**TONIGHT'S 12NEWS SIMULCAST:** Tonight features 12News' penultimate D-backs' simulcast in 2025...the final simulcast will be on September 19...their first simulcast on April 25 was the club's first ever on a local network affiliate...12News reaches approximately 1.59 million television households across the market.

**2026 SCHEDULE:** The D-backs 2026 schedule features the Opening Homestand vs. Tigers (March 30-April 1) and Braves (April 2-5), holiday weekends for Mother's Day vs. Mets (May 9-10), Father's Day vs. Twins (June 19-21), Fourth of July vs. Brewers (July 3-5), Interleague Play vs. Blue Jays (April 17-19) and Yankees (September 19-20), and marquee NL West matchups...for more information, visit dbacks.com/2026.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs claimed RHP **Elvin Rodríguez** from the Orioles and optioned him to Triple-A Reno and transferred INF **Pavin Smith** (strained left quad) to the 60-day injured list.

**SNAKE BITES:** The D-backs face off with the Red Sox @ Chase Field for only the fourth time in team history (4-5 record; 1-2 in 2023, 2-1 in 2019 and 1-2 in 2007).

- The D-backs have won 4 straight home series (vs. Rangers, Reds, Guardians, Rockies), won or split 5 straight series, and won 7 of their last 10 series.
- The D-backs have won 6 of their last 8 games, since Aug. 27, and 10 of their last 15 games, since Aug. 19, all against teams in a postseason position (Brewers and Dodgers) or within 5.0 games of a Wild Card berth (Guardians, Reds and Rangers).
- Since August 1, the D-backs are 19-13 (.594), the fourth-best record in the NL and fourth in the Majors, behind the Brewers (22-11, .667), Phillies (20-12, .625) and Red Sox (19-12, .613).
- 8 of the D-backs' last 10 games and 19 of their last 27 have been decided by 2 or fewer runs (16-11 record / 9-4 home / 7-7 road / +29 run differential).
- Since August 20, D-backs starting pitchers have only allowed an MLB-low 4 homers (14 G 71.1 IP).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 2-0 vs. Rangers for their ninth shutout...it was their third win this season with 3 or fewer hits in a game (also: 3 hits on June 1 vs. Nationals and 3 hits on April 2 @ Yankees) and sixth win with at most 1 extra-base hit (Corbin Carroll double) in a game (last: Aug. 28 @ Brewers, Blaze Alexander double).

- **Zac Gallen** had his second straight scoreless outing, extending his scoreless-inning streak to 12.2 IP, and fourth straight quality start after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with 4 hits, 1 walk and 5 strikeouts...his 63 wins rank third in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson (118) and Brandon Webb (87).
- **Corbin Carroll** reached base safely in 21st consecutive game since Aug. 13, the second-longest active streak in the Majors, behind only Jackson Chourio/MIL (25)...it is the tied for his second-longest streak of his career (also: 21-gamer from July 7-Aug. 4, 2024), behind a 27-gamer from Sept. 23, 2024-April 19, 2025.
- Gabriel Moreno recorded the game's first RBI in the first inning on his single...since his return on Aug. 22, has recorded 11 RBI in his 11 games.
- Jake Woodford recorded his third save in his last 6 appearances and became the sixth different D-back pitcher to reach 3+ saves this season.

**FACING THE 'SOX:** The D-backs have won 4 consecutive games vs. Red Sox dating back to the 2023 season and have won 6 of their last 9 games vs. Red Sox since 2019...won 4-2 in their last home game vs. Red Sox, led by early homers by Corbin Carroll (Bot 1) and Geraldo Perdomo (Bot 2).

- Last season, the D-backs earned their second-ever sweep @ Fenway Park (3-0)...it was their first sweep since their inaugural matchup with the Red Sox from June 7-9, 2002 (3-0).
- Eduardo Rodriguez pitched for Boston from 2015-21...was a 2018 World Series champion with the Red Sox and named the Red Sox's 2015 & 2019 Most Valuable Pitcher by the Boston chapter of the BBWAA.
- Torey Lovullo served as Boston's bench coach from their 2013 World Series Championship season thru 2016.
- **Tim Bogar** was Boston's first base coach (2009), third base coach (2010-11) and bench coach (2012).
- As an 8-year-old, after his dad, Kevin, was traded from the D-backs to the Red Sox, reliever **Bryce Jarvis** would shag balls in the outfield during batting practice at Fenway Park off the bats of Manny Ramirez and Hall-of-Famer David Ortiz: "I remember it being a really beautiful day and thinking 'this is what I want to do forever. Just be on a big-league field and spending it with my dad just made it that much more special. Those memories are going to help me through my own journey to the big leagues."

### WALDSCHMIDT NAMED TEXAS LEAGUE AUGUST PLAYER OF THE MONTH:

Yesterday, D-backs No. 1 prospect and Double-A Amarillo OF **Ryan Waldschmidt** was named by MiLB as August's Texas League Player of the Month...in 26 games with the Sod Poodles, hit .371 (36-for-97)/1.143 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers, 17 RBI, 24 walks (14 K) and 12 stolen bases...among all Minor League players in August, ranked in runs (1st, 28), OBP (4th, .504) and walks (T-5th, 24).

**EXTRA! EXTRA!:** With 1 more home run, **Corbin Carroll** would become the third player in franchise history to record a 30+ homer season in his age 24 season or younger (age as of June 30), joining Chris Young in 2007 (32) and Justin Upton in 2011 (31).

 He is 4 triples shy of becoming the fifth player in MLB history to record a 20+ double, 20+ triple, 20+ homer and 20+ stolen base season (20-20-20-20) to join Frank Schulte/CHC in 1911, Willie Mays/NYG in 1957, Jimmy Rollins in 2007 and Curtis Granderson in 2007...Mays and Rollins were the only players to accomplish the feat with 30+ homers.

### NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (12-8, 5.33)

- Surpassed 400 career strikeouts in his last start on Aug. 31 vs. Dodgers (ND; 4 ER in 4.1 IP, 5 K).
- Career-high 12 wins are tied for fourth in the NL.
- Facing the Red Sox for a second time in his 79th career start after going against them for the first time on May 26, 2023 in his fifth career start, where allowed 5 runs on 8 hits and 0 walks with 4 strikeouts in 3.2 innings.

### **SNAKEBITES**

**AT A GLANCE:** Second season with the D-backs (10th overall in MLB; did not pitch in 2020).

- Signed a 4-year contract in December 2023 (2024-2027) with a conditional option for the fifth year.
- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- Finished tied for sixth in the 2019 AL Cy Young Award vote after going 19-6 with a 3.81 ERA (86 ER in 203.1 IP) and 213 strikeouts.
- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- From 2018-23, his 63 wins tied for third most in the AL (also: Justin Verlander), behind Gerrit Cole (86) and Jose Berríos (66).
- Among lefty starting pitchers vs. AL opponents since 2022 (min. 35 GS), he ranks in wins (7th, 20) and ERA (8th, 3.67).

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Since 2015, his 89 wins are fourth among active lefty starters, behind Clayton Kershaw (123), Chris Sale (99) and Carlos Rodón (91) while his 1,262 strikeouts rank eighth.

- Pitched 6 seasons with the Red Sox from 2015-21.
- The D-backs have won and scored 6+ runs in 5 of his last 6 starts.
- Has 3 straight no decisions in his last 3 home starts.
- In 6 August starts, went 3-1 in his 6 starts (2 quality) as he went 3-1 with a 4.73 ERA (17 ER in 32.1 IP).
- In his last 4 starts (2 quality), is 2-1 (team is 3-1) with a 4.09 ERA (10 ER in 22.0 IP), opponent .250 AVG, 9 walks and 15 strikeouts.
- Celebrated 10 years of MLB service time on July 6.

**LAST START:** On Aug. 30 vs. Dodgers, tossed 6.0 shutout innings, allowing 4 hits and 4 walks with 4 strikeouts...was his first career scoreless start vs. Dodgers after 6 previous outings (previous low: 1 ER in 7.0 IP on July 12, 2019 with the Red Sox).

 Was his third scoreless outing of the season (also: 6.0 IP on June 23 @ White Sox and 6.1 IP on July 22 vs. Astros.

**VS. RED SOX:** Third career start (first as a D-back)...first start since Aug. 13, 2023 @ Red Sox while with the Tigers.

• In search of his first career win vs. Red Sox.

**FORMER RED SOX SOUTHPAW:** Pitched 6 seasons with the Red Sox from 2015-21...2018 World Series champion with the team and named the Red Sox's 2015 & 2019 Most Valuable Pitcher by the Boston chapter of the BBWAA.

- In 2019, the Red Sox were 26-8 (.765) in his starts...only Gerrit Cole/ HOU also had 25+ team wins in his starts (Astros went 26-7 in his starts).
- Tossed a career-high 7.2 hitless innings on Sept. 4, 2016 @ Athletics that was broken up by Marcus Semien's eighth-inning 2-out single.
- In his rookie season in 2015, became the first pitcher in MLB history to toss 6.0+ innings and allow no more than 1 run and 3 hits or fewer in each of his first 3 games.
- Was the first pitcher to begin a career career with 3 straight starts of 6.0+ innings, 1 earned run or fewer allowed and 7+ strikeouts since the earned run became an official stat in 1912. [Elias Sports Bureau].
- On May 28, 2015 @ Rangers, became the first pitcher in Red Sox history to pitch 7.2+ innings and allow 0 runs, yield 3 hits or fewer with 7+ strikeouts in a debut.

**VS. AL EAST**: In his last 3 home starts vs. AL East opponents, is 2-0 with a 2.37 ERA (5 ER in 19.0 IP), opponent .217 AVG (15-for-69), 7 walks and 13 strikeouts.

- Did not factor in the decision in his last home start on April 23 vs. Rays (4 ER in 6.2 IP, 6 H, 1 BB, 5 K).
- In his last 8 starts (since April 29, 2023), is 2-3 with a 2.88 ERA (13 ER in 40.2 IP), opponent .223 AVG (33-for-148), 15 walks and 32 strikeouts.

• In his 9 starts of 6.0+ innings (6 quality) in 2025, is 4-2 with a 2.83 ERA (18 ER in 57.1 IP), 19 walks and 45 strikeouts.

**10+ STRIKEOUTS:** Has 3 10+-strikeout games, tied for third most among NL lefty starters with MacKenzie Gore/WSH, behind Jesús Luzardo/PHI (5), Cristopher Sánchez/PHI (4) and and Chris Sale/ATL (4).
