The Brewers' magic number to clinch the NL Central is 11....any combination of Brewers wins and Cubs losses that total 11 gives Milwaukee the division title for the third consecutive season and fourth in the last five seasons.

The Brewers are looking for their 90th win of the season tonight.....the team has produced 90+ victories 11 times in franchise history, including a high of 96 twice (2011 and 2018).

Beat the Streak

The Brewers are looking to avoid their third season-high 4-game losing streak....the team began the season 0-4 and also had a 4-game losing streak from 4/23-4/26.

Quinning Streak

Quinn Priester has won a franchiserecord 11 consecutive decisions, covering 17 games and 14 starts.

Quinn for the Win

The Brewers have won each of the last 17 games in which **Quinn Priester** has pitched.....this includes 14 starts. the longest winning streak for any starting pitcher in franchise history.. the previous record was 12 straight wins in starts made by Corbin Burnes in 2021....this also marks the longest winning streak in the majors by a team for a starting pitcher since the Dodgers won 16 consecutive games started by Clayton Kershaw in 2017.

In his last 37 games, Brice Turang is batting .340 (48-for-141) with 12 HR and 30 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .404 OBP/.674 SLG/1.078 OPS.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 1 of a 6-game, 7-day homestand against St. Louis (3g) and Los Angeles-AL (3g)....the Brewers are coming off a 3-3 road trip to Pittsburgh (3-0) and Texas (0-3).....following this homestand, the team has its final road trip of the season to St. Louis (3g) and San Diego (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (178 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 64*, SECOND: 57, THIRD: 43, FOURTH: 11, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the Cubs by 5.5 games (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

AT HOME: The team has gone 46-26 at home, going 15-7-1 in series play.....had a season-high 7-game winning streak from 8/8-8/22.

ON THE ROAD: The team has gone a Major League-best 43-32 (.573) on the road, going 13-9-2 in series play.....are 33-14 in the last 47 games despite a current 3-game losing streak.....had a franchise-record-tying 9-game winning streak from 7/23-8/16.

MANAGER: Pat Murnhy is in his second season as Brewers manager - he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23. replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 24 replay challenges this season. going 16-8....their last challenge (won) came 9/7 at Pittsburgh as an out call at first base involving Joey Ortiz was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees [6].....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers have 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25).....this does not include 2020.....entering 2025, the Brewers, Dodgers and Astros were the only teams with 86+ wins in the last seven full seasons. the Brewers have 755 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

PRIESTER AT A GLANCE: Quinn Priester, 24, will make his 27th appearance and 22nd start of the season.....Priester last pitched last Friday at Pittsburgh and earned a 5-2 win (7ip, 6h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 6k, 96 pitches).....the team is 15-6 in his starts.....he has 9 quality starts.....opponents are batting .241 (128-for-531, 17hr).....he is 9-2 with a 2.83 ERA as a starter (114.2ip, 36er) and 3-0 with a 5.06 ERA in relief (26.2ip, 15er).....he is on a franchise-record 11-game winning streak over his last 17 games/14 starts while posting a 2.79 ERA (96.2ip, 87h, 32r, 30er, 23bb, 81k, 12hr).....Priester was acquired from Boston on April 7 for OF Yophery Rodriguez, a Competitive Balance Round A selection and a player to be named (RHP John Holobetz on May 5).....he began the season at Triple-A Worcester (1 start).

LAST SEASON: Priester went 3-6 with a 4.71 ERA in 11 games/7 starts with Pittsburgh (10g/6gs) and Boston (1gs).....his teams went 1-6 in his starts.....he had 2 quality starts..... opponents batted .277 (56-for-202, 7hr).....he went 1-5 with a 4.42 ERA as a starter (36.2ip, 18er) and 2-1 with a 5.54 ERA as a reliever (13ip, 8er).....Priester was traded by Pittsburgh to Boston on 7/29/24 in exchange for INF/OF Nick Yorke.

CAREER: Is 18-11 with a 4.48 ERA in 47 games/36 starts (241ip, 120er) while pitching for Pittsburgh (2023-24), Boston (2024) and Milwaukee (2025).....has gone 12-10 with a 4.19 ERA as a starter (191.1ip, 89er) and 6-1 with a 5.62 ERA as a reliever (49.2ip, 31er).....Priester was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-2 with a 4.08 ERA in 13 games/9 starts (70.2ip, 32er).....is 6-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 10 games/7 starts this season (54.2ip, 23er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 9-6 with a 3.96 ERA in 28 games/22 starts (147.2ip, 65er)....is 6-1 with a 2.91 ERA in 16 games/14 starts this season (86.2ip, 28er).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF (8-2, 3.32)

RHP Brandon Woodruff makes his 12th start of the season and first against the Cardinals.....he last started last Saturday at Pittsburgh and earned a 4-1 win (6ip, 2h, 0r, 0bb, 8k, 85 pitches).....the team is 9-2 in his starts.....he has 6 quality starts.....opponents are batting .194 (43-for-222, 8hr).....
