# **NEW YORK METS (42-44) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (42-45)**

July 6, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 4:05 EDT - GAME #88/HOME #44 LHP DAVID PETERSON (3-0, 3.51 ERA) vs. LHP BAILEY FALTER (4-6, 3.87 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...scored a season-high 14 runs while hitting a club record-tying seven home runs last night...Have gone 15-14, including 10-7 at home, in one-run games... Have won 10 games in their last at-bat, matching their total from all of 2023 (the team won 13 games in the final at-bat of 2022)...Have gone 32-3 (.914 winning percentage) when outhitting their opponents this season...Have not been shut out in 32 straight games, which is tied for the seventh-longest

active streak in MLB (the Cardinals have the longest active streak at 65 games)...Have recorded an extra base hit in a season-high 19 straight games.

CLEARING THE DECK: Pittsburgh's seven home runs last night tied a club record, SEVEN HOME RUNS HIT IN A GAME which has now been accomplished five times...The seven home runs are the most in a single game in MLB this season...Last year six teams went deep seven times in a game, which included the Pirates on May 26 at Seattle...According to @OptaStats, the Pirates became the first team in MLB history to end a game scoring 14-plus unanswered runs with all of them coming on home runs.

A SLAMMING WE WILL GO: The Pirates have hit six grand slams this year, which ranks second in all of MLB (the Brewers lead with seven)...Pittsburgh's six grand slams are the most for the team since the team also hit six in 2000...The club record MOST GRAND SLAMS IN A GAME IN for most grand slams in a season is seven, which was accomplished in both 1978 and 1996...According to @OptaStats, Rowdy Tellez and Bryan Reynolds became the first pair of teammates in MLB history to each hit multiple home runs, including a grand slam, in the same game on Friday.

ALL-STAR WORTHY: Bryan Reynolds recorded his third career six-RBI game, sixth career multi homer game and third career grand slam on Friday...Since the beginning of last month, Reynolds ranks first in the National League in total bases (80) and hits (42), tied for second in extra base hits (18), fifth in OPS (1.033), third in slugging (.645), and tied for fourth in home runs (nine).

**HOT ROWD:** Rowdy Tellez comes into today one home run shy of 100 in his career...Tellez has gone deep four times in his last five games and five times in his last eight contests...Since June 16, Tellez is tied for eighth in the National League in batting (.340), ninth in slugging (.679) and 11th in OPS (1.054).

**ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER:** Bailey Falter gets the start this afternoon in game two of this series against the Mets...Falter allowed just one run in 5.0 innings while winning a 4-2 decision in his last start Sunday in Atlanta...Falter comes into today with a 3.87 ERA, which ranks eighth among all left-handed pitchers in the National League.

**B-REY AND BOBBY BO:** Bryan Reynolds is tied with Bobby Bonilla for the most home runs (114) in Pirates history among switch hitters...That's also tied for 17th overall in Pirates history. Reynolds is now two home runs shy of tying Andy Van Slyke and Dick Stuart for 15th place in team history in home runs (117).

# BOMBS AWAY AT THE BEST BALLPARK IN AMERICA: The

Pirates have gone deep in nine consecutive games at PNC Park, hitting a total of 16 home runs during that time...It's the longest home run streak at PNC Park since 2017 when the team went deep in 12 straight games from August 4-23...Overall, it's the fourth-longest home run streak at PNC Park since the ballpark opened in 2001.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen's double on Wednesday moved him into sole possession of sixth place for the most career extra base hits (591) in Pirates history... He is now one extra base hit shy of tying Pie Traynor for the fifth-most in team history...McCutchen also ranks fifth on the team's all-time walks list (796) after passing Hall of Famer Ralph Kiner on Thursday...The only four Pirates with more career walks are Willie Stargell (937), Max Carey (919), Paul Waner (912) and Honus Wagner (877).

## **ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY**

July 6, 1933: Future Hall of Famers Paul Waner and Pie Traynor represented the Pirates at Comiskey Field in Chicago in the very first game in All-Star history. Traynor delivered a pinch-hit double in the seventh inning off Lefty Grove while Waner played the final inning of the game in right field in a 4-2 win by the American League.

# 2024 RECORD: 4-6, 3.87 ERA

**HEIGHT/WEIGHT:** 6-4/175 BATS/THROWS: R/L

BORN: April 24, 1997

**AGE:** 27 SIGNED: Thru 2024

HOW ACQUIRED: From the Phillies in exchange for INF Rodolfo Castro on 8/1/23

STARTING OFF: The 27-year-old lefthander is in his second season with the Pirates after being acquired from the Phillies at the trade deadline last season (August 1) in exchange for INF Rodolfo Castro...Falter is in his fourth Major League season...He made 50 appearances (24 starts) for the Phillies from 2021-23...He has also made 26 appearances (23 starts) with the Pirates from 2023-24 after being selected in the fifth round of the 2015 draft by Philadelphia.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the win on June 30th at Atlanta, allowing one run on just two hits with five strikeouts against four walks in 5.0 innings pitched.

**AGAINST THE METS:** Falter will be making his sixth career appearance and fifth start against the Mets today, including his second this season...Has gone 1-2 with a 2.95 ERA (7 ER in 21.1 IP) and 15 strikeouts against eight walks in those outings

Falter made the start against the Mets on April 17 at Citi Field, taking the loss after allowing just two runs on four hits with four strikeouts and one walk in 5.0 innings of work.

**LEAGUE LEADERS:** Falter enters play among the NL leaders in several categories, including ranking first in pitches per batter faced (3.57) and pitches per inning (14.3), 18th in opponents OPS (.680) and opponents batting average (.234).

**HOME COOKIN':** Today will be Falter's eighth start of the season at PNC Park, where he's pitched to a 2-2 record with a 3.38 ERA (16 ER in 42.2 IP)...He has allowed three or fewer runs in six of those outings, including two or fewer four times.

Over his last nine appearances (eight starts) at PNC Park since Sept. 6, 2023, Falter has gone 3-2 with a 2.92 ERA (17 ER in 52.1 IP).

IF YOU TAKE AWAY ONE INNING...: Since allowing five runs in his first inning of the season on March 31 at Miami, Falter has pitched to a 3.40 ERA (33 ER in 87.1 IP).

Has posted a 6.75 ERA (12 ER in 16.0 IP) in the first inning this year, compared to

3.24 ERA (26 ER in 72.1 IP) through the rest of the game.

**GETTING IT DONE:** Falter has twice posted outings of 6.0-plus innings pitched and two or fewer hits allowed - April 6 vs. Baltimore (6.0ip/1h) and May 31 at Toronto (6.0ip/2 h)...He is one of five NL lefties to have multiple such outings this season, joining PHI Ranger Suarez (2), ATL Chris Sale (2), LAD James Paxton (2) and ATL Max Fried (2).

THAT'S QUALITY: Falter turned in four consecutive quality starts from May 12-31, which matched the longest such streak of his career (also: July 29-August 31, 2022)... It was the longest quality start streak by a Pirates lefty since Jonathan Niese also had a four game streak from May 9-27, 2016.

**JUST LIKE SANDY:** Growing up in Chino Hills, California, Falter's father, Darwin, taught him to idolize fellow left-handed pitcher Sandy Koufax...Bailey would do reports on Koufax at school and even had a framed picture of the Dodgers southpaw hanging above his childhood bed...To this day, his delivery on the mound mimics that of Koufax.

IT'S GOING TO BE MAY: In five starts in the month of May, Falter went 1-0 with a 2.23 ERA (32.1ip/8er) and a .193 opponents average (22-for-114)...He ranked in the top 10 in the NL in each of those categories, including tied for seventh in opponents average, ninth in innings pitched and 10th in ERA.

Among NL left-handed pitchers in May, he was tied for third in opponents average, fourth in innings pitched and fifth in ERA.

**ON DECK:** The Pirates have not named a starter for tomorrow's game against the Mets.

WHAT THE METRICS SAY: Per Baseball Savant, Falter's four-seam fastball has a run value of 7, tied for the 10th-best mark in the NL this season (St. Louis' Lance Lynn leads the league with 14).

Falter has an average 7.4 foot extension when releasing the pitch, which ranks in the 99th percentile in Major League Baseball this season...He also ranked in the 99th percentile in 2023 and was in the 100th percentile from 2021-22.

BACK HOME IN CALIFORNIA: Attended Chino Hills High School where he was classmates with NBA players Lonzo and LeMelo Ball...He had committed to play collegiately at the University of California Santa Barbara prior to signing with the Phillies in 2015
