THE TWINS: Completed their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4, going 2-1 vs. Boston and 0-3 vs. the Reds...tonight, the Twins will begin their third roadtrip of the season with the first of three games against the Mets at Citi Field...after this series, they will travel to Tampa Bay to play the Rays at Tropicana Field over the weekend.

☞ Twins are looking to snap a four-game losing streak, their longest since dropping five-straight from September 16-20, 2025.

☞ Twins had their fourth off-day yesterday...they are 1-2 this season coming out of the off-day...their one win was in the second game of the season, a 4-1 win at Baltimore.

☞ Twins are playing their second NL opponent of the season...their next opponent in IL Play will be the Nationals in D.C. from May 5-7...last season, they went 20-28 vs. the NL.

BOY IS OUR FACE RED: The Twins lost to the Reds on Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 7-4 in 10 innings, suffering their first sweep of the season...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one unearned run on three hits in 6.1 innings pitched, with four walks and 10 strikeouts...marked sixth time in Ober's career he reached double-digit strikeout totals...the bullpen combined to allow six runs (3 earned) on four hits in 3.2 innings pitched, as the Twins held a 3-1 lead entering the top of the ninth; marked their first loss when leading after eight innings (11-1)...the offense recorded nine hits and walked six times, including two hits apiece from Victor Caratini and James Outman.

PLUSES AND MINUSES: Twins have made the following roster moves:

☞ Yesterday they placed right-handed pitcher Mick Abel on the 15-day IL with right elbow inflammation...Abel appeared in four games (3 starts) for the Twins, going 1-2, 3.98 ERA (20.1 IP, 9 ER), 10 walks and 23 strikeouts.

☞ Royce Lewis has been returned from rehab assignment and reinstated from 10-day IL... Lewis, who has missed the club's last nine games with a left knee sprain, played in two games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul this week, going 2-for-7 with two home runs and three RBI...Lewis hurt the knee twisting it in the batters box during an at-bat on April 9.

☞ Kody Funderburk has been placed on the Paternity List...Funderburk has appeared in 12 games for the Twins this season, going 1-1, 2.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 2 ER), seven walks, eight strikeouts, a .212 opponent batting average, one save and four holds.

☞ Kendry Rojas has been recalled from Triple-A St. Paul...Rojas, 23, made two appearances (1 start) for the Saints, throwing 6.0 shutout innings, with four hits allowed, two walks and five strikeouts...the Ciego de Avila, Cuba native was acquired by the Twins at the 2025 trade deadline from Toronto along with outfielder Alan Roden, in exchange for infielder Ty France and right-handed pitcher Louis Varland...entering the season, Rojas was ranked as the club's eighth-best prospect by *Baseball America* and 10th-best prospect by MLB.com.

IN THE CITY: The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 32nd, 33rd, and 34th times in their history this week...Minnesota is 13-18 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 3-8 at Citi Field and 4-7 at Target Field.

☞ These two last met for three games at Target Field from April 14-16, 2025 as the Twins lost game one but won games two and three.

☞ The last time the Twins played at Citi Field came July 29-31, 2024, as the Twins won just game three of the three-game series.

☞ Derek Shelton has a managerial record of 10-17 vs. the Mets, 3-11 at Citi Field.

☞ Twins are just 2-7 in their last nine at Citi Field and have never won a series in this ballpark in four chances.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .313 (5-for-16) with two doubles, one home run, three walks, a .450 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.075 OPS in five career games vs. the Mets.

☞ Tonight's starter, Simeon Woods Richardson, was drafted by the Mets in the second round (48th overall) in the 2018 MLB Draft out of I. H. Kempner HS in Sugar Land, TX...he played two seasons in the Mets' minor league system for GCL Mets and Rookie-Kingsport from 2018-19...he was traded to Toronto on July 28, 2019 with Anthony Kay for Marcus Stroman and cash.

AUSTIN MARTIN. INTENSITY. DRIVEN.: Austin Martin has reached base safely in 13-straight games with a plate appearance and in 16 of 18 games with a plate appearance...the 13-straight is the 11th-longest active streak in baseball (Ohtani is the leader with 21)...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Martin's own 16-game on-base streak from September 2-20, 2025.

☞ Martin currently leads the club with 14 walks...he has posted a .484 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 60 plate appearances.

☞ Dating back to September 4, 2025, he is hitting .306 (38-for-124) with nine doubles, 10 RBI, 23 runs scored, 24 walks, a .428 on-base percentage and an .831 OPS.

THE RUNNING MEN: Twins have scored 112 runs on the season, third-most in the AL and eighth-most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (133), Atlanta (131), Houston (130), Washington (125), Chicago-NL (117), Los Angeles-AL (117) and Pittsburgh (113).

☞ 43 of their 112 runs scored (38%) on the season have come via the home run...they have hit 26 home runs this season, tied for sixth-most in baseball...they have gone homerless in three-straight games, their longest streak this season.

JOSHIN' AROUND: Over his last 12 games, Josh Bell is hitting .304 (14-for-46) with two doubles, one home run, three walks, eight RBI, eight runs scored, a .347 on-base percentage and a .760 OPS.

☞ Bell is hitting .304 (6-for-20) with two home runs off breaking pitches this seasons.

☞ Bell has 196 career home runs, needing four to become the 40th active player in baseball to reach the 200 home run mark...Xander Bogaerts reached the 200-homer mark on April 12...Bell's last homer came on April 9 vs. Detroit, off Jack Flaherty.

ROGER THAT: Left-handed reliever Taylor Rogers officially reached the 10 years of major league service mark yesterday on the off-day... Rogers was selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2012 MLB Draft and made his debut with the Twins in 2016...over his 11-plus years, he has pitched for the Twins (2016-21, '26), Padres (22), Brewers (22), Giants (23-24), Reds (25) and Cubs (25)...he has appeared in 575 career games, seventh-most among actives...he is the second Twin to reach his 10-year mark this season after Byron Buxton did so on April 5.

☞ Rogers ranks tied for 16th on the Twins all-time list in games (328), sixth among lefties.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1961, the Twins played their first game in Minnesota at Metropolitan Stadium after moving from Washington, D.C....they lost that game to the expansion "new" Washington Senators by a score of 5-3...Camilo Pascual was the starter for the Twins, allowing three runs on eight hits in 8.0 innings pitched...Ray Moore was the losing pitcher, allowing two runs in the top of the ninth inning...the Twins went on to win their first ever game in Minnesota the following day against the Senators.

- ☞ Making his fifth start of the season, 56th start of his career (58th game) and second career start vs. New York-NL.
- ☞ On April 15 vs. Boston, took the loss in a 9-5 Twins' defeat, allowing seven runs on a career-high 10 hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched with three walks and three strikeouts.
- ☞ Is 0-2 with a 7.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 7 ER), two walks and four strikeouts away from Target Field this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Woods Richardson made his fourth start of the season on April 15 vs. Boston opposite left-hander Connelly Early...received the loss, his second in as many starts and third straight decision with a loss to begin 2026...marked the first time he has started a season with three losses before recording a win; sixth consecutive start without a win dating back to September 21, 2025 vs. Cleveland, his longest such streak since going seven starts without a victory from July 2-August 10, 2024...allowed seven runs (six earned) on a career-high 10 hits (1 HR) through 5.0 innings pitched with three walks and three strikeouts in the outing.

- ☞ Surrendered a three-run shot to Trevor Story in the third inning; has allowed a home run in four consecutive starts to begin the season, joining Colorado's Tomoyuki Sugano and St. Louis' Matthew Liberatore as the only starters in MLB to allow a homer in each of their first four starts of the year.
- ☞ Each of the first five Boston batters reached to begin the third inning courtesy of singles by Isiah Kiner-Falefa and Cedanne Rafaela, a walk by Roman Anthony, a two-error sequence by Luke Keaschall on a Masataka Yoshida grounder that brought in a pair of runs, and then Trevor Story's blast to cap off a five-run frame.

TWO STARTS AGO: Sim made his third start of the season on April 10 at Toronto, his former organization, opposite left-hander Patrick Corbin...took the loss, allowing five runs on six hits (1 HR) through 4.0 innings pitched with one walk and two strikeouts.

- ☞ Sim was traded to Minnesota from Toronto along with Austin Martin on July 30, 2021 in exchange for right-hander Jose Berrios.

MEET THE METS: Sim is set to make his second career start against New York-NL; he is 0-1 with a 16.20 ERA (3.1 IP, 6 ER), three walks, two strikeouts, a .438 (7-for-16) BAA and a 3.00 WHIP against the Mets...in his lone outing against New York-NL on July 29, 2024, Sim took the loss, pitched 3.1 innings and allowed six runs on seven hits - including a home run from Pete Alonso - with three walks and two strikeouts in a 15-2 Twins loss at Citi Field.

- ☞ Has faced nine current Mets' hitters in his career; those nine players have combined for a .344 (11-for-32) BAA with four doubles, three home runs, five walks, six strikeouts and seven RBI.
- ☞ Was traded from New York-NL to Toronto on July 28, 2019 alongside left-hander Anthony Kay in exchange for right-hander Marcus Stroman and cash considerations; at the time of the trade, Simeon was ranked as the No. 6 prospect in the Mets' system.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Today's game will mark Simeon's 17th career start against an Interleague opponent (19th game); 4-5, 4.26 ERA (82.1 IP, 39 ER) with 35 walks, 72 strikeouts, 10 homers allowed, a 1.38 WHIP and a .253 (79-for-312) BAA in those contests.

- ☞ In 2025, Sim went 2-2 with a 2.91 ERA (34.0 IP, 11 ER) across six starts against National League opponents, totaling 15 walks, 27 strikeouts, a 1.15 WHIP and a .198 (24-for-121) BAA.
- ☞ In five career starts (7 games) against the NL East, Woods Richardson is 1-2 with a 4.99 ERA (39.2 IP, 22 ER), 15 walks and 33 strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Sim has gone 6-5 with a 4.03 ERA (140.2 IP, 63 ER), 55 walks, 133 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP in 28 games (27 starts) at home compared to 6-8 with a 4.68 ERA (134.2 IP, 70 ER), 52 walks, 110 strikeouts and a 1.36 WHIP in 29 road games (28 starts).

- ☞ Is 0-2, 7.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 7 ER) with two walks, four strikeouts, a 1.44 WHIP and a .297 (11-for-37) BAA in his two starts away from Target Field this season; it is his highest ERA through the first two road starts of a season in his career.
- ☞ He allowed five runs in his last road start but had permitted two earned runs through 11.0 innings pitched combined across his two prior starts away from Target Field.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In his first four starts of 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .275/.341/.500 (11-for-40) with three doubles, two home runs, four walks and seven strikeouts, while righties are slashing .341/.383/.568 (15-for-44) with four doubles, two home runs, three walks and four strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .243/.318/.382 (116-for-477) with 51 walks and 109 strikeouts (2.14 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .247/.312/.423 (141-for-572) with 55 walks and 134 strikeouts (2.44 K/BB).

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson relies on a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ Sim's -4 run value with his slider and his -5 run value with his split finger each rank as the worst among all pitchers in Major League Baseball.
- ☞ His .350 (7-for-20) opponent batting average against the slider is the eighth worst in the league (min. 10 plate appearances).
- ☞ This season, Sim has an overall strikeout percentage of just 12.0%, over eight percent below his career average; it falls within the bottom five percent among all pitchers this season.

WELL TRAVELED: Simeon is no stranger to pitching in opposing ballparks, with today's outing marking his 29th road start of his career, accounting for nearly 52% of his starts... he is one of 35 pitchers in Twins club history (1961-) to make his first 28 career road starts in MLB with Minnesota...among those 35 starters through their first 28 career road starts, Simeon has the fewest decisions (13), hits allowed (125) and innings pitched (130.1 IP), is tied with Roger Erickson for the fewest losses (7), is eighth in earned runs allowed (67), and is second in total baserunners allowed (183), trailing only teammate Bailey Ober (166) during that span.

EARLY AND OFTEN: Through his first 55 starts, Woods Richardson has set the tone in the first inning, posting a career 2.78 ERA (55.0 IP, 17 ER) with 26 walks, 54 strikeouts and a .204 (41-for-201) BAA in the opening frame...below are some of his numbers in the first inning and where those numbers rank among starting pitchers in Twins club history since 1974 (min. 200 plate appearances):
