BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore opens a three-game road trip tonight in Cincinnati...The Birds are coming off a 2-4 homestand against the Nationals (1-2) and White Sox (1-2)...Following Monday's off day, the O's host the Cubs (3 G) and Royals (3 G) before entering the All-Star break...Baltimore enters play today 13.0 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 5.0 games back in the Wild Card.

⚾ The Birds' 6-1 win on Wednesday snapped a four-game losing skid...A loss would have marked a season-high-tying fifth straight loss (4/30 [G2]-5/4).

⚾ The O's drew seven walks in the win and it marked their 10th game with seven or more free passes...The 2025 Orioles had six such games.

⚾ **Leody Taveras** (1-for-3, HR, 2 R, BB, SB) became the eighth player to reach at least 15 extra-base hits and 10 stolen bases before the All-Star break in his first season with the Orioles in team history (since 1954), including the first since Corey Patterson in 2006 (20 XBH, 31 SB).

ROGER THAT: Over five June starts, **Trevor Rogers** went 3-1 with a 2.05 ERA (7 ER/30.2 IP), .198 (22-for-111) opponent average, and 0.91 WHIP.

⚾ Among all MLB pitchers who threw at least 30.0 innings in June, Rogers' 2.05 ERA was ninth lowest in the majors, including third lowest in the AL behind TB's Drew Rasmussen (0.82) and CLE's Tanner Bibee (1.89).

⚾ In four July starts in 2025, Rogers went 3-1 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) and 0.72 WHIP.

FASTBALL FOCUS: Since June 13, during which Baltimore is 6-11, Orioles hitters are batting .229 on fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, cutter), the third-lowest mark in the majors ahead of the Braves (.221) and Yankees (.207)...In their previous 21 games from May 22-June 12, during which the O's went 13-8, Baltimore hit .274 on fastballs, ranking 13th in MLB.

GUNNAR GETTING GOING: Over his last three games, all of which have come in the leadoff spot, **Gunnar Henderson** has recorded 1+ hit and 1+ run, going 5-for-12 (.417) with two doubles, four runs, two walks, and zero strikeouts...The three-game streak with 1+ hit and 1+ run is tied for his second longest of the season behind a career-best six-game run earlier this season from April 6-12.

⚾ He has reached base safely in each of his last eight road games since June 17, slashing .250/.351/.531 (8-for-32) with one double, one triple, two home runs, six runs, five RBI, four walks, and one hit-by-pitch.

⚾ He has reached base safely in each of his three career games at Great American Ball Park, going 3-for-10 (.300) with four walks.

QUEEN CITY CREDENTIALS: **Adley Rutschman** has hit safely in five of six career games at Great American Ball Park, slashing .360/.407/.560 (9-for-25) with two doubles, one home run, four runs, four RBI, and two walks.

⚾ Baltimore swept the three-game set over Cincinnati in 2024, outscoring the Reds 16-2 during the series at Great American Ball Park.

⚾ The Birds have played 12 games all-time at Great American Ball Park, tied with the Mariners for the second fewest by any team in MLB behind the Athletics (8).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 79 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Athletics (75 G).

⚾ The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

⚾ Oriole relievers have not permitted a walk in a season-high-tying four straight games (also 6/4-7).

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** is tied for third in the AL and tied for seventh in the majors with 59 RBI...He is batting .270/.385/.540 (27-for-100) with three doubles, eight homers, 19 runs, 23 RBI, 18 walks, and two hit-by-pitches in 28 games since June 1.

⚾ He is one home run shy of becoming the 21st player (28th occurrence) in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and **Anthony Santander** (24) in 2024...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 37 home runs in 2013.

⚾ Alonso is one RBI shy of becoming the 24th player (31st occurrence) in O's history to drive in 60 runs before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (63) in 2024...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 93 RBI in 2013.

⚾ Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on Saturday and has played 504 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (867 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .366/.413/.542 (48-for-131) with 10 doubles, two triples, three home runs, 16 runs, 25 RBI, nine walks (1 IBB), five stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 49 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

⚾ Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 100 PA) in batting average (1st), on-base percentage (6th), and OPS (10th, .955).

⚾ His seven games with at least three hits since May 4 are tied for the major league lead with HOU's Yordan Alvarez, NYM's Carson Benge, PHI's Bryce Harper, PHI's Brandon Marsh, and WSH's James Wood.

⚾ Alexander is batting .370 (17-for-46) with five doubles, two triples, one home run, and 23 RBI with runners in scoring position...His average with RISP ranks seventh in the majors (min. 45 AB).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (T-2nd, 66) and times on base (T-4th, 151)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

⚾ Ward recorded 64 walks and 76 hits through 80 career games with the Orioles...The only other players to have at least 60 walks and 75 hits through 80 career games with the club in franchise history (since 1954) were Albert Belle (63 BB, 82 H), Bob Nieman (62 BB, 89 H), and Ken Singleton (68 BB, 89 H).

⚾ His 15 multi-walk games are tied for second most in the majors behind LAA's Mike Trout (19)...Last season, **Jackson Holliday** led the Orioles with nine multi-walk efforts.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 16th start of the season and 118th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second straight win on June 26 vs. Washington after tossing 6.1 innings of one-run ball, scattering five hits with zero walks and a season-high seven strikeouts...Threw 87 pitches, 65 strikes.

👉 The seven strikeouts marked his most since September 19, 2025 vs. New York-AL (also 7)...Has 13 punchouts over his last two outings after recording 15 strikeouts over his previous five starts.

👉 Did not issue a walk for the second time this season, joining April 7 at Chicago-AL.

SEEING RED: Rogers is set to make his third career start opposite the Reds, having gone 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA (8 ER/9.1 IP)...Both of the outings have come in Cincinnati.

👉 Is 4-5 with a 3.65 ERA (30 ER/74.0 IP) in 14 career starts against the NL Central.

ENCOURAGING SIGNS: Over five June starts, Rogers went 3-1 with a 2.05 ERA (7 ER/30.2 IP) and a .510 opponent OPS.

👉 Among all MLB pitchers who threw at least 30.0 innings in June, Rogers' 2.05 ERA was ninth lowest in the majors, including third lowest in the AL behind TB's Drew Rasmussen (0.82) and CLE's Tanner Bibee (1.89).

👉 He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

👉 Posted a .188 (3-for-16) opponent average on his sweeper in June after opponents went 3-for-7 (.429) off the pitch in May...His usage on the sweeper was up to 13.8 percent in June after throwing it 10.4 percent of the time in May.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Over his past two starts, Rogers has limited left-handed hitters to a .053 (1-for-19) clip with one double and eight strikeouts.

👉 Over his previous seven starts from May 12-June 14, lefties went 11-for-39 (.282) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, four walks, and seven strikeouts.

👉 Rogers opened the season limiting left-handed hitters to a .091 (2-for-22) mark with two doubles, three walks, and eight strikeouts over six starts.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .340/.397/.472 (36-for-106) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 28 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

👉 His .868 opponent OPS with two outs is the fifth-highest mark in the AL (min. 100 BF) and the 11th highest in MLB.

👉 Opponents are slashing .500/.558/.763 (19-for-38) with four doubles and two home runs off Rogers with runners in scoring position and two outs.

ORDER OF OPERATIONS: Rogers has held the opposition to a .194 (25-for-129) batting average the first time through the order... However, they are hitting .310 (36-for-116) the second time through and .292 (19-for-65) the third time around.

👉 Nine-hole hitters are slashing .393/.433/.500 (11-for-28) with three doubles off Rogers.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).

2025 IN REVIEW: Went 9-3 in 2025 with a 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) on 70 hits (6 HR), 29 walks, and two hit batters with 103 strikeouts across 18 starts...Led the Orioles with a career-high 5.5 *Baseball Reference* Wins Above Replacement, the third-highest mark by an Oriole southpaw in franchise history (since 1954).

👉 His ERA was second lowest in MLB behind TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.73), while his opponent average, opponent slugging percentage, and opponent OPS each led all pitchers (min. 100.0 IP).
