RAY REPORT—The Rays wrap up the first portion of a six-game, six-day Midwest road trip through Chicago (0-2, 1 to play) and Milwaukee (3 to play) today at Guaranteed Rate Field...after last night's loss 8-7, the Rays are 0-3-1 in their last four series after winning three straight from April 5-14, marking their longest stretch of winless series since June 12-25, 2023 (0-1-3)...they have lost five of their last six games and are 5-9 (.357) since April 13 on the heels of a 5-1 run, tied for the 11th-best record in the AL over that span...the Rays have remained within two games of .500 each day since the beginning of the season, but they are two games below .500 for the first time since April 5 (3-5).

- ★ The Rays fell to 2-1 in extra-inning games after yesterday's 10-inning, 8-7, loss... they blew leads of 3-0, 4-3 and 7-6 in a game that featured three ties and four lead changes, capped by **Andrew Benintendi's** walk-off two-run homer.
- ★ Of the seven walk-off home runs in the majors this season, two have been hit against the Rays...they have lost via walk-off homer twice before the calendar flips to May for the second time in franchise history, joining the 2000 Devil Rays (3).
- ★ The Rays are 1-4 against the AL Central this season...since winning 12 of their first 13 games against the division to open 2023, they are .500 (12-12) in their last 24 games opposite AL Central foes, going 4-8 in their last 12.
- ★ **Kevin Cash** (752) remains three victories shy of surpassing **Joe Maddon** (754) as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader.

WHAT'S AT STAKE

- ★ Suffer their first sweep since July 17-19 at TEX.
- ★ Be swept by an AL Central opponent for the first time since Aug. 3-5, 2018 vs. the White Sox at Tropicana Field...since then, they have entered the final game of a series vs. an AL Central club with a chance to be swept six times, winning all six of those finales.
- ★ Be swept by the White Sox for the fifth time in franchise history, including the third instance in Chicago, joining a one-game "series" in a makeup game on Aug. 27, 2007 and three-game set from July 4-6, 2005.
- ★ Fall three games below the .500 mark for the first time since April 15, 2021 (5-8), over 1,100 days ago.
- ★ Drop to 5-4 in series finales, including 2-2 on the road.

1-2 PUNCH—Last night, **Richie Palacios** tied a Rays single-game record by reaching base via hit, walk or hit by pitch six times, coming aboard on two singles, a homer and three walks, two of which were intentional...he shares the record with three others: **Daniel Robertson** (July 3, 2018 at MIA), **Ben Zobrist** (July 20, 2012 vs. SEA) and **José Cruz** (June 24, 2004 at TOR)...Palacios was the first Ray to turn the trick in defeat...he was also the first player in the majors to reach base 6+ times since **BOS Willyer Abreu** (6) on Sept. 9, 2023 vs. BAL...he and **Ben Rortvedt** (3 1B, 2BB) became the first pair of Rays teammates to reach base 5+ times in the same game since **Isaac Paredes/David Peralta** on Aug. 28, 2022 at BOS...it has happened only five times in Rays history, including a June 24, 2004 contest in which four Tampa Bay hitters accomplished the feat.

- ★ Rortvedt's five times on base tied the club record by a catcher, accomplished by five others (8 instances)...the last Rays backstop to achieve the mark was **Travis d'Arnaud** on July 15, 2019 at Yankee Stadium...Rortvedt is the only member of that group who also stole a base...he has already set career highs in hits (17), RBI (7) and doubles (3) and is 9-for-20 (.450) with 1 2B, 3 RBI and 2 BB over his last six games.
- ★ Palacios' performance came after going 1-for-11 (.091) with six strikeouts in his previous four games.

NOT THE RAYS WAY—Despite pitching to a 2.64 ERA (44.1IP, 13ER) over their last seven games, the Rays bullpen has blown eight saves this season, tied with the Marlins and Pirates for the most in the majors...the group has been charged with six losses, fourth most in the AL...according to FanGraphs, the Rays bullpen owns an AL-worst 8.14 ERA (21.0IP, 22ER) in high-leverage situations, including a 14.54 ERA (6.2IP, 14ER) in high-leverage spots from the 8th inning on...the bullpen has tossed 112.0 IP, second most in the AL behind the Red Sox (112.1IP).

- ★ The rotation's 4.03 ERA ranks eighth in the AL...however, Rays starters have turned in a 7.07 ERA (28.0IP, 22ER) during their current 1-5 skid.
- ★ The White Sox used a trio of multi-run frames to take down the Rays last night... Rays pitching has allowed a total of 38 multi-run innings, fourth most in the majors behind the Rockies (43), White Sox (41) and Marlins (39).
- ★ The Rays have yielded 39 HR, second most in the majors behind the White Sox (40).

ABOUT THE OFFENSE—Rays hitters rank sixth in the AL in batting average (.246) and second in singles (169) behind the Astros (172)...they pace the AL in infield singles (37), stolen bases (31) and stolen base attempts (11st, 38)...however, only 27.5 pct. of their hits have gone for extra bases, the second-lowest rate in the majors, ahead of only the Marlins (25.1%)...the Rays .665 OPS is sixth lowest through the first 28 games of a season in franchise history, signaling their worst mark since 2021 (.672).

- ★ The Rays tied a season-high with 5 XBH last night (also April 14 vs. SF)...they join the Athletics as the only AL clubs yet to record 6+ XBH in a game.
- ★ Rays hitters also drew a season-high-tying seven walks for the second straight game, recording back-to-back 7+ walk efforts for the first time since Aug. 8-10, 2021...with 7+ free passes today, the Rays would tie the longest such streak in franchise history (3x, last: June 25-27, 2010).
- ★ Over their last three games, the Rays are batting .263 (10-for-28) with RISP...in their previous nine games, they hit .141 (10-for-71)...the Rays are 0-for-5 with the bases loaded in the current series and have gone 1-for-their-last-12 (.083) with the bags full dating back to April 12 vs. SF.
- ★ Rays hitters have stranded 23 baserunners over the last two games, their most in any two-game span since Aug. 5-6, 2022 (24)...the club record for men left on base in a three-game series is 38, done from May 22-24, 2009 at Florida.

SUNSHINE IN THE WINDY CITY—The Rays and White Sox continue a six-game season series today on the South Side, concluding the first of two series in 2024...all six games will take place over the course of 13 days from April 26-May 8, with the White Sox visiting Tropicana Field for a three-game set from May 6-8 in the middle of the Rays nine-game homestand...Chicago has already claimed its first series victory over Tampa Bay since June 3-5, 2022, snapping the Rays two-series winning streak...the Rays went 6-1 against the Sox in 2023, winning each of the first six matchups before a 12-9 defeat on April 30.

- ★ The Rays have lost three straight to the White Sox for the first time since June 15-Aug. 20, 2021...their last four-game skid came from April 11-Aug. 5, 2018.
- ★ **Yandy Diaz** is batting .455 (20-for-44) with 5 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI and 16 BB against 5 SO during his 15-game on-base streak against Chicago, which began on Aug. 21, 2021.
- ★ **Randy Arozarena** has reached base safely in 14 straight contests against the White Sox since April 16, 2022, batting .333 (19-for-57) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 RBI and 7 BB during the streak.

CONNECTIONS

- ★ **OF Tommy Pham**, who was selected by the White Sox from Triple-A Charlotte on Friday, appeared with 184 games with the Rays after being acquired from the Cardinals at the 2018 trade deadline.
- ★ **White Sox Bench Coach Charlie Montoyo** spent 22 seasons in the Rays organization, including four on **Kevin Cash's** staff as third base coach (2015-17) and bench coach (2018), before departing to manage the Blue Jays in 2019.
- ★ **Chicago 1B/OF Coach Jason Bourgeois** played for the White Sox (6G, 2008) and Rays (9G, 2013) during his eight-year ML career.
- ★ **White Sox ML Coach Grady Sizemore** appeared in 58 games with the Rays in 2015 to conclude his major league career.
- ★ **White Sox Assistant Hitting Coach Mike Tosas** began his professional coaching career as a hitting coach with Tampa Bay...worked with the Gulf Coast League Devil Rays in 1996 and Rookie-level Princeton from 1997-99.
- ★ **Rays Senior Advisor, Player Development & Baseball Operations Mitch Lukevics** was a second-round selection by the White Sox in 1975 and worked in the Chicago farm system as a pitching coach (1981-85) and minor league administrator (1986-88).
- ★ **Rays RHP Chris Devenski** was drafted by the White Sox in 2011 before they dealt him to the Astros in 2012 as a player to be named later in a trade that sent **RHP Brett Myers** to Chicago.

RAYS DAYS

The Rays have won five of their last seven day games since April 7 at COL...the club's rotation has led the way in those contests, pitching to a 3.18 ERA (34.0IP, 12ER)...they are 3-2 in daytime affairs on the road.

BACKSTOP POP

Rays catchers have combined for an .850 OPS, second highest in the AL behind the Red Sox (.877) and fifth in the majors behind the Brewers (.937), Braves (.883) and Dodgers (.864)...last season, Rays backstops produced the AL's 11th-ranked OPS (.656).

TODAY'S START—The right-hander makes his sixth start of the season, including his third on the road...is seeking his first victory since his season debut on March 30 vs. TOR, taking three no-decisions and one loss since that outing...is looking for his first victory on the road since Aug. 4, 2023 at Detroit (6.OIP, 3H, 0R, 1BB, 1SO).

LAST TIME OUT—Suffered his first defeat of the season on April 22 vs. Detroit...allowed season highs in hits (9), runs (6), earned runs (5) and home runs (2)...his 6.0 innings and 7 SO also matched season highs.

- He allowed multiple home runs for the first time since allowing 2 HR on Sept. 12, 2023 at Minnesota.
- After allowing a season-high three walks on April 10 at Los Angeles-AL, has not issued a free pass over his last two starts while striking out 14 batters during that time.

SOUTH SIDE SHOWDOWN—Littell has made five career appearances (2GS) opposite Chicago, going 0-1 with a 9.75 ERA (12.OIP, 13ER).

- Made his major league debut vs. the White Sox on June 5, 2018 and took the loss after allowing six runs on six hits and four walks with one strikeout across 3.0 innings.
- In 34 appearances (6GS) against AL Central opponents, Littell is 6-3 with a 4.09 ERA (70.1IP, 32ER), including 1-3 with a 5.87 ERA (30.2IP, 20ER) in his six starts.
- In his last three outings against the division, he is 0-2 with a 6.11 ERA (17.2IP, 12ER)...from July 30, 2020-Aug. 4, 2023, he posted a 1-0 mark and 1.89 ERA (19.OIP, 4ER) over 11 games (1GS) against the AL Central.

UPS AND DOWNS—Over his last two starts, Littell has allowed nine runs (8 earned) on 17 hits and three home runs...during this stretch, however, he has not issued a walk and fanned seven batters in each of the outings...he has received one run of support across the 11.2 innings.

- His 4.3 pct. walk rate on the year ranks in the top 89th percentile of all MLB pitchers.
- Has produced a 29.3 pct. ground ball rate, ranking in the bottom 7th percentile in the majors.
- Has a 32.9 pct. hard hit rate, which is down 9.0 pct. from 2023 (41.9%).

EARLY BIRD SPECIAL—Littell is 1-0 with a 1.17 ERA (15.1IP, 2ER) in three daytime starts—min. 3 GS, it is tied with SF **Jordan Hicks** for the fourth-lowest day ERA in the majors behind CIN **Frankie Montas** (0.73), LAD **Tyler Glasnow** (0.90) and KC **Cole Ragans** (1.16)...he has produced a 6.17 ERA (11.2IP, 8ER) in his two nighttime starts of 2024.

- In his last five day starts dating to Sept. 17, 2023 at BAL, he is 1-0 with a 1.05 ERA (25.2IP, 3ER)...this, compared to 0-3 with a 5.23 ERA (32.2IP, 19ER) in his last six night games (5GS) since Sept. 2, 2023 at CLE.

SLIDE PIECE—Littell's most effective pitch through five starts has been his slider...opponents are batting 7-for-37 (.189) with 1 XBH and 8 SO against the pitch, including 2-for-14 (.143) with 6 SO against left-handed hitters...opponents are 25-for-74 (.338) against Littell's other four pitches.

PINPOINT PRECISION—Littell's 69.2 pct. strike rate since the beginning of last season ranks third in the majors (min. 1,250 pitches thrown) behind SEA **George Kirby** (71.0%), DET **Tarik Skubal** (69.5%) and SF **Tyler Rogers** (69.4%).

- Littell issued multiple walks in two of his first three starts to open the season...he did not have a multi-walk start in all of 2023, going walkless in nine of his 14 starts.
- Since walking three consecutive batters in the 1st inning on April 10, Littell has not issued a free pass to his last 70 BF.

ODDS AND ENDS—Opposing leadoff hitters are 2-for-15 (.133) against him, but the 2-4 spots are batting 12-for-39 (.308) with 5 of the 9 total XBH he has allowed...opponents are 14-for-41 (.341) the first time through the order and 9-for-44 (.205) the second time...when his pitch count sits between 1-15, opponents are 7-for-17 (.412) with 3 2B and 2 HR...from pitches 16-45, opponents are 6-for-30 (.200) with zero extra-base hits...from pitch 46 and on, opponents are 19-for-64 (.297) with 3 2B and 1 HR...all three of the home runs he has allowed have been solo shots.
