SUNDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Rangers, 11-2, on ESPN's Sunday Night Baseball and failed to with a double and scored both runs in his first game since June 25 , while Ryan 0 'Hearn went 3 -for-4 with an RBI...Baltimore hit four batters, tying a O's record for most in a game.
ALL-STAR VOTING: MLB announced a voting update for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game today...Phase 2 of voting, which began Sunday at 12:00 p.m. ET and ends tomorrow at 12:00 p.m. ET at MLB.com/vote, features the top two vote-getters at each position in each League (and the top six outfielders in the NL; next four outfielders in the AL after leading vote-getter Aaron Judge) based on vote totals from Phase 1, which ran from June $5-27$; fans can vote once per day, as opposed to five times in tease .....IIGame since Adam Jones and Nelson Cruz in 2014
O. Alley Rutschman has received 70 percent of the votes against Kansas City's Salvador Perez he's seeking his second All-Star nod (2023) and first starting assignment and would become the
third O's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with Gus Triandos in 1958 and 1959, and Terry third O's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with Gus Triandos in 1958 and 1959, and Terry
Kennedy in 1987; Matt Wieters was voted to start in 2014 , but did not play (injury).
Ө. Gunnar Henderson is leading Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. with 65 percent of votes; he's vying for his first career All-Star selection and would be the first Orioles shortstop selected to the

O. Jordan Westburg has received 40 percent of the votes and is behind Cleveland's Jose Ramirez; he's seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first Orioles third baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Machado in 2016.
O. Anthony Santander is in third place with 25 percent of the votes in the outfield, ahead of
Houston's Kyle Tucker ( $16 \%$ ), and trailing New York-AL's Juan Soto ( $31 \%$ ) and Cleveland's Steven Houston's Kyle Tucker (16\%), and trailing New York-AL's Juan Soto (31\%) and Cleveland's Steven Phase 1, guaranteeing him a starting spot; Santander is looking for his first All-Star selection and would be the first fan-elected Baltimore outfielder since Jones in 2014.
O. Ryan O'Hearn is second behind Houston's Yordan Alvarez with 47 percent of the vote; he's aiming for his first All-Star selection while trying to join Nelson Cruz (2014) as the only Baltimore designated hitters to earn a fan election.
WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have won four of their last five games after dropping their previous five, the team's longest losing streak since May 13-18, 2022 (6 G)...At $53-31$ (.631), the Birds own the third-best
record in MLB, behind the Guardians (.634, 52-30) and Phillis (.655,55-29). Since the start of 2023 Baltimore is 154-92 (.626), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time. The O's are 237-171(.581) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.586, 239-169), Braves (.618, 251-155), and Dodgers (.643, 263-146).
HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 139 home runs and are one of four clubs with $100+$ homers this season, along with the Yankees (123)
. The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.
. The 139 homers are the most through 84 games in team history and nine more than any other year; Baltimore is the $13^{\text {th }}$ MLB team since at least 1901 with $139+$ home runs in the first 84 games of a season and the first since Atlanta hit 161 last season; all such occurrences in MLB have come since 1999 with nine coming since 2018.
Q. The O's are 46-20 this year when homering, 36-6 when hitting multiple home runs, 19-5 when hitting at least three, and $5-2$ when hitting four.
Baltimore has an MLB-best seven players with at least 10 home runs: Gunnar Henderson (26)
Anthony Santander (22), Adley Rutschman (15), Jordan Westburg (13) Mount castle (11), and Ryan O'Hearn (10); the Padres are second with six.
O. Henderson and Santander are one of three duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season, along with Cleveland's Jose Ramirez and Josh Naylor, and New York-AL's Aaron Judge and Juan Soto.
. The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; Gunnar Henderson has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with Cedric Mullins

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson had his career-best 36-game on-base streak since May 22 snapped on Sunday...The stretch was the longest by an O's batter since Nick Markakis' 38 -game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009...It was the second-longest on-base streak in MLB this season behind New York-
AL's Aaron Judge's 37 -gamer from May 2 to June 12...For Henderson, 35 of those came as the starting shortstop, the longest such streak in team history ahead of a 30-gamer by Cal Ripen Jr. from June 26 to short 28, 986 .

He is tied for second in MLB with 26 homers with Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani, trailing New $\theta$ S Since May 28, he's slashing .333/.425/.643 (42-for-126) with 12 doubles, nine homers, 33 runs, 21 RBI, 19 walks, one hit-by-pitch, and six stolen bases in 31 games; he leads MLB during that time in hits, extra-base hits (21) and runs.

SUMMER SLUGGER: Anthony Santander led MLB with 13 home runs last month, the most in June in team history...He tied with Nelson Cruz (13 in May 2014) and Frank Robinson (13 in July 1966), and finished behind Jim Gentile ( 5 in August 1961) for the most home runs hit in a single month by an Orioles batter.
O. Santander's 83 home runs since the start of 2022 are the most by a switch hitter, third in the AL, and $11^{\text {th }}$ in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Alvarez

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles just finished 29 games in 30 days in June while going 17-12 (.586), the thirdbest record in the AL during that time...The O's have nine consecutive winning months (min. 10 games
played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the O's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the Elias Sports Bureau...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors.
ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore begins a six-game road trip to the West Coast tonight with the first of three in Seattle...The Birds complete the trip with three games in Oakland from July 5-7...The O's went 2-4 on their last road trip against the Yankees (2-1) and Astros ( $0-3$ ) from June 18-23, their first losing trip since
going 2-3 against the Cubs (1-2) and Rays (1-1) from June 16-21, 2023...Despite being swept in Houston, the Orioles are a league-best 24-14(.632) on the road this year and 76-43(.639) away from Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above 600 during that time.
AGAINST SEATTLE: The O's and Mariners meet for the second time this season this week at T-Mobile Park... Baltimore took two of three games against Seattle at Camden Yards from May $17-19 \ldots$ In the last
eight meetings between the teams, five games have been decided by one or two runs with three of those eight meetings between the teams, five games have been decided by one or two runs with three of those
coming by exactly one run.

ROSTER MOVES: Yesterday, the Orioles reinstated right-handed pitcher Corbin Burns from the Paternity List yesterday and optioned left-handed pitcher Matt Krook to Triple-A Norfolk after Sunday's game.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL
consecutive year...Hyde's 368 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

OUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his $15^{\text {th }}$ start of the season tonight against the Mariners...Is the first Oriole to win at least nine of their first 14 starts to begin a season since Chris Tillman in 2016 (9); Tillman won his $15^{\text {th }}$ start that season, making him the last Orioles pitcher to win 10 of his first 15 starts to begin a season...Activated from the 15 -day Injured List prior to the game on May 18 vs. Seattle (right shoulder inflammation), retroactive to Aprio 30...Posted a $7-4$ record and year... Began ast seasonw his MLB debut on April 5 at Texas...Optioned to Norfolk on May $27 \ldots$ Recalled on first round (No. 11 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his ninth win of the season on June 26 vs. Cleveland after allowing two runs on five hits (2 HR) and one hit batter with four strikeouts across 7.0 innings pitched; completed 7.0 innings for the second time in his last second in the AL, along with teammate Corbin Burnes and three others, and tied second in the AL, along with teammate Corbin Bur
for fourth in MLB...Threw 97 pitches, 65 strikes.

AGAINST THE MARINERS: Scheduled to make his second career start against the Mariners and his first in Seattle...Did not factor in the decision in his only prior start against them earlier this season on May 18 in Baltimore; tossed 6.0 shutout took a no-hitter into the sixth inning before surrendering an infield single with one out to Julio Rodríguez.

AGAINST THE AL WEST: Making his $11^{\text {th }}$ career start against the AL West and first since June 21 at Houston...Owns a lifetime 2-4 record with an 7.66 ERA ( 42 ER/49.1 IP) in his 10 prior regularseason starts against the division; also faced the Rangers in Game 2 of the 2023 ALDS, allowing five runs on six hits and four walks
with strikeouts in 1.2 innings. Across the 11 regular starts, AL West opponents are slashing a combined .321/.396/.512 (69-for-215).

LIFE ON THE ROAD: Has gone 4-2 with a 5.35 ERA (23 ER/38.2 IP) in seven road starts this season compared to 5-1 with a 2.27 ERA (11 ER/43.2 IP) across his seven starts at Oriole Park...Opponents are slashing .277/.335/.447 (44-for-133) in those seven road starts.

REVERSE SPLITS: Lefty hitters are slashing .1971.269/.303 (30-for-152) off him this season, while righties are slashing, 285/.341/.497 (47-for-165)...Has allowed just two extra-base hits to left-handed hitters in his last four starts...The 285 opponent batting average against righties ranks 79 out of 86 qualified righthanded starting pitchers.

GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS: In Rodriguez's 10 starts in his initial stint with the club in 2023, he notched a 7.35 ERA (37 ER/45.1 IP)...After being optioned to Norfolk, he returned to Baltimore on July 17 and has gone $14-5$ with a 3.17 ERA (56 ER/159.0 IP) across 27 starts since...Has posted 14 quality starts in his last 25 outings, dating back to July 28, 2023...Did not register a quality start in his first 12 outings to begin his career.

GAS 'EM UP: Punched out 129 batters for the O's last season, the most for an Orioles rookie since 2012 (Wei-Yin Chen, 154)...His mark ranks sixth among rookies in team history (since 1954)...He became the $20^{\text {th }}$ rookie pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 100 batters.
$\mathbf{2 0 2 3}$ HIGHLIGHTS: Rodriguez opened last season with the Norfolk Tides, earning the nod as their Opening Day starter...Recalled by the Orioles on April 5, making his MLB debut in a start at Texas...Marked the first of six Orioles to make their big-league debut last year...Earned his first career win on April 29 (G2) at Detroit, throwing 5.0 shutout innings and striking out nine...Tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings on September 16 vs. Tampa Bay, tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023; at 23 years old, 304 days old, became the youngest O's starter to work 8.0 scoreless frames since Zack Britton (23-141) tossed a shutout on May 12, 2011 vs. Seattle, and the youngest rookie right-hander to do since Brad Bergesen (23-257) worked 8.0 scoreless on June 9, 2009 vs. Seattle.
POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 2 of the ALDS against the Rangers on October 8...Allowed five runs on six hits and four walks across 1.2 innings...Marked the most runs that Rodriguez had surrendered since May 26 when he allowed eight, also against the Rangers.
