HISPANIC HERITAGE WEEKEND: This weekend's Hispanic Heritage Weekend presented by Estrella Jalisco will celebrate Puerto Rican Heritage tomorrow and Dominican Republic Heritage on Sunday as well as offer specialty food items at Taste of Chase at Section 130: Venezuelan Arepas Pelúa and Mexican Picadillo Empanadas...tomorrow's Special Event Ticket Pack features a Puerto Rican-inspired D-backs jersey while the stadium festivities include a recognition of Puerto Rican-owned businesses Phoenix Coqui and Batey Puerto Rican Gastronomy and performances by Miguel “Mambo” De Leon and Orgullo Boricua AZ...Sunday's Special Event Ticket Pack features a Dominican Republic-inspired hat while the stadium festivities will include dance lessons in La Terraza and a performance by Stilo Dance Company, a pregame recognition of Dominican community leaders Caroline Torres and Vanessa Garcia as well as a celebration of the award-winning Mambo’s Dominican Kitchen.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 4-2 in their last 6 games vs. Reds and 9-6 in their last 15 games (since 2024).

- Vs. Reds, the D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 home games and 10-6 in their last 16 home games (since 2021).
- **Corbin Carroll is celebrating his 26th birthday today**...has reached base safely in 9 straight games, batting .333 (10-for-30)/1.254 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 3 RBI, 7 walks, and 1 stolen base.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has a career-best 13-game hitting streak, batting .370 (20-for-54)/1.080 OPS with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 13 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** has had back-to-back quality starts with a 2.77 ERA (4 ER in 13.0 IP), opponent .204 AVG (10-for-49)/.603 OPS, 2 walks and 14 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 7-6 in the 10-inning series finale @ Red Sox on Wednesday.

- In the 10th, **Nolan Arenado** (2-for-5, RBI) hit a 1-out single to make it a 6-5 game before 3 consecutive walks by **Tim Tawa** (0-for-4, BB), **James McCann** (PH-BB) and **Jose Fernandez** (2-for-4, 2 2B, RBI, BB) made it a 7-5 score.
- Had a 3-run fifth via 3 doubles from **Jose Fernandez**, **Ryan Waldschmidt** and **Gabriel Moreno**.
- **Lars Nootbaar** (1-for-2, HR, 2 RBI), in the sixth as a pinch-hitter for **Jordan Lawlar**, hit a 2-run homer for his first as a D-back.
- **Brandon Pfaadt** went decisionless (5 ER in 5.2 IP, 7 H, 0 BB, 8 K) after allowing just 2 runs on 4 hits thru 5.0 frames.
- Relievers **Juan Morillo** (1.0 IP), **Brandyn Garcia** (0.2 IP) and **Kevin Ginkel** (0.2 IP) went scoreless from the sixth-eighth innings.
- **Jonathan Loaisiga** (1 R-0 ER in 2.0 IP, H, 0 BB) earned his fourth win after tossing the ninth and 10th innings (allowed UER in 10th).

ROSTER MOVE: Last night, the D-backs reinstated **Ketel Marte** from the Restricted List and placed him on the 10-Day Injured List (left knee inflammation).

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 1.0 game behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 3.0 games behind the Phillies (WC2, lead season 2-1) and 7.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1).

MORENO'S HOME STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno's** career-best 29-game home on-base streak is the third longest single-season home streak in club history, behind Steve Finley’s 31 in 2000 and Stephen Drew’s 38 in 2009.

MILESTONE WATCH: **James McCann** is 1 game shy of 1,000 career games and 1 hit shy of 800 career.

SINCE JULY 9: The D-backs' 22 wins (22-14) since July 9 are tied for second in the Majors with the Yankees, Cubs, Padres, Rays and Braves, behind the Red Sox (26).

HITTING LEFTIES: The D-backs offense vs. lefties ranks among all teams in August in doubles (T-1st, 15), P/PA (3rd, 4.25), AVG (4th, .274), OBP (4th, .359), OPS (4th, .807), SLG (6th, .448), hits (6th, 55) and walks (T-th, 26).

TRENDING BATS VS. LHP: **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 8 games vs. lefties, is hitting .333 (5-for-15)/1.233 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 1 RBI and 4 walks (3 K).

- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 7 games vs. lefties, is hitting .313 (5-for-16)/.826 OPS with 2 doubles and 2 walks (2 K).
- **James McCann**, in his last 13 games vs. lefties, is hitting .438 (7-for-16)/1.026 OPS with 1 double, 2 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt**, in his last 22 games vs. lefties, is hitting .348 (8-for-23)/.879 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 RBI and 4 walks (3 K).

VS. STARTING PITCHERS: The D-backs offense vs. starting pitchers ranks among NL teams since Aug. 10 in AVG (3rd, .259), SLG (3rd, .476), fewest strikeouts (3rd, 37), XBH (3rd, 21), OBP (4th, .324), OPS (4th, .800), TB (4th, 79) and runs (T-5th, 26).

MORENO'S HITTING STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno's** 13-game hitting streak is tied for the second longest by a D-backs catcher (primary position as catcher w/ plate appearances as designated hitter and pinch hitter):
