## A Slice of Devin

Devin Williams has posted a sterling 1.69 ERA this season (26.2ip, 5er).... he surrendered 4 runs without retiring a batter in his lone blown save of the season on 6/13 at Minnesota... without that outing, his season ERA drops to 0.34 (26.2ip, 1er).

## It's Milner Time!

**Hoby Milner** is unscored upon in each of his last 15 appearances (13ip) to lower his ERA from 4.50 to 2.61.

## Rebel Yeli

Since June 6. Christian Yelich has hit .338 (24-for-71) with 2 HR and 9 RBI in 19 games while he has produced a .434 OBP/.563 SLG/.997 OPS.

## Take Me To Your Leader

Christian Yelich is the team leader in runs (53 - 9th in NL), hits (76), walks (40 - T9th in NL), SB (17 - T6th in NL), doubles (15), total bases (120), OBF (.368), SLG (.429) and OPS (.797) and is tied for the team lead in XBH (25).

MANAGER: Craig Counsell - the longest-tenured active manager in the National League and third in the majors - is in his ninth season as Brewers manager (656-593) and eighth full season.....he has the most wins (656) and games managed (1,249) of any manager in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through the 2023 season.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (3rd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (2nd season), bulloen coach **Jim Henderson** (2nd season), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (5th season), third base coach Jason Lane (8th season, 3rd as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (4th season), bench coach Pat Murphy (8th season) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (2nd season) all returned from the 2022 staff.....Néstor Corredor, who was bullpen catcher (2021-22), is now a coach.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER: #20 - LHP WADE MILEY (10gs, 5-2, 2.91)

MILEY AT A GLANCE: Wade Miley, 36, is making his 11th start of the season and second against the Mets.....Miley last started last Friday at Cleveland and earned a 7-1 win (6ip, 3h, 0r, 0bb, 3k, 67 pitches).....the team is 7-3 in his starts.....he has made 5 quality starts.....opponents are batting .219 (43-for-196, 6hr).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 5/17-6/16 with a left lat strain.....he has gone 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 2 starts since coming off the IL (11ip, 0er).....Miley signed as a free agent with Milwaukee on January 9.....he is signed through the 2023 season with a mutual option for 2024.

WELCOME BACK!: Miley returned to Milwaukee, where he pitched in 2018 for the National League Central champions and went 5-2 with a 2.57 ERA in 16 starts.....he went on to make 4 starts during the postseason, posting a 1.23 ERA (14.2ip, 2er), as the team went on to advance to the seventh game of the NLCS against Los Angeles.

LAST SEASON: Miley went 2-2 with a 3.16 ERA in 9 games/8 starts with Chicago-NL last season.....he missed most of the season while spending time on the injured list on three occasions: 4/7-5/9 (left elbow inflammation), 5/29-6/9 (left shoulder strain) and 6/11-9/5 (left shoulder strain).

CAREER: Is 104-96 with a 4.09 ERA in 302 games/295 starts (1670.2ip, 759er).....is in his 13th Major League season with Arizona (2011-14), Boston (2015), Seattle (2016), Baltimore (2016-17), Milwaukee (2018, '23), Houston (2019), Cincinnati (2020-21) and Chicago-NL (2022).....was an All-Star with the Diamondbacks in 2012....he threw a no-hitter with the Reds on 5/7/21 at Cleveland.....Miley was selected by Arizona in the supplemental first round (43rd overall) of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft out of Southeastern Louisiana University.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-3 with a 3.90 ERA in 17 starts (80.2ip, 35er)....is 3-1 with a 3.33 ERA in 5 starts this season (27ip, 10er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 50-51 with a 3.96 ERA in 160 games/158 starts (889ip, 391er)....is 2-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 starts this season (25.2ip, 7er).

CAREER vs. METS: Is 2-1 with a 3.19 ERA in 7 starts (42.1ip, 15er), including 0-0 with a 4.01 ERA in 4 starts at Citi Field (24.2ip, 11er).....Miley earned a 9-0 win against the Mets this season on 4/4 at American Family Field (6ip. 5h. Obb. 3k. 1hbp).
