TODAY'S GAME: The Giants open their six-game homestand tonight with the first of three games vs. the Dodgers...SF is coming off a nine-game, 11-day road trip in which the Giants went 4-5 with stops in Baltimore (1-2), Cincinnati (1-2) and D.C. (2-1).

- ▶ After falling to 6-12 on the season last Wednesday, SF has won three of its last four, outscoring opponents 20-14 and out-hitting opponents 45-26.
- ▶ The Giants went 4-9 against the Dodgers last season (2-4 at Oracle Park)...since 2022, SF is 18-40 (.310) vs. the Dodgers, which is the team's fourth-worst winning percentage against any team, and the worst against any NL opponent over that span.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants announced the following roster moves today.

- ▶ **C Daniel Susac** placed on the 10-day IL with right elbow ulnar neuritis (retro to 4/20).
- ▶ **C Eric Haase** (#18) selected from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **RHP José Buttó** transferred to the 60-day Injured List.

ROUPP THERE IT IS: RHP Landen Roupp looks to earn his fourth win of the season...he has won two straight games, allowing just one run on six hits while striking out 10 across 12.0 innings over two starts last road trip (April 10 at Baltimore and April 16 at Cincinnati).

- ▶ Roupp was solid in his last start vs. the Dodgers in 2025 despite receiving the loss, striking out eight while allowing two runs (one earned) over 6.0 innings on July 12.
- ▶ The righty's best pitch in terms of putaway rate (33.3%) and strikeouts (12) is his curveball, which has a 28.4% usage rate...the Dodgers have a 36.1% strikeout rate vs. curveballs, which is the eighth-highest mark in MLB.
- ▶ Since the start of last season, Roupp is 7-5 with a 3.00 ERA (27er, 81.0ip) in starts following a Giants' loss in the previous game.

BACK ON THE GRIND: The Giants did get eight hits in Sunday's defeat, but left 10 runners on-base as a team while going 0-for-11 with runners in scoring position.

- ▶ The Giants are one of just three teams in the Majors with six or more players with 20+ hits on the season (*Stats, LLC*)...SF's three 15-hit games this season are tied for second-most in MLB, behind only the Dodgers' six such games.
- ▶ The Giants are batting .254 (46x181) with RISP this season (15th in MLB), yet their .670 OPS (25th in MLB) and 3.41 runs per game (27th in MLB) are near the bottom.

YOU AGAIN?: The Giants will face Dodgers pitcher Yoshinobu Yamamoto for the fifth time in his career tonight...after totaling nine runs in 10.1 innings vs. Yamamoto over his first two career starts vs. SF, the Giants have been held to just one run on five hits while striking out 24 times over their last three games vs. Yamamoto (19.1ip).

- ▶ In their last three games vs. Yamamoto, the Giants are 1-for-21 (.048) vs. his splitter and 1-for-13 (.077) vs. his four-seamer.
- ▶ Of the 71 Giants faced in those three starts, 42 of the plate appearances ended in pitcher's counts (0-1, 0-2, 1-2, 2-2)...SF hit .048 (2x42) in those at-bats.
- ▶ Both **IF Willy Adames** and **IF Casey Schmitt** have homers in their careers vs. Yamamoto with Schmitt's being a grand slam.

HEATING UP: SF's outfield entered the road trip with a .164/.212/.221 slash line (.433 OPS), which were all last in MLB...since April 10 (first day of the road trip), SF's outfield posted a slash line of .277/.318/.455 (.773 OPS)...the .277 batting average is fifth-best in MLB.

- ▶ **OF Heliot Ramos** led the team with 10 RBI over the road trip, batting .323 (10x31) with four runs, three doubles and two homers...**OF Jung Hoo Lee** also had a strong road trip, batting .361 (13x36) with five runs, three doubles, a homer and three RBI.

ALLARRAEZ: Prior to his 0-for-4 on Sunday, **IF Luis Arraez** on Saturday became one of just six Giants to record 25+ hits in their first 20 games with the team since 2000 (*Stats, LLC*), joining **Pablo Sandoval** (2008), **Marco Scutaro** (2012), **Nori Aoki** (2015), **Alex Dickerson** (2019) and teammate **IF Casey Schmitt** (2023).

PEN TO PAPER: The Giants' bullpen has allowed just two earned runs over their last six games (0.84 ERA, 21.1ip, 24 strikeouts and seven walks).

- ▶ Since April 7, the SF bullpen has a 2.04 ERA (8er, 35.1ip) over its last 11 games...opponents have hit .177 in that time with a .546 OPS...the 2.04 ERA in that span is second-best in MLB behind only the Reds (1.78 ERA).

HEADLINER

San Francisco's signature - remixed and framed in our gradient accent.

JERSEY SCRIPT

The Giants chest script flows like sound and is influenced by psychedelic posters and a lava lamp - moving with the energy of the game, the moment and the music.

SOUND WAVES

The jerseys feature a sound wave moving through the tops that gives the impression of pressed grooves on vinyl.

GLOVE PATCH

The glove patch is a fusion of past and present, inspired by warped 1960s gig posters as well as the iconic outfield glove in left field at Oracle Park.

GRADIENT ACCENTS

Orange and violet crossfade - vibrant and fluid. The purple pays tribute to the New York Giants from 1913 to 1917, when the team wore violet as a nod to New York University (NYU). It also honors the Fillmore's stage lights and Haight-Ashbury's posters - a symbol of rebellion and artistry.

WITH SAN FRANCISCO: Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco and made his third career Opening Day roster...he is slated to make his fifth start of the season tonight after going 3-1 through his first four starts.

LAST START: Made his third start on the road of the season, and was stellar once again, as he earned the win...flirted with a no-hitter against the Reds until P.J. Higgins hit a lead-off single in the 6th inning...finished 6.0 innings and did not allow a run while giving up just one hit and striking out six...extended his streak of consecutive road starts of 6.0+ innings and one-or-fewer runs allowed to three games, which is the longest such streak of his career and is tied with Los Angeles-AL's José Soriano for the longest active streak in the majors...Roupp's current two-game win streak is tied for the longest of his career (most recent: 6/21/25-6/27/25).

VS. DODGERS: Has appeared in four games in his career against LAD (two starts), and holds a 7.30 ERA over 12.1 innings...the high ERA is largely due to his outing at Los Angeles on June 14 of last season, the shortest start of his career, in which he allowed six earned runs and walked five over 1.2 frames...in his most recent start against the Dodgers, he bounced back with a 6.0 inning performance at Oracle park on July 12, 2025, in which he was a tough-luck loser but only allowed two runs (one earned) and struck out eight.

(SURPRISE) ROAD WARRIOR: Through the early going this season, has an 0.50 ERA in three starts on the road (3-0, 18.0ip, 1er) compared to a 9.64 ERA at home after a tough start vs. the Mets... this is the opposite of 2025, as he had a 2.63 ERA (14er, 48.0ip) in nine starts at Oracle Park compared to a 4.76 ERA (31er, 58.2ip) in 13 starts on the road...his 2.63 home ERA ranked as the 14th-lowest among NL pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched at home.

MIXING IT UP: In 2025, Roupp's curveball (thrown 35.7% of the time) was very effective, as opponents were just 29x147 (.197) with 49 strikeouts and a 35.8% whiff rate against it...this season, he's mixing his pitches more, throwing the curveball just 28.4% of the time... its been just as effective, as opponents are 5x31 (.161) off the curve with a 31.3% whiff rate... the big change is his cutter usage has increased from 6.7% in 2025 to 12.9% through four starts in 2026...while opponents have hit it hard (5-for-7, three singles and two doubles) it's helped the rest of his pitches and hitters stay off his sinker and curveball.

2025 SEASON: Was the Giants' fourth starter for most of the season...had his year cut short after suffering a left knee bone bruise in his start on August 20 at San Diego...the injury shut his season down and he went 7-7 with a 3.80 ERA (45er, 106.2ip), 102 strikeouts and 45 walks allowed in 22 starts (eight quality outings)...the Giants went 12-10 in his outings.

AIN'T NOBODY GOT TIME FOR THAT: With the bases empty, Roupp averaged 11.9 seconds between pitches in 2025, which was tied for the second-quickest in the Majors...Cincinnati's Brent Suter was quickest with only 11.5 seconds between pitches with the bases empty...he's been a tad slower this year, averaging 12.7 seconds between pitches with the bases empty which is still good for sixth-fastest in MLB... league average thus far in 2026 is 16.1 seconds.

- ▶ Is looking to bounce back from a rough outing last Wednesday at Cincinnati...suffered the loss after matching a career-high eight runs...walked five in 4.0 innings of work.
- ▶ Will face the Dodgers for the eighth time in his career...is 2-3 with a 3.72 ERA in seven career starts vs. LA.
- ▶ Last faced them on April 20, 2025 with the Texas Rangers... threw 7.0 scoreless innings with two hits and four Ks.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; 0.1ip, k (6 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-14 (.143) with two walks and five strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .180 clip (69-for-383) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 7-for-14 with three XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 4/19 at WSH; 1.0ip (12 pitches)

- ▶ Eight of his nine appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Has issued at least one walk in six of nine contests (6.35 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 9-for-27 (.333) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-13 (.077).
- ▶ Three of his nine appearances thus far have been 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; 1.0ip (6 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed a homer to James Wood on Friday night, the first homer he'd allowed in 41.0 MLB innings dating to June 11, 2023.
- ▶ Has appeared in 10 of SF's 22 games, tossing 9.1-innings.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; W, 2.0ip, bb, 2k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Earned his first MLB win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief on Saturday...stranded the free base runner in both the 11th & the 12th.
- ▶ Allowed one run on two hits in 10.0 innings with 14 strikeouts and six walks in 10 games.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.

#60 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; 1.0ip, 2k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Struck out three batters in the 9th last Thursday at Cincinnati to record his first career save...overall, struck out five of the last six batters he faced.
- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's 22 games, allowing four runs in 7.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 52.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fourth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

Last Game: 4/17 at WSH; 1.0ip, hbp (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in five of his six outings (2er, 8.0ip) and posted a 0.75 WHIP and .192 BAA.
- ▶ Has only walked one batter in 8.0 innings this season...his 3.6% walk rate ranks in the top 6% of the league.
- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL...logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants MGR Tony Vitello while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/18 at WSH; BS, 2.0ip, 3h, r, er, 2bb, 2k (26 pitches)

- ▶ Blew his first save of the season Saturday in the 9th, but was able to throw a scoreless 10th inning by stranding the free base runner.
- ▶ Has appeared in nine of SF's first 22 games.
- ▶ Batters are 3-for-17 in ABs that end with his slider and 6-for-18 in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider last season.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 4/19 at WSH; 1.0ip, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Eight of his 10 appearances this year have been scoreless...opponents are just 4-for-32 (.125) off him this year.
- ▶ Struck out 12 batters in 9.1 innings of work.
- ▶ Batters are just 1-for-18 with 10 K's off his splitter this season.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.
