#### Missed It By That Much!

The Brewers were just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons, missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game.

#### Brewing Consistency

The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does not include the 2020 season.

#### 90

The Brewers had their 11th season all time with 90+ wins: **1978** (93), **1979** (95), **1982** (95), **1987** (91), **1992** (92), **2008** (90), **2011** (96), **2018** (96), **2021** (95), **2023** (92) and **2024** (93).

**SEASON SUMMARY:** The Brewers went 93-69 in 2024 as they finished in first place in the NL Central, 10.0 games ahead of the Cardinals and Cubs....the team qualified for the postseason for the sixth time in the last seven seasons and won the NL Central for the fourth time in the last seven seasons and second straight season....the Brewers were defeated by the Mets, 2 games to 1, in the NL Wild Card series in Milwaukee.

**FREE AGENTS (2):** The following players will become free agent at the conclusion of the 2024 season: **SS Willy Adames** and **RHP Joe Ross**.

**MANAGER:** **Pat Murphy** was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing **Craig Counsell**....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54)....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009)....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

**COACHES:** First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... **Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach), **Matt Erickson** (infield coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) all completed their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.
