- Bradley will make his third start of the season and 2026 home debut tonight...it will also mark his first career start and appearance against the Tigers.
- His 0.87 ERA (10.1 IP, 1 ER) through two starts is the lowest he has ever had to begin a year; ranks ninth in ERA among qualified starting pitchers in the American League.
- On April 2 at Kansas City, Bradley tossed a season-high 100 pitches, twirling 6.0 innings of scoreless baseball, with one walk and three strikeouts...it marked his first quality start of the season and first by a Twins starter in 2026.

LAST TIME OUT: Bradley earned his first win of the season and the first win by a Twins starting pitcher in 2026. Tossed six quality innings, giving up five hits while walking one and striking out three...at the time of his April 2 outing, the Twins had won both of the games in which Bradley had taken the ball, their only wins on the season up to that point.

- TRIPLE DIGITS...FOR REAL:** In the third inning of his start against Kansas City, Bradley struck out Royals star, Bobby Witt Jr., looking with a 100.0 mph fastball. By doing so, Bradley broke his own record of the fastest pitch by a Twins starting pitcher (99.6 mph) that he had set in his previous start on March 29 against Baltimore...following his start in Kansas City, Bradley now holds all 10 of the fastest pitches by a Twins starting pitcher in the StatCast Era.
- It was the third time in Bradley's career that he has hit triple digits...the other two came on July 20, 2024 against Aaron Judge and August 24, 2024 against Freddie Freeman, when Bradley was with the Rays.

2025 RECAP: At the major league level in 2025, Bradley combined to go 6-8 with a 5.05 ERA (142.2 IP, 80 ER), 56 walks and 127 strikeouts in 27 starts between Tampa Bay and Minnesota...made six starts for Twins to end his season, from August 24-September 24, going 0-2 with a 6.61 ERA (31.1 IP, 23 ER), 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.

- Acquired by Minnesota on July 31 in exchange for right-handed pitcher Griffin Jax; initially assigned to Triple-A St. Paul.
- Tallied 13 quality starts over the course of the year, the most in a single season in his career, eclipsing his previous career high of 10 in 2024.

CAREER VS. DETROIT: Tonight will be Taj's first career start and appearance against the club from the Motor City...the only batter Bradley has faced on Detroit's roster is Gleyber Torres (0-4, 1BB, 2K).

- GET YOUR POPCORN OUT:** Bradley will make his 2026 Target Field debut across from two-time reigning Cy Young award winner, Tarik Skubal tonight...Skubal comes into the game sporting a 1-1 record and 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER), while Bradley also brings in a sub 1.00 ERA (0.87).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Over the course of his career, Bradley is 11-15 with a 5.10 ERA (194.0 IP, 110 ER), 64 walks, 218 strikeouts and a 1.27 WHIP in 37 career home starts compared to 9-12 with a 4.42 ERA (201.2 IP, 99 ER), 82 walks, 204 strikeouts and a 1.32 WHIP in 40 road appearances (38 starts).

- In 2025, between Tampa Bay and Minnesota, Bradley went 4-4 with a 5.89 ERA (70.1 IP, 46 ER), 27 walks, 64 strikeouts and a 1.42 WHIP in 14 home starts while going 2-4 with a 4.23 ERA (72.1 IP, 34 ER), 29 walks, 63 strikeouts and a 1.20 WHIP in 13 road starts.
- In three starts at Target Field in 2025, Bradley went 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA (14.0 IP, 12 ER), 7 walks and 17 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .278/.350/.333 (5-for-18) with one double, two walks and six strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .143/.217/.143 (3-for-21) with zero extra-base-hits, two walks and six strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

- Bradley continues to rely heavily on the fastball, with 69.8% of his pitches so far this season being either his four seamer or cutter. His 47.9% four seam usage ranks second on the Twins starting staff, behind only Simeon Woods Richardson (50.3%).

- His split finger is tied for the best run value (2) among all pitchers in baseball (min. 10 pitches), and is one of six MLB starters with a .000 (0-for-8) opponent batting average against the split finger (min. 10 pitches).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - BAILEY OBER (2025: 0-0, 6.75 ERA // CAREER: 31-30, 4.11 ERA)

Right-hander Bailey Ober is set to start tomorrow night in the third game of a four-game set against Detroit...will be Ober's third start of the year and second start at home...will also be his second start during the seven-game homestand, after he started the home opener on April 3...in the home opener, went 4.0 innings, giving up three runs (all earned) on four hits, with two walks and four strikeouts in a 10-4 Twins win...owns a career record at Target Field of 16-15 with a 4.22 ERA (318.0 IP, 149 ER), 77 walks, 314 strikeouts, a 1.15 WHIP and a .239 (288-for-1207) BAA...has made 13 career starts against Detroit, going 4-3 with a 4.13 ERA (72.0 IP, 33 ER), 13 walks, 76 strikeouts, a 1.18 WHIP and a .257 (72-for-280) BAA.

CAREER NOTES

- Made six starts for Twins to end his season, from August 24-September 24, going 0-2, 6.61 ERA (31.1 IP, 23 ER) with 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.
- Acquired by the Minnesota Twins from Tampa Bay on July 31 in exchange for RHP Griffin Jax.
- In 2025, made the Rays Opening rotation for the first time as the team's third starter...posted a 4.61 ERA (111.1 IP, 57 ER) with 44 walks and 95 strikeouts over 21 starts.
- In 2024, went 8-11 with a 4.11 ERA (138.0 IP, 63 ER) and 154 Ks over 25 starts with the Rays...set career highs in nearly every major category while leading the club in strikeouts, wins and quality starts (T-1st, 10).
- Named AL Pitcher of the Month for July after going 3-1 with a 1.45 ERA (31.0 IP, 5 ER) and 31 Ks across five starts...became the ninth pitcher (11x) in franchise history to earn AL Pitcher of the Month honors...also became the youngest player in Rays history to earn a monthly award from MLB.
- In 2023, went 5-8 with a 5.56 ERA over 22 appearances (21 GS) in his first MLB season.
- Collected 128 Ks in his 21 outings, most in Rays history through a rookie pitcher's first 21 career starts and seventh most in a rookie season...also marked the fourth most strikeouts through any pitcher's first 21 starts after joining the Rays, behind Charlie Morton (152), Drew Smyly (137) and Tyler Glasnow (129).
- He was the youngest pitcher in the majors to make at least 20 starts...became the third pitcher (4x) in Rays history to reach the threshold in an age 22 or younger season, joining Scott Kazmir (32, 2005 & 24, 2006) and Joe Kennedy (20, 2001).
- Entered the season ranked as the Rays No. 3 prospect and the No. 44 prospect in the majors by *Baseball America*...was ranked as the Rays No. 1 prospect and the No. 16 prospect in the majors by MLB.com.
- In 2022, split the season between Double-A Montgomery and Triple-A Durham, earning a July 21 promotion...went 7-4 with a 2.57 ERA (133.1 IP, 38 ER) and 141 Ks in 28 starts between the two levels.
- Named Southern League Pitcher of the Month for May, turning in a 1.06 ERA (17.0 IP, 2 ER) and 23 Ks in four starts.
- Started for the AL Team at the All-Star Futures Game, his first career selection...pitched around a double and walk for a scoreless first inning.
- Split the 2021 season with Class-A Charleston and Class-A Bowling Green...went 12-3 with a 1.83 ERA (103.1 IP, 21 ER) in 23 appearances (22 GS).
- Led full-season minor leaguers in ERA and tied for third in wins.
- Named the Top Starting Pitcher in the minors at the annual MLBBY Awards following the season.
- Named to the Rays Organizational All-Star Team by MLB.com and to Baseball America's Minor League All-Star Team.
- In 2020, was not part of the Rays 60-man player pool and did not play following the cancellation of the minor league season.
- Selected by Tampa Bay in the fifth round (150th overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Redan High School (Stone Mountain, GA).
