BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a stretch of 15 games in 14 days tonight which started with an April 30 doubleheader vs. the Astros...The Birds will play each of the next nine days, including three-game sets against the Marlins, Athletics, and Yankees before enjoying an off-day on May 14.

Following yesterday's 12-1 setback, the Birds have suffered five straight losses by 5+ runs, marking the longest streak in franchise history...It is the longest streak by any MLB club since the Nationals had five straight such losses from July 30-August 5, 2025...The last team in the majors to suffer six straight defeats by 5+ runs were the 2000 Detroit Tigers, who had six straight losses by 5+ runs from April 18-24...The 2000 Tigers went on to finish the season 79-83.

The Birds suffered their second series sweep of 2026 (also 4/3-5 at PIT) and were swept by the Yankees in a four-game set for the first time since September 11-13, 2020.

Baltimore has dropped five straight overall for the first time since August 25-29, 2025 (also 5 G)...The O's have not lost six straight since an eight-game skid from May 14 (G1)-20, 2025.

Adley Rutschman tallied his 500th career hit last night, a 110.3 mph single in the opening frame, his hardest-hit ball of the season.

Last night, the O's scored only one run despite tallying 10 hits...Prior to last night, Baltimore had 10+ hits five times in 2026 and won each game, scoring no fewer than six runs in each contest...The Birds had won each of their last nine games when recording 10+ hits dating to August 30, 2025.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: Rico Garcia has posted a 0.61 ERA (1 ER/14.2 IP) with 16 strikeouts across 16 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

His .022 (1-for-45) opponent average and 0.34 WHIP are the best among all MLB relievers, outpacing MIA's John King (.063, 3-for-48) and SEA's Matt Brash (0.44 WHIP), respectively.

Garcia is the only pitcher in MLB since 1900 to allow one or zero hits through their first 16 appearances of the year.

He has yet to allow a hit in each of his eight home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of three Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with Bryan Baker (9 G, 2023) and Shawn Armstrong (8 G, 2019).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: Taylor Ward has reached base safely 66 times through his first 34 games with the O's (36 H, 29 BB, 1 HBP), the third-highest figure by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) behind Frank Robinson (72 TOB, 1966) and Roberto Alomar (68 TOB, 1996)...The record through 35 games is also held by Robinson (72 TOB).

Ward's .423 on-base percentage ranks fourth in MLB...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2nd, .410).

Ward has reached safely in 31 of the last 33 games since March 28 while slashing .298/.434/.430 (36-for-121) with 13 doubles, one homer, 19 runs scored, 12 RBI, 29 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time.

FASTBALL FOCUS: Baltimore hitters own a collective .470 slugging percentage off fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, cutter), the best mark in the AL and sixth-highest in MLB behind Arizona (.523), Atlanta (.519), Chicago-NL (.502), Los Angeles-NL (.490), and St. Louis (.473).

The O's .298 slugging percentage on all other pitches is second lowest in the majors ahead of only the Twins (.287).

During the four-game set in the Bronx, Oriole hitters slashed .235/.326/.321 (19-for-81) with one double, two homers, and a 22.8 percent strikeout rate against heaters, compared to .146/.180/.188 (7-for-48) with two doubles and a 32.0 percent strikeout rate on all other offerings.

POLAR BEAR PETE: Pete Alonso has hit safely in a season-high-tying five straight games (also 3/28-4/1), batting .353 (6-for-17) with two doubles, two home runs, five runs, and three RBI during that stretch.

Alonso's 32 career home runs opposite the Marlins are third most among all active players, trailing LAD's Freddie Freeman (42) and PHI's Bryce Harper (39).

He has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 games in Miami since July 31, 2022.

'PEN PALS: Grant Wolfram has not allowed a home run in 32.2 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 38.1 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

The O's 16.3 percent inherited runners scored rate (8 IRS/49 IR) is second lowest in the majors behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR).

The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

ROAD TRIPPIN': O's hitters have posted a .626 OPS on the road, the fourth-lowest mark in the majors ahead of the Pirates (.622), Phillies (.617), and Royals (.611)...Their .777 OPS at home ranks eighth highest in MLB.

Baltimore pitching has permitted 10+ hits in seven straight road games, its longest streak since a seven-game stretch from June 9-15, 2022...The Birds allowed 10+ hits in a franchise-record-tying eight straight games from May 26-June 12, 2017.

Overall this season, the O's have given up 10+ hits an MLB-high 21 times, with the next closest team being the Phillies (17 G)...Despite that figure, the Birds are 8-13 (.381) when allowing double-digit hits, the fourth-highest winning percentage in MLB behind the Yankees (4-2, .667), Braves (3-4, .429), and Diamondbacks (6-8, .429).

FIGURING OUT THE FISH: The O's and Marlins meet for their lone series of 2026 this week...Baltimore is 15-32 (.319) all-time opposite Miami, the lowest winning percentage against a single opponent in franchise history (since 1954), with the next closest club being Chicago-NL (8-17, .320).

Each of the last eight games between the Orioles and Marlins in Miami dating to May 22, 2015, have been decided by three runs or fewer, with the Birds going 3-5 in those affairs.

Baltimore used 70 different players in 2025, tied for the second-most players in a season by a team in major league history with the 2024 Marlins.

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY	
May 5, 2021	John Means throws the Orioles' first complete game no-hitter since Jim Palmer in 1969, striking out 12 and walking none in a 6-0 win at Seattle. The only runner to reach against Means is the Mariners' Sam Haggerty on a third-inning strikeout that eludes catcher Pedro Severino for a passed ball. Haggerty is promptly caught stealing. Means becomes the first pitcher in MLB history to record a non-perfect game while allowing no hits, walks, hit batters or batters reaching by error.

QUICK HITS: Bassitt is scheduled to make his seventh start of the season and 225th of his career in the series opener at Miami tonight...The 11-year veteran signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026, to mark his fifth MLB team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)...He is one of seven major league pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the past four seasons (2022-25)...Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 16th round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second consecutive victory on April 30 (G1) vs. Houston after allowing one run on seven hits and one walk with a season-high seven strikeouts across 6.2 innings pitched...Marked his first outing with seven or more strikeouts since August 20, 2025 at Pittsburgh (10)...Completed 6.2 innings for the first time since tossing 7.1 innings on July 23, 2025 vs. New York-AL...Threw 94 pitches, 62 strikes.

👉 Recorded a season-high-tying 12 whiffs (also 3/30 vs. TEX), six of which came on his curveball.

MIAMI VICE: Bassitt is scheduled to make his fifth career start vs. Miami, having gone 1-2 with a 4.21 ERA (12 ER/25.2 IP)...Has tossed at least 6.0 innings in each of those outings with three quality starts...Is 1-0 with a 4.85 ERA (7 ER/13.0 IP) over two career starts at loanDepot park, both of which came during the 2022 season with New York-NL.

👉 Holds a 3.35 ERA (160 ER/430.0 IP) over 74 career starts vs. NL opponents compared to his 3.84 ERA (374 ER/876.2 IP) opposite the AL.

👉 His 2.02 ERA (31 ER/138.0 IP) over 22 career starts vs. the NL East is his lowest mark against any division...Is riding a seven-game winning streak vs. the division since May 12, 2023, during which he holds a 1.03 ERA (7 ER/61.0 IP).

WEAK CONTACT: Only three of Bassitt's 101 batted balls (3.0%) have been barreled this season...The 3.0 percent barrel rate is the lowest mark of his career (since tracking began in 2015) and ranks in the 89th percentile of MLB...Likewise, his 32.7 percent hard-hit rate is his lowest figure since 2019 (31.7%).

👉 All three of his barreled balls have come on the road, including two on April 22 at Kansas City and one on April 5 at Pittsburgh.

ROADHOUSE BLUES: In his last road start on April 22 at Kansas City (W, 5.1 IP, 8 H, 2 HR, 5 R, 2 BB, 3 K), Bassitt snapped a six-decision losing streak that spanned seven games from July 28, 2025-April 5, 2026, which tied for the longest of his career (7/25/15-6/22[G2]/18)...Is 4-10 with a 5.82 ERA (58 ER/89.2 IP) in 19 road games (18 GS) since the beginning of the 2025 season compared to his 9-1 mark and 2.82 ERA (34 ER/108.2 IP) in 19 starts at home.

SINK OR SWIM: Opponents have gone 19-for-49 (.388) with two doubles and two home runs off his sinker, while whiffing at the offering only 14.0 percent of the time...Last season, the opposition hit .297 (86-for-290) with 18 doubles, seven home runs, and an 18.7 percent whiff rate on his sinker.

👉 However, Bassitt held hitters to a .154 mark (2-for-13) with three strikeouts on his sinker in his last outing on April 30 (G1) vs. Houston.

TO THE LEFT: All seven of the extra-base hits (4 2B, 3 HR) Bassitt has allowed this season have been to lefties, who are slugging .593 against him compared to a .281 mark for right-handed batters...In 2025, he allowed 38 extra-base hits (22 2B, 3 3B, 13 HR) to left-handed batters, more than double his 18 extra-base hits (9 2B, 9 HR) given up to righties.
