RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals begin a four-game homestand today with a make-up game against the New York Mets (from May 8) followed up by a three-game series against the Tampa Bay Rays (Aug. 6-8). The Cardinals arrived back at Busch Stadium last night at 12:35 a.m., after playing Sunday Night Baseball at Wrigley Field in Chicago completing a four-game series road trip going 1-3.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central Division, 5.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and 3.0 games back of Arizona for the 3rd Wild Card spot. The Cardinals and Diamondbacks' 42 wins since Mother's Day are the most among National League teams.

BREAKING THE TIE: A win today would give the Cardinals a season-series tie with the New York Mets at 3-3. With the new MLB tie-breaker procedure rules, the second round of tie-breakers would go to intradivisional records. Both teams enter today each having played 36 games against their division with the Mets holding a 20-16 mark against the East and the Cardinals at 17-19 against the Central.

HAPPY HOUR SHOWDOWN: According to research dating back 30 seasons, St. Louis will play its first scheduled regular season home game in the 4 o'clock hour (not part of a doubleheader) today when they host the Mets at 4:15 p.m. Central Time, making up the May 8th rainout between the two clubs. - Elias

• The last time St. Louis played any regular season home game with a first pitch occurring in the 4 o'clock hour was May 5, 2021 (also vs. the Mets), in the opener (7 innings) of a doubleheader that was rescheduled due to rain from the day prior. First pitch was also 4:15 p.m.

• The previous Cardinals regular season home game in the 4 o'clock hour (not part of a doubleheader) was May 11, 2019 vs. the Pirates, a 1:15 p.m. scheduled first pitch that was delayed 2 hours and 56 minutes due to rain that started at 4:11 p.m.

• The last time St. Louis hosted a Postseason game beginning in the 4 o'clock hour was 4:39 p.m. vs. the Cubs (Oct. 10, 2015).

CLOSE SHAVES: The Cardinals (21-15) and Mets (21-12) lead all Major League teams with 21 wins in one-run games. The first five games of the Cardinals-Mets series this season have all been decided by three runs or less with four requiring a save to close down the game and one with a walk-off home run.

NIFTY FIFTY: Today begins the stretch of the final 50 games of the season. The Cardinals were 22-28 (.440) to finish the 2023 season, which surprisingly matched the 2006 team as the worst 50-game finish by a Cardinals team to make the postseason, let alone win the World Series.

• The best Cardinals 50-game finish occurred in 1942 when they finished 42-8 (.840) en route to the World Series championship.

• The most recent 50-game success rate for the Cardinals came from the 2002 squad, which finished 37-13 (.740) winning the N.L. Central Division before falling to the San Francisco Giants in the National League Championship Series.

• The 1906 Cubs hold the MLB record, finishing 43-6-1 (.878) for a final 116-36 record. (see chart left)

O'BRIEN PITCHES BACK-TO-BACK IN REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Relief pitcher Riley O'Brien (right forearm flexor strain) made his first back-to-back pitching appearances during his minor league rehabilitation assignment at Memphis (AAA) last night. O'Brien began his assignment on July 20 and is 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA in seven appearances (five scoreless) striking out four batters over 6.0 innings and allowing five hits. His longest outing was his first against Iowa (Cubs) on July 20 tossing 21 pitches, but has pitched 18 or less since. Last night, O'Brien pitched a perfect inning with two strikeouts after pitching on Saturday.

NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

Steven Matz was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

Brendan Donovan (April 25, 2022 at Busch III), and **Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

Tommy Pham played in 79 games for the Mets during in 2023 before traded to Arizona.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jos6 Oquendo** played the first two seasons MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Adam Ottavino was selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#30 overall) of the 2006 MLB Draft...pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2006-11)...made his MLB debut with St. Louis in 2010.

Jos6 Quintana made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals in 2022...acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris Statton** from Pittsburgh in exchange for **Johan Oviedo** and **Malcom Nuñez**.

Matt Carpenter's younger brother, Tyler, played two seasons in the Mets organization (2011-12).

Harrison Bader was selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in St. Louis (2017-22) where he won the 2021 NL Gold Glove in center field.

Mets Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

Mets VP of Amateur Scouting **Kris Gross** was a Cardinals amateur scout for three seasons (2010-12).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y....graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Cardinals reporter **Jim Hayes** was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...graduated from SUNY-Geneseo.

Tyler Megill's older brother, **Trevor Megill**, was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Cardinals reporter **Mark Sweeney** was traded to the Mets with **Jeremy Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)...attended Spring Training with New York before released (March 13, 2002).

Cardinals AGM/Player Dev. **Gary LaRocque** previously served as Scouting Dir., AGM & VP/ Player Dev. and Scouting with the Mets from (1998-2005)...appointed VP of Pro Scouting in 2006.

TODAY'S GAME

- Making his 11th start of the season tonight and his 21st career. It's his eighth career appearance vs. the Mets and his first career start.
- Made six scoreless relief appearances to begin his career vs. NYM before allowing a run in his last appearance on Aug. 20, 2023, but was credited with a Hold in the Cardinals 7-3 win started by Dakota Hudson, improving to 5-0 in that game.
- In day games starts, is 2-2 with a 1.95 ERA, holding his opposition to one earned run or less in 4-of-5 starts. His ERA is the 4th-lowest in MLB of pitchers with five or more day game starts (**Hunter Greene**, CIN, 1.50, **Paul Skenes**, PIT, 1.90 & **Reynaldo Lopez**, ATL, 1.93).
- Despite being winless in his four July starts, owns the Cardinals top starter's ERA (3.33) for the month and his .220 opponent's BA in July ranked 9th among N.L. starters.
- Since returning to the Cardinals starting rotation on May 29, ranks T-8th among all National League pitchers with 8 GDP and has a 1.58 GDP/9 IP. Would rank 13th in the N.L. with his 3.61 ERA in that span, but is 10.0 innings shy of qualifying.
- Was involved in the decision in his first six starts this season alternating wins and losses over the first five games before winning back-to-back decisions (W-L-W-L-W-W).
- His career reverse splits have continued this season, as he's held LHB to .217 BA & .570 OPS, while RHB are batting .296 with .818 OPS, hitting 4 of the 5 HR's he's allowed in 2024.
- Has held the opposition to two runs or less in 6-of-10 starts this season.
- Had his 17.0 IP scoreless innings streak as a starter snapped in an 8-5 defeat at HOU (6/4), pitched 3.0 innings allowing six runs.
- The scoreless inning streak had dated back to the 1st inning (3 runs allowed) of his 7/26/22 start at Toronto. Blanked Washington for 8.0 IP in 7/31/22 start at Nationals Park, followed by 6.0 scoreless IP in start at CIN (5/29/24).
- Is 7-6, 3.72 ERA in 19 career starts (101.2 IP/42 ER) and 4-1, 2.96 ERA (45.2 IP/15 ER) in eight career home starts at Busch Stadium, winning 4 of his last 5 starts at Busch dating back to July 15, 2022 vs. Cincinnati.
- Was recalled on May 26 from Memphis (AAA), and made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington at Great American Ball Park vs. CIN (5/29).
- Appeared in four games (three starts) in Memphis (AAA) after being optioned from St. Louis on April 21, going 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP), 13 walks, nine strikeouts, and a 1.65 WHIP.
- Was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine MLB relief appearances before his option on April 21.
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 101 vs. KC on 7/10/24 (Game 1).

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed three runs on seven hits, six singles, as he took the loss in a 6-3 Texas Rangers win last Monday. Texas tallied two runs in their go-ahead rally on four singles and a ground out in the 4th inning.

- Allowed a run in his last outing vs. the Mets at Busch Stadium on Aug. 20, 2023, recording a Hold for Dakota Hudson's 7-3 win.
- Threw six consecutive scoreless relief outings vs. the Mets to begin his career from 4/26/22-8/17/23.
- Has not allowed a home run in 42 total batters faced.

- Made his second career appearance in a neutral site game when he started vs. SF (6/20) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala. Joined Alan Benes (4/19/1997 vs. SD) as the only two Cardinals starting pitchers to earn a win at a neutral site game.
- Logged a season-high 7.0 IP at PIT (7/4). His longest outing since a career-high 8.0 IP at WSH (7/31/22). Had a career-high 101 pitches in his final start before the All-Star break in Game 1 of 7/10/24 split DH vs. KC.
- Made his first MLB start since 2022 at CIN (5/29), threw 6.0 scoreless innings at Great American Ball Park for a 5-3 win. Threw a season-high 86 pitches (both Memphis & St. Louis) and did not allow a hit until the 4th inning.
- Suffered his first loss and allowed runs as a starting pitcher for the first time since 2022 at HOU (6/4) in an 8-5 loss, allowing six runs on six hits over 3.0 IP
- Made nine relief appearances in St. Louis after making the Opening Day roster before getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21.
