THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their six-game homestand, going 1-2
against Washington over the weekend, followed by a victory last night over Bostontonight.
they will continue the homestand with the second of three against the Red Soxthey will
complete the series and homestand tomorrow afternoon, then travel to Cleveland for six games
in seven daysafter an off-day on Thursday, they will play the Guardians for three games
over the weekend, then play the Tigers in Detroit from Monday-Wednesday.

BLAME IT ON THE RAIN: The Twins beat the Red Sox last night by a score of 5-4 in walk-off fashion...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Royce Lewis and DaShawn Keirsey Jr...it marked Keirsey's first career multi-hit game as he added a two-run homer, the third of his career...the game was delayed in the middle of the ninth inning due to strong storms, which held the game in check for one hour and 30 minutes...when play resumed, the Twins put their first three batters on and eventually won it on a Brooks Lee two-run single.

The walk-off win marked the eighth for the Twins this season, tied for second-most in baseball with Boston and Los Angeles-NL, trailing San Francisco (9).

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins today placed outfielder Byron Buxton on the 10-day Injured List (retroactive to July 27) with left ribcage inflammation and reinstated catcher Ryan Jeffers from the Paternity List...Buxton was removed from Saturday's game in the seventh inning with the injury and has played in 85 games for the Twins this season, hitting .282 (92-for-326) with 14 doubles, four triples, 23 home runs, 59 RBI, 29 walks, 17 stolen bases, 68 runs scored and a .905 OPS.

♣ Jeffers' wife, Lexi, gave birth to a son, Hayes, on Saturday.

♣ Additionally, the Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Pierson Ohl from Triple-A St. Paul...Ohl, 25, pitched in seven games (3 starts) for Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-1 with a 2.82 ERA (22.1 IP, 7 ER), five walks and 23 strikeouts since being promoted there in June. On the season, he has appeared in 22 games (5 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers, Double-A Wichita and St. Paul this season, combining to go 5-2 with a 2.17 ERA (66.1 IP, 16 ER), two saves, 10 walks, 79 strikeouts and a .209 opponent batting average. The Moorpark, California native was originally selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Grand Canyon University.

BOSTON COMMON: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fifth of six games in 2025...Twins are 3-1 against the Sox this season...one more win and the Twins will win the season-series for the first time since going 4-3 in 2022 (3-3 in 2024, 3-4 in 2023).
♣ Twins have gone 8-4 in their last 12 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.
♣ Trevor Larnach is hitting .293 (12-for-41) with one home run, nine RBI and a .721 OPS in his last 11 games against the Red Sox...
♣ Carlos Correa has posted an .834 OPS in 62 career regular season games vs. the Red Sox...
additionally, in those 62, he has a .377 on-base percentage, a .457 slugging percentage,
11 home runs and 32 RBI.
♣ Ty France has 15 career doubles in 31 games against the Red Sox, his second-most against any opponent (LAA - 16).
♣ Christian Vázquez is hitting .304 (7-for-23) with four walks and a .393 on-base percentage in his last seven games vs. the Red Sox.

ROYCE ROLLS: Over his last eight games, Royce Lewis is hitting .469 (13-for-30) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, an .867 slugging percentage and a 1.336 OPS...below are his season comparisons in a few categories: K% OBP OPS HARD HIT% AVGEV AVG SLG

TWINS GO FOR A PAIR AGAINST SOX: With a win today and/or tomorrow, the Twins will win their 15th series of the season...Minnesota is 14-18-2 in series play, going 9-6-2 at home and 5-12-0 on the road...their last series win came July 11-13 vs. Pittsburgh.

◆ After taking the series at Fenway Park 2-1 in early May, the Twins are looking to win two series in one season over Boston for the first time since 2006, when they went 3-0 at home and 2-1 at Fenway.

♠ Twins pitching coach Pete Maki is celebrating his 43rd birthday today.

♠ Twins batters have grounded into 15 double plays since the All-Star break, the most in baseball...they've grounded into multiple DPs in four of 10 games since the break.

♠ Twins have struck out 78 times since the break, fifth fewest in the AL.

♠ Twins infielder Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) remains on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul...the Saints will play in Toledo tonight at 6:05 pm (CT)...Keaschall has played in eight games on rehab assignment over the last week-plus, going 7-for-32 with five walks.

REST IN PEACE, RYNO: National Baseball Hall of Famer Ryne Sandberg passed away yesterday at 65-years-old...Sandberg played three career games against the Twins in the first year of Interleague Play in 1997 at Wrigley Field...he went 7-for-14 with two doubles and four RBI, recording multiple hits in all three games that series.

LAST TIME OUT: Last started for the Saints on July 24 in Game 2 of a doubleheader vs. Worcester Red Sox...did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 5-2 loss...allowed one unearned run on one hit, with no walks and five strikeouts over 4.0 innings of work...retired first six batters he faced in order before Nathan Hickey reached on a fielding error to start the third inning; Hickey scored with one out on Tyler McDonough's RBI double...retired next five batters in order, including three groundouts

TWO APPEARANCES AGO: Made his fourth relief appearance with St. Paul on July 19 at Louisville... entered the game with two outs in the bottom of the fifth inning...allowed two runs on three hits over 2.1 innings of work, with no walks and two strikeouts...both runs scored with one out in the seventh via an RBI single by Francisco Urbaez and an RBI double by Edwin Ríos; induced a fly out and a swinging strikeout to end the inning...31 pitches thrown were his fewest since May 10 at Northwest Arkansas (AA).

- ₱ Has struck out five-or-more batters in eight of his 22 appearances this season, compared to seven of 21 appearances in 2024, 13 of 24 appearances in 2023 and 11 of 22 appearances in 2021-22.
 ₱ Among all minor league pitchers with 20-or-more appearances this season, 0hl's 7.90 strikeoutto-walk ratio ranks fourth best
- ₱ Has not pitched more then 4.0 innings in any of his outings...his shortest outing of the season was 1.2 IP (AA) on May 18.
