on the West Coast for only the second time in franchise history and first time since 1960.

WINNING WAYS: Winners of four in a row and seven of their last nine, St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the National League Central Division ... The Cardinals are looking for one more win to finish with a winning season record for the 23rd time in 25 seasons since 2000.

- Last night's win extended the Cardinals 65-year streak of not experiencing back-to-back losing campaigns in full seasons since 1958-59,
 2nd-longest in major North American sports history behind the NHL's Montreal Canadiens (80 years).
- After a 71-91 finish last season, St. Louis has improved by double-digit wins for the 33rd time in franchise history (1892-present) compared to the previous season (excluding 1981-82 and 2020-21). - Elias
- Through 158 games, their 12-win gain from last season is tied for MLB's 5th-best improvement in 2024.

TAP THE ROCKIES: A win today would give St. Louis a series sweep of the Rockies for the first time since August 16-18, 2022 at Busch Stadium and the first time in Denver since Sept. 24-26, 2004 at Coors Field.

- The Cardinals have won the season series vs. the Rockies 24 times in 31 seasons since Colorado joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993.
- St. Louis has swept the Orioles (May 20-22 at Busch), Cubs (May 25-26 at Busch), and Giants (June 20-23 at Rickwood/Busch) this season.
- The Cardinals have won their last four games here at Coors (April 11, 2023-present), tying their longest win streak in Colorado for the 5th time and first since May 30, 2007-May 6, 2008

MASYN MILESTONES: Masyn Winn plays in his 146th game at shortstop today, tying Charlie Gelbert (1929) for 2nd-most all-time by a Cards rookie behind 1907 Ed Holly (147g) ... 1978 Padre Ozzie Smith holds the MLB rookie record with 159 games at SS.

• Winn logged his 5th triple and 30th double last night, becoming only the 4th Cards rookie all-time with 15+ homers, 5+ triples, and 30+ doubles in a season to join 1942 **Stan Musial** (10-10-32), 1936 **Johnny Mize** (10-8-30), and 1930 **George Watkins** (17-7-32).

HELS BELLS: Ryan Helsley's 48 saves lead Major League Baseball and match **Trevor Rosenthal** (2015) for the most in Cardinals single-season history ... The last Cardinal to lead all of Major League Baseball in saves was **Lee Smith** (47 in 1991).

- Helsley has combined to win or save a Cardinals-record 55 games this season, tied for the 9th-highest total in MLB history and the highest total in MLB since Seattle Edwin Diaz converted 58 saves (0 wins) in a 2018.
- Helsley has combined to share in 67.9% of the team's 81 victories with his 48 saves & 7 wins (5 in extras), 5th-highest in MLB since 1969 (when saves became official *(chart left)*.

KID'S CLUB: The Cardinals lead MLB this season in combined games (991) by players age 25 or younger, 5th-most in franchise history behind 1937 (1,008 g), 1973 (1,042 g), 1977 (1,084 g), and 1974 (1,089 g) ... Over the last six seasons (2019-24) across Major League Baseball, only the Cleveland Guardians from 2023 (1,041 g) and 2022 (1,038 g) have had more.

 Including those 22 and younger, the Cardinals have played a combined 205 games, 2nd-most in MLB this season to Cincinnati (226g) and the most in franchise history since the 1983 Redbirds (247g)

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 26, 2009): The Cardinals clinch the NL Central Division with a 6-3 win over the Rockies at Coors Field, highlighted by backup catcher Jason LaRue hitting a go-head homer in the 7th inning ... Adam Wainwright scattered 10 hits while fanning 11 over 8.0 innings for his 19th win, while also going 2-for-3 with a double.

COLORADO CONNECTIONS

Nolan Arenado played eight seasons with Colorado (2013-20), where he was a five-time NL All-Star and the winner of four Silver Sluggers, eight Gold Gloves, and four Platinum Gloves...originally selected by Colorado in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft...Acquired by St. Louis with cash in exchange for Austin Gomber, Elehuris Montero, Tony Locey, Mateo Gil and Jake Sommers.

Nolan Arenado's cousin, **Josh Fuentes**, played three seasons with the Rockies (2019-21) and college baseball at Missouri Baptist Univ. (2014).

Daniel Descalso played two seasons with Colorado (2015-16).

Kyle Leahy was born in and resides in Boulder... graduated from Erie High School, and selected to play at the Colorado High School Futures Game at Coors Field...played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction (2016-18).

Austin Gomber pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2018, '20)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 4th round of the 2014 MLB Draft...shared Cardinals Co-Minor League Pitchers of the Year honors with Alex Reyes in 2015.

Dakota Hudson pitched six seasons and the 2019 Postseason (2018-23) with St. Louis, where he made his MLB debut...selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#34) of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Daniel Bard made 10 appearances for Springfield (AA) in 2017.

John Mozeliak began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant scouting operations following the 1995 season... graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher... graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Asst. GM & Scouting Director Randy Flores pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Holliday** was originally selected by Colorado in the 7th round of the 1998 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons for the Rockies (2004-08, '18) where he was a three-time All-Star and appeared in the 2007 World Series.

Rockies Special Assistant to the GM **Clint Hurdle** played in 78 games for St. Louis in 1986.

Rockies MLB.com **Thomas Harding** covered the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) for two seasons for the Commercial Appeal (1998-99)...mentored recent Cardinals MLB.com writer **Anne Rogers**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist **Benjamin Hochman** previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is originally from Boulder...graduated from Centaurus High School in Lafayette...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

Rockies Communications Coordinator **Kevin Collins** previously served as the 2015 Media Relations Intern for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Rockies Digital Comm. Manager **Nora Farrell** previously worked in communications and social media for St. Louis for part of seven seasons (2016-22).

Rockies VP Ticket Sales, Ops & Svcs. **Sue Ann McClaren** worked 15 seasons (1978-92) in the Cards sales department before joining the Rockies in 1992.

- Will join José Berriós, Dylan Cease, Patrick Corbin, Kevin Gausman and Aaron Nola as pitchers with four consecutive seasons of 30 or more starts since 2021.
- Has a 6-3 record on the road and 2-5 at home. Ranks T-9th among National League pitchers in road wins.
- Making his 13th start in a day game this season and is 4-3 with a 3.30 ERA under the
- Earned the Cardinals first ever regular season road win against the Yankees on 8/31 and the team's first road win overall against the New York Yankees dating back to Bob Gibson's win in Game 5 of the 1964 World Series (Oct. 12).
- Durable starting pitcher has now logged 10 seasons of 20 or more starts since 2014, tied with teammate **Sonny Gray** for most in MLB (2014-19, 2021-24).
- Needs one more win to tie Stephen Strasburg (113) for the most wins of any pitcher from the MLB 2009 draft class.
- Limited his opposition to two earned runs or fewer in 16-of-29 starts, 3rd among Cardinals starters behind Sonny Gray (16) behind Erick Fedde (19).
- Boasts a 41.2% Whiff Pct. on Sweepers, 2nd-highest for the Sweeper (**Sonny Gray**, STL, 44.4%) among MLB starting pitchers (*min. 100 TBF*).
- Fanned Josh Rojas (SEA) for his 1,500th career strikeout on 9/7 to become the 19th active pitcher to hit that mark. Has had 100+ K's in each of his 10 full seasons played.
- Five of his starts have been delayed by rain (5 hr. 14 min. total) and he was scratched from his scheduled start on 6/19 at MIA during warm-ups due to back tightness.
- Has started four doubleheader games this season (April 30-1 at Detroit; June 26-1 vs. Atlanta; June 13-2 vs. Chicago Cubs; July 20-1 at Atlanta), most by a Cardinal since Daniel Ponce de Leon (4 in 2020) and most in a non-COVID-19 affected season since Bob Forsch (4 in 1983). Elias
- St. Louis area resident and Univ. of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals
 as a free agent last November. Is one of three free-agent starters (Sonny Gray & Lance
 Lynn) that the Cardinals signed last off-season. Pitching for his fifth MLB team: Twins
 (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).
