POWER OUTAGE—Tampa Bay's 37 HR are tied with Detroit for third fewest in the AL, ahead of only Chicago-AL (32HR) and Toronto (35HR)...it marks the Rays fewest home runs through 44 games since 2014 (34HR)...the 2023 Rays hit a franchise-best 86 HR through 44 games.

ON THE DEFENSE—The Rays have not committed an error in five straight contests, one game shy of matching their season-long six-game streak from April 2-8...despite this, their -16 Defensive Runs Saved are fourth fewest in MLB (Sports Info Solutions), ahead of only Chicago-AL (-28), New York-NL (-24) and Miami (-21)...their only net positive position is catcher (+1).

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON—Tampa Bay and Boston complete a four-game set tonight at Fenway Park...the two clubs will meet seven times in 10 days, with the Red Sox traveling to St. Petersburg from May 20-22 for a three-game series...the Rays are 13-3 vs. the Red Sox since the beginning of the 2023 season, outscoring Boston, 86-57 (+29), during that strates stretch.

SOX TALK-Littell is set for his first career start opposite the Red Sox... he has made one relief appearance against them, earning the win after holding the Red Sox scoreless over the final two frames of a 17-inning win in Minnesota on June 18, 2019 during his stint with the Twins (W, 2.0IP, 2H, OR, 2SO)...it was the longest contest in Target Field history until the record was broken just nine days later, when the Rays defeated the Twins, 5-2, in an 18-inning marathon to conclude a 10-game road trip.
 Littell was traded from Texas to Boston on May 5, 2023 and had his contract selected the following day...he yielded 3 ER over two relief appearances spanning 3.0 IP before being designated for assignment on May 10 and subsequently claimed by the Rays on May 12.
 Since joining the Rays, Littell has gone 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA (28.0IP, 7ER) and 0.96 WHIP in his five starts against AL East opponents... this includes a 1.23 ERA (22.0IP, 3ER) over the last four starts dating to Sept. 17, 2023 at BAL.

ON THE ROAD—Since transitioning to a full-time starting role on July 19, 2023 at TEX, Littell is 2-4 with a 2.96 ERA (51.2IP, 17ER) in 10 road starts, allowing two runs or fewer in eight of those outings...min. 50.0 IP, he ranks among AL starters on the road over that span in walk rate (2nd, 1.9%) and ERA (8th).

PINPOINT PRECISION-Littell holds the AL's fourth-lowest walks per 9.0 **PINPOINT PRECISION**—Littell holds the AL's fourth-lowest walks per 9.0 IP (1.41) and fifth-lowest walk rate (3.7%)...according to Elias, his free pass to NYY **Anthony Rizzo** on May 11 snapped a 123 BF streak without a walk, third longest in Rays history behind **Corey Kluber** (150, 2022) and **David Price** (124, 2013)...five of his walks have come in a total of two frames: the 1st inning on April 10 at LAA (3BB) and the 2nd on May 11 vs. NYY (2BB)... excluding his statistics in those two frames, he has produced a 1.1 pct. walk rate (2BB/175BF) in all other innings.
