LACKING SIX APPEAL: The Detroit Tigers this afternoon take their six-game losing streak into the finale of their four-game series with the Toronto Blue Jays at Comerica Park ... the Tigers have now bookended a single win one week ago today in Texas with a pair of season-high six-game losing streaks in their past 13 games starting July 9 ... the Tigers today aim to avoid a losing streak of more than six games for the first time since a nine-game skid from June 2-11, 2023

- The Tigers have now lost 12 of their last 13 games dating to July 9, their first 1-12 stretch since July 15-28, 2019 ... that 13-game stretch in 2019 was also bookended by a pair of six-game losing streaks with the lone win right in the middle of said 13-game drought.
- Overall, the Tigers have endured a 1-12 stretch like this within only three of their past 27 seasons ... the Tigers are now 14 games above .500 for the first time since improving their record to 34-20 on May 25, the day of Tarik Skubal's "Maddux" vs. Cleveland.
- After dropping the first three games of this set, the Tigers have now lost four series in a row for the first time this season and for the first time since June 7-19, 2024 (also four series).
- The Tigers have lost seven games in a row at home for the first time since an eight-game home skid from June 9-28, 2019.
- Detroit is nine games through its stretch of 13-games-in-13-days out of the All-Star Break through July 30, while this series also kicked off a stretch of 13-of-16 games at home ... this seven-day homestand concludes with a three-game series vs. Arizona starting tomorrow.

LET THERE BE LIGHT: This afternoon's game represents the lone day game for the Tigers and Blue Jays during their four-game weekend set ... the Tigers are 27-17 (.614) in day games this season, the most wins during the day by any A.L. club and one behind Milwaukee (28) for the most wins by any team in the majors during the day ... Detroit has the third-best winning percentage of any big league club during the day behind Houston (23-11, .676) and Seattle (24-15, .615).

- Tigers pitchers have a 2.92 ERA (127 ER/391.0 IP) in day games this season, second-best in all  $\frac{1}{10}$ of baseball behind only Texas and its 2.48 ERA.
- Spencer Torkelson ranks third in the A.L. with a .997 OPS during the day behind only Aaron Judge (1.247) and Cal Raleigh (1.027).
- Zach McKinstry is tied for third in all of baseball with a .333 (42-for-126) batting average during the day behind only Jacob Wilson (.382) and Aaron Judge (.358).

THAT'S EITHER HERE OR THERE: The Tigers enter today's game having played exactly 53 games at home and 53 games on the road, going 32-21 at home while posting a 28-25 record on the road ... offensively, the Tigers have a .747 OPS at home, 34 points higher than their .713 OPS on the road ... however, Detroit has scored a near-identical number of runs at home and on the road this year with 247 runs at Comerica Park and 251 away from here.

The Tigers have pitched to a 3.72 ERA while allowing a .689 OPS at home and own a 4.01 ERA and .701 OPS against on the road.

THIS IS SOME HIGH-END TORK: Spencer Torkelson has tallied 23 homers and 46 extra-base hits in 100 games this season, tied with Nick Kurtz for the most homers by any player in baseball that primarily plays first base this year, while Torkelson has the most extra-base hits among first basemen in the American League, trailing only Pete Alonso (49) for most in the majors.

TOUGH BREAK: The Tigers have lost eight of their first nine games out of the All-Star Break for the first time since 2019 (also eight of their first nine games post-Break).

- Despite their recent times of woe, the Tigers still have a 7.0-game lead in the A.L. Central, the largest lead within any of the six divisions in baseball, and trail only Toronto (by 3.5 games) and Houston (by half-a-game) for the best record in the A.L.
- The Tigers have their best start through 106 games since 2013, when they began 61-45 ... 2025 marks the seventh time in the last 41 years the Tigers have won 60 of their first 106 games.

THREE'S COMPANY: Riley Greene joins New York's Aaron Judge and Chicago's Seiya Suzuki as the only three players in the majors to reach 21 doubles. 25 homers and 80 RBI this season ... Greene has those totals through 106 team games, which puts him on pace for 32 doubles, 38 homers and 122 RBI in a 162-game season, shattering previous career bests.

A PAIR OF TWOS: Riley Greene (25 homers, 80 RBI) and Spencer Torkelson (23 homers, 61 RBI) are the only teammates in the A.L. to reach 23 homers and 61 RBI this season and are one of only two teammates to do so in baseball this year, joining Chicago's Seiya Suzuki and Pete Crow-Armstrong.

THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T NEGLIGIBLE: The Tigers have the best record in the A.L. Central on the strength of a +56 overall run differential, the third-best mark in the A.L. (Yankees, +94; Rangers, +67) ... in the A.L. Central, the Tigers have a +91 edge on the second-place Guardians (-35), are +78 on the third-place Royals (-22) and are +68 on the fourth-place Twins (-14).

AND FINALLY: The Tigers today aim to avoid their first ever four-game sweep at the hands of the Toronto Blue Jays, home or road, since Toronto's inception in 1977.

- Retired the final seven batters against Washington on July 2 via strikeout...finished the game with nine punchouts over five innings.
- Had four straight quality starts from May 22 June 8, going 3-1 with a 1.46 ERA (4ER/24.2IP) over that span...came one out shy of a quality start on May 16 against Toronto, allowing two earned runs over 5.2 frames.
- Struck out José Ramírez to end the first inning on May 22 for his 1,000th career strikeout, becoming the 567th player in MLB history to record 1,000 strikeouts.
- Lost a career-high five straight games from April 15 May 10 this year.
- Flaherty returned to the Tigers this offseason by signing a two-year contract...was with Detroit to start last season before being sent to the Los Angeles Dodgers for catcher Thayron Liranzo and infielder Trey Sweeney on July 30.
- Won the World Series with the Dodgers in 2024...went 1-2 with a 7.36 ERA in five postseason starts and started the final game of the World Series.

- Played in the Japanese Pacific and Eastern Leagues as well as the KBO League from 2022-24.
- Selected by the Yankees in the 19th round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Central Michigan University.
