TODAY'S GAME: The Giants snapped their three-game losing streak and evened the series with a 6-4 win last night vs. the A's... SF is 3-2 in rubber games this season.

- ▶ A win today would give SF its third road series win of the season and first since April 17-19 at Washington (2-1).

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Adrian Houser will make his ninth start of the season looking to make it two wins in a row.

- ▶ Houser earned his first win of the season in his last start at the Dodgers on May 12, allowing two runs on three hits (one homer) while striking out four in 5.2 innings.
- ▶ This marks Houser's third career start vs. the A's, last facing them in 2023...he is 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA (6er, 9.0ip) in the two outings.
- ▶ Houser is one strikeout away from reaching 600 for his career.

SAC-TOWN: The Giants are 6-2 vs. the A's since the start of last season, including a 3-2 mark here at Sutter Health Park...since the start of the 2022 season, SF is 13-7 vs. the A's, outscoring them 81-60 (+21) over that span.

- ▶ A's starter Jeffrey Springs' most-used pitch is his four-seamer (43.4% usage rate)...SF is slashing .251/.301/.404 vs. four-seamers this season.
- ▶ SF is just 2-9 (.182) in interleague games in 2026, which is the lowest winning percentage in interleague games this season...to date, the Giants have faced the Yankees (0-3), Orioles (1-2), Rays (0-3) and A's (1-1) from the AL.
- ▶ Dating back to the start of last season, SF is 26-33 (.441) against AL opponents.

LOOK AT LUIS: IF Luis Arraez reached base another three times in last night's game (a double and two walks)...he has five extra-base hits, a .350 batting average (14x40) and a .960 OPS over his last 10 games.

- ▶ Arraez's 54 hits through his first 43 games this season are the most by a Giant in their first 43 games of a season since **Thairo Estrada** had 54 in 43 games to start the 2023 season.
- ▶ His 54 hits in his first 43 games with the Giants are the most in a player's first 43 games with SF since former A's/Giants infielder **Marco Scutaro** had 58 hits after being acquired at the 2012 trade deadline.

HOMER HAPPY: IF Casey Schmitt logged his second career multi-homer game as part of a four-hit game last night (other: October 1, 2023 vs. LAD)...the last Giant with both a multi-homer and four-hit day in the same game was **IF Rafael Devers** (August 27, 2025 vs. CHC).

- ▶ SF has homered at least once in 11 of its last 12 games (dating to the first game of the last homestand on May 4 vs. San Diego).
- ▶ In this 12-game span, SF has 22 doubles, two triples, 16 homers and 49 runs scored (4.1 runs per game) with nine different Giants logging a homer.
- ▶ The two homers by Schmitt were the first two homers out of the third spot in the Giants' lineup this season (fewest in MLB)...the last Giants' No. 3 hitter to homer prior to last night was Devers on the final day of last season (September 28 vs. Colorado).

CARELESS RISP-ER: A 3rd inning single by **IF Casey Schmitt** snapped an 0-for-18 stretch with runners in scoring position for the Giants...they would go on to finish the game 3-for-17 with eight strikeouts with RISP.

- ▶ Over their last four games, SF is 3-for-31 (.097) with RISP with 14 strikeouts.

HEATING UP: Two key Giants have caught fire in the last couple weeks.

- ▶ **IF Rafael Devers** is slashing .339/.400/.607 with six doubles, three homers, eight RBI and a 1.007 OPS over his last 16 games...**IF Willy Adames** is slashing .419/.438/.516 with three doubles and seven RBI over his last seven games.

WHAT'S ON DECK: The Giants will head south to Arizona following today's game...this three-game series from Monday-Wednesday is the first series between the Giants and Diamondbacks this season.

- ▶ SF went 6-7 vs. the Diamondbacks in 2025, going 3-4 at Chase Field.
- ▶ The Giants are 5-4 in road games in the state of California (Padres, Dodgers, A's) compared to 4-11 vs. all out-of-state hosts (Orioles, Reds, Nationals, Phillies, Rays).

Age: 33 (February 2, 1993)

YO ADRIAN: Is in his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract (with a club option for 2028) with the Giants this past offseason.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win as a Giant, turning in a solid performance against the Dodgers...pitched 5.2 innings, allowing just three hits and two earned runs while striking out four.

HOUSE CLEANING: After struggling through his first six starts (0-3, 7.12 ERA, 1.71 WHIP over 30.1 IP) Houser has been solid over his last two starts...although he took a tough-luck loss against the Padres the start before last, he holds an ERA of 2.31 (3er, 11.2ip) with an 0.86 WHIP in that span.

VS. THE ATHLETICS: Today will be Houser's third career start against the A's, and first since June 9, 2023 as a member of the Brewers...in those two starts, he's 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA (6er, 9.0ip).

SINK IN: A big difference from last year is his sinker...the pitch had a run value of +6 last season per *Baseball Savant*...so far in 2026, the pitch has a run value of -3...however, entering his last start, his sinker's run value was at -5...over his last two starts, opponents are batting .130 (2x23) vs. the sinker with Houser throwing the pitch 100 times.

LEFT ON READ: Lefties have been a thorn in Houser's side this season...they are slashing .380/.458/.739 with 13 doubles, a triple, six homers and a 1.197 OPS in 92 at-bats compared to righties slashing .169/.188/.260 with a double, two homers and a .447 OPS in 77 at-bats...amongst pitchers with 40.0+ innings pitched this season, Houser's 1.197 OPS vs. left-handed batters is second-highest, behind only COL's Michael Lorenzen (1.229).

HAPPY DAYS: Opponents have a slash line of .329/.387/.622 vs. Houser in night games along with a 1.009 OPS, ranking fourth-highest in the Majors (min. four night game starts).

STUMBLING OUT OF THE GATE: Houser has allowed at least one earned run in five of his eight 1st innings thus far in 2026...opponents are batting .324 (11x34) with three doubles, five home runs and a 1.238 OPS in the 1st inning vs. Houser.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

- ▶ Suffered the loss in his last start against the Dodgers on May 13...only lasted 4.2 innings and allowed four runs (three earned) on seven hits (two homers) and struck out a season-low two batters
- ▶ Played for the Diamondbacks from 2015-2020 and posted a 48-47 record with a 4.13 ERA over 152 career games...has faced Arizona just three times in his career, all of which came last season, and posted a 3-0 record with a 3.15 ERA (7er, 20.0ip) and a 0.95 WHIP...has made just one appearance against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field and tossed a complete game, allowing two runs on three hits with seven strikeouts in the Giants 7-2 victory over Arizona on July 3, 2025.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/15 at ATH; 1.0ip, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has now allowed a run over his last three games (4.1ip).
- ▶ Has allowed runs in seven of his 17 appearances (4.41 ERA)... however, he's 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA (3er, 11.0ip) in his last 11 games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-33 (.152) with four walks and nine strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .179 clip (72-for-402) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 12-for-28 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/14 at LAD; 1.0ip, bb, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ In his last six outings, he has a 5.40 ERA (5er, 8.1ip) and .313 BAA (10x32)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x40).
- ▶ Has thrown 10.1 scoreless innings in eight appearances on the road...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in nine of 15 contests (5.49 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 13-for-44 (.295) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 7-for-28 (.250).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 5/16 at ATH; SV, 1.0ip (15 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his first career save last night with 1.0 perfect inning.
- ▶ Gage's 23 appearances this year are tied for second-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has surrendered four runs (three ER) in 19.1ip this year (1.40 ERA).
- ▶ His 1.40 ERA is the eighth-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-23 (.087) against him this season, and 19-for-106 in his career (.179).
- ▶ His 25.9% hard hit rate ranks in the top 3% of MLB.
- ▶ His 14.1% walk rate is in the bottom 9% of MLB (11 BBs in 19.1ip).
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by **RHP Dan Otero** in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 5/15 at ATH; 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has made three appearances with SF, logging 2.1-scoreless innings with three walks and three strikeouts.
- ▶ Is returning to the Majors for the first time since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL Sunday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/16 at ATH; 0.2ip, h, r, er, hr (9 pitches)

- ▶ Last 6 games: 6.0ip, 5h, 4r, 3er, 2hr, 5bb, 1bb, 5k (4.50 ERA)...had a 0.64 ERA (1er, 14.0ip) with a .111 BAA and 16 K's in 13 games prior.
- ▶ His 1.80 ERA (4er, 20.0ip) ranks 14th among NL relievers.
- ▶ Owns a 25.6% strikeout rate and .147 BAA (10x68) this season.
- ▶ Has a 5.40 BB/9ip...his 14.6% BB rate ranks in the bottom 8% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 5-for-40 (.125) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 5-for-28 (.179) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 5/16 at ATH; 0.2ip, 2r, 2er, 2bb, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL yesterday after missing 14 games with a low back strain...pitched in two rehab games (May 10 and 13), striking out three over 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Had not allowed a run in his last eight appearances prior to injury dating back to April 8 vs. Philadelphia (8.1ip, 2h, 0r, 0er, 4bb, 13k).
- ▶ Right-handers are 4-for-24 (.167) off him with two doubles.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 57.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the second-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP

(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/13 at LAD; 1.1ip, bb (12 pitches)

- ▶ Activated on May 5 after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 5.1 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in five games so far.
- ▶ Batters are 1-for-12 with a single off his sinker thus far, which he's thrown 51.5% of the time...he threw it 34.3% of the time in his stint w/SF last season.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 5/11 at LAD; H; 1.0ip, h, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with nine holds, which is tied for the fourth-most in the Majors.
- ▶ 15 of his 19 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 9-for-61 (.148) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 5-for-36 (.139) with 13 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 84.8 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 5% of the league while his 25.5% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 3%.
- ▶ His 1.67 xERA is third-best in the Majors behind Mason Miller (0.82) and Dylan Lee (1.46).
