AROUND THE HORN

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since March 30, the D-backs' 13 wins are tied for third in the Majors (also: Dodgers and Reds) to the Braves and Padres (14).

- Since April 4, their 10-4 (.714) record is third, behind the Padres (15-2, .867) and Dodgers (15-11, .733).
- The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 games and 8 of their last 11.
- The D-backs have won 4 straight series and won/split 6 straight:
 - Last 5+ straight series wins: 9 from July 12-Aug. 14, 2024.
 - Last 7+ straight series wins/splits: 13 from June 28-Aug. 12, 2024.
- **Ildemaro Vargas'** career-best 18-game hit streak since Sept. 26, 2025 is the Majors' longest active streak since 2025.
 - His 18-gamer is tied for the Majors' fourth-longest streak since 2025, with Bobby Witt (Aug. 11-30, 2025), behind Jackson Chourio's 20-gamer (July 3-27, 2025), José Ramírez's 21-gamer (May 7-28, 2025) and Bobby Witt Jr.'s 22-gamer (April 8-May 1, 2025).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won the series but lost the finale 10-4 vs. Blue Jays on Sunday.

- **Ildemaro Vargas'** extended his MLB-best and career-long 18-game hit streak (since Sept. 26, 2025).
- **Adrian Del Castillo** reached base 3 times (2-for-3, 2B, RBI, BB) for the second time since coming off the injured list on April 3.
- **Andrew Hoffmann** (2.1) and **Brandon Pfaadt** (6.1) combined for 8.2 relief innings (2 R, 6 H, 3 BB, 6 K).
- Pfaadt is the only D-back ever to record 2 relief appearances of 6.0+ innings (also: Sept. 10, 2023 @ Cubs, ND, 6.0 IP, 4 R, 7 H, BB, 4 K)... third D-backs all-time with 6.0+ innings in relief and 1 or fewer runs (also: Randy Johnson, 0 R/7.0 IP on July 18, 2001 @ Padres and Josh Collmenter, 0 R/6.0 IP on June 19, 2013 vs. Marlins).

GO VARGY GO: Ildemaro Vargas' 15-game hit streak is tied for MLB's sixth streak of 15+ games to start the season (within the first 30 games) since 2011:

- Is tied for the third-longest single-season streak by a D-back since 2015, with Tommy Pham from Aug. 8-25, 2023, behind Ketel Marte's 16-gamer from May 16-June 4, 2022 and Marte's 21-gamer from April 28-May 22, 2024.

COMEBACK WINS: The D-backs' 10 comeback wins lead the Majors, (9, Dodgers and Cardinals) and tied the club record for March/April (10 in 2017, '19, '25).

- 10 comeback wins are the most all-time thru the team's first 22 games...last had 11 comeback wins thru 28 games in 2017.

LEVEL UP: The D-backs' 20 high-leverage hits to tie the game or take a lead are tied for most in the Majors (also: Athletics) [source: Stathead].

BULLPEN SNAPSHOT: Since April 4, the D-backs bullpen's 2.30 ERA (17 R-14 ER in 54.2 IP) is second in MLB to the Reds (1.53; 16 R-10 ER in 59.0 IP).

- Since April 4, ranks among MLB leaders in walks (1st, 11), OBP (1st, .231), OPS (1st, .516), WHIP (1st, 0.86), extra-base hits (T-1st, 10), AVG (2nd, .187) and hits (3rd, 36).

IN THE 'PEN: Ryan Thompson's 12 straight games without an earned run is tied for the eighth longest streak by a D-back to start a reliever's season...last with 12+ straight to start their season was Shelby Miller (13 from March 28-May 1, 2025).

- **Juan Morillo** has held opponents scoreless in 11 straight home games (1-0, 8.1 IP, 5 H, 2 BB, 9 K).

WITH RISP: Since April 5, with runners in scoring position, the D-backs are hitting .309 (38-for-123)/.899 OPS with 12 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers and 58 RBI.

- Since April 5, the D-backs lead the Majors with RISP in AVG (1st, .309), SLG (1st, .561), OPS (1st, .899) and extra-base hits (1st, 19) and total bases (1st, 69).

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: The D-backs are 7-2 vs. AL opponents (3-0 vs. Tigers, 2-1 @ Orioles, 2-1 vs. Blue Jays).

- Since Aug. 12, 2025, the D-backs lead the NL with a .739 win pct. (17-6) against the AL and rank second in wins to the Braves (18).
- **Ildemaro Vargas** has a 10-game Interleague hit streak.
- **James McCann** has a 9-game Interleague hit streak.

VS. WHITE SOX: The D-backs' 6 straight series wins (since 2014, 14-4) is tied for the longest streak by a NL team since 1998, along with the Brewers (since 2020, 15-4).

- The D-backs are 5-1 in their last 6 games @ Chase Field since 2017...won 2 of 3 in their last home series from June 14-16, 2024.
- The D-backs' .704 win pct. (19-8) is the NL's best since 1998, ahead of the Mets (.636, 14-8) and Phillies (.607, 17-11).

- **Ketel Marte**, in his last 5 games is hitting .381 (8-for-21)/1.030 OPS with 2 homers and 4 RBI.

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has a 6-game hitting streak, batting .308 (8-for-24)/.782 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 RBI and 3 walks.

- **Nolan Arenado**, in his last 9 games, is hitting .382 (13-for-34)/1.269 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 6 walks.

- **Ildemaro Vargas**, in his last 7 games, is hitting .353 (6-for-17)/.912 OPS with 1 double, 1 RBI and 4 walks.

- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 5 games, is hitting .353 (6-for-17)/.912 OPS with 1 double, 1 RBI and 4 walks.

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, in 20 career starts, is hitting .346 (28-for-81)/.846 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 3 walks.
