TOUCHING ALL THE BASES

D-BACKS LAUNCH INTERACTIVE APP: The D-backs launched a series of interactive games within the MLB Ballpark app that will allow fans to stay connected from home during the 60-game season and beyond...fans can download the Ballpark App for free and after navigating to the D-backs' homepage, click on Interactive Games to earn points during daily competitions, with the opportunity to win prizes each day throughout the season.

HERE'S THE STORY: Arizona has won 2 of its last 3 games.

- ◆ Merrill Kelly has thrown at least 6.0 innings in 7 consecutive starts dating back to Sept. 3, 2019 vs. Padres...he is 5-2 with a 2.31 ERA (12 ER in 46.2 IP) during that span.
- ◆ David Peralta is 6-for-12 (.500)/.625 OBP/.917 SLG with 1 triple, 1 home run, 5 RBI and 4 walks in his last 4 games.
- ◆ **Starling Marte** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 13 plate appearances and in 12 of 13 games this season.

IT ALL STARTED IN S.D.: Merrill Kelly won his Major League debut on April 1, 2019 @ Petco Park, allowing 3 runs over 6.0 innings of a 10-3 victory.

♦ Kelly and Jon Duplantier (save) became the first duo to earn the win and save while making their Major League debuts in the same game since saves became an official statistic in 1969 [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

JUST PERFECT CLARKE: Last night @ Padres, **Taylor Clarke** retired all 9 batters faced, the first D-back to toss 3.0+ perfect innings of relief since Patrick Corbin on Sept. 15, 2016 vs. Dodgers (3.0 IP).

♦ Max Scherzer holds the club record for longest perfect relief outing with 4.1 IP (13 BF) on April 29, 2008 @ Phillies.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK: 4 of Arizona's 5 victories have come after trailing.

IT ALL STARTED WITH AN INSIDE JOB: Starting with Kole Calhoun's 2-run, inside-the-park home run in the fourth inning on Aug. 5, the D-backs have scored 19 runs in their last 22 innings on offense compared to 29 in their previous 101.

WORTH THE RISP: The D-backs are 12-for-27 (.414) in their last 3 games with runners in scoring position and are batting .322 (19-for-57) with RISP in their last 8.

DOUBLE YOUR FUN: Christian Walker has 5 doubles in his last 8 games and is tied for the Major League-lead with 7 doubles (also: Jose Iglesias/BAL, Maikel Franco/K.C. and J.D. Martinez/BOS).

PROVIDING RELIEF: The D-backs relievers' .191 opponent average is third in the NL behind the Cardinals (.100) and Dodgers (.187).

♦ In their last 5 games, Arizona's bullpen has posted a 1.83 ERA (4 ER in 19.2 IP) and 21 strikeouts.

GUERRA HAS IT GOING ON: Junior Guerra's 6 hitless outings to start the season are tied for the most in baseball with Tyler Kinley/COL, Jordan Romano/TOR and Jeremy Jeffress/CHC.

QUITE THE FIRST HOMECOMING HOMESTAND: One day after hitting his first career inside-the-park home run, **Kole Calhoun** delivered his third career walk-off hit on Thursday vs. Astros (double off Ryan Pressly).

◆ Calhoun, who was born and resides in Tempe, is 6-for-18 (.333) with 3 doubles, 1 home run and 6 RBI in his last 5 games.

A GALLEN OF SOLID STARTS: On Thursday, Zac Gallen tied a NL record for starting pitchers by allowing 3 or fewer earned runs in each of his first 18 career games (all starts, no relief appearances), matching the mark set by Steve Rogers/MON (July 18, 1973-April 11, 1974).

♦ The Major League record is 21 by Aaron Sele/BOS from June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994.

JOE G TO BE FEATURED ON MLB NETWORK: Former D-backs broadcaster **Joe Garagiola** will be featured on MLB Network's series *The Sounds of Baseball* tomorrow at 5:00 p.m. AZ.

♦ Bob Costas and Tom Verducci will co-host the show and highlight the Hall of Famer's career.

NEXT STARTER: LHP MADISON BUMGARNER (0-2, 7.04)

- ♦ Is looking for his first win since Aug. 30, 2019 vs. Padres and first on the road since July 28, 2019 @ Petco Park.
- ♦ Lost his last start on Aug. 4 vs. Astros (7 ER in 4.1 IP).
- ♦ Made D-backs debut on July 24 @ Padres (L, 3 ER in 5.2 IP).
- ♦ Is 13-11 with a 3.43 ERA (90 ER in 236.0 IP) in 37 games (36 starts) lifetime vs. Padres…has gone 5-8 with a 3.99 ERA (51 ER in 115.0 IP) @ Petco Park.

- Agreed to terms on a 2-year contract through 2020 (club options 2021, '22) on Dec. 4, 2018.
- Played 5 seasons in the Rays' system (2010-14) then 4 seasons (2015-18) with the SK Wyverns in the KBO League.
- Rays' eighth-round pick in the 2010 draft.

LAST START: Lost on Aug. 2 vs. Dodgers (3 ER in 6.0 IP)...gave up homers to Mookie Betts (solo) and Clay Bellinger (2-run).

VS. PADRES: Was 3-1 with a 3.71 ERA (11 ER in 26.2 IP) in 5 starts in 2019.

NO-HIT BID: Set a career high with 6.1 hitless innings to start a game on July 28 @ Rangers.

 The no-hit bid was snapped in the seventh inning on Rougned Odor's solo homer.

FINISHING STRONG: Went 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA (8 ER in 33.0 IP) and a .202 opponent average over his last 5 starts in 2019.

 Posted a 16.2-inning scoreless streak that covered parts of his final 4 outings (Sept. 9-25, 2019).

2019 REVIEW: Went 13-14 with a 4.42 ERA (90 ER in 183.1 IP), .260 opponent average and 158 strikeouts in 32 starts in his first Major League season with Arizona.

- Led Major League rookies in strikeouts, ranked second in innings, was tied for second in wins and ranked fourth in ERA...was the second D-back rookie to lead the Majors in strikeouts (also: Brandon Webb in 2003).
- His 158 strikeouts were second all-time by a D-backs rookie, behind only Brandon Webb in 2003 (172).

ARIZONA PRIDE: Grew up in Scottsdale, Ariz., and attended Desert Mountain High School, Yavapai College and Arizona State University.

 Attended Arizona State University (2010) and helped the Sun Devils reach the College World Series in 2010.
