LHP David Peterson (5-3, 2.98 ERA) vs. RHP Mitch Keller (1-10, 4.02 ERA)

THE PIRATES: had the day off on Thursday...Went 1-2 on their three-game road trip to Milwaukee (Monday-Wednesday)...Are 12-11 against the National League East, including 10-3 at home...Have gone 40-34 all-time vs. the Mets here at PNC Park...Are 20-24 since Don Kelly took over as manager on May 8 (played in 21 one-run games in that span).

IT'S A BEAUTIFUL DAY IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD: The Pirates will begin a six-game homestand tonight, featuring three games this weekend against New York (NL) and three games this coming Monday to Wednesday against St. Louis...Pittsburgh has gone 13-9 at home since Don Kelly made his managerial debut here on May 9 vs. Atlanta...The Pirates' pitching staff has posted a 3.00 ERA (201.0ip/67er) in those 22 games, including a 2.77 ERA (126.2ip/39er) from the rotation.

A QUALITY INDIVIDUAL: Mitch Keller will start the opener of this weekend's three-game series against the Mets tonight...Keller's 11 quality starts so far this season are tied for the eighth-most in all of Major League (teammate Paul Skenes, 12, is tied for the third-most)...Keller also enters today ranked sixth in all of Major League Baseball in home runs allowed per 9.0 innings (0.57) and eighth among National League pitchers in innings pitched (94.0).

BEASTS AGAINST THE EAST: The Pirates are 12-11 against teams from the National League East this season, including 10-3 here at PNC Park...Pittsburgh has gone 21-9 against the National League East here at PNC Park since the beginning of the 2024 season (7-0-2 in nine series)...Pittsburgh's last series loss here against the NL East came from September 29-October 1, 2023 vs. Miami.

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Spencer Horwitz went 1-for-3 with a double and an RBI on Wednesday at Milwaukee, extending his career-high on-base streak to 14 games (since June 9 vs. Miami)...It's the longest-such streak by a Pirate since Andrew McCutchen reached in 15 straight games last season from July 28-September 2...It's also tied for the fifth-longest active streak in all of Major League Baseball...Horwitz has hit safely in 12 of 14 games during the streak, going 16-for-51 (.314) with six doubles, five RBI, five walks and nine runs scored.

PHAMTASTIC: Tommy Pham has multiple hits in three straight games (since Sunday vs. Texas), going 7-for-11 with a pair of doubles, a home run and six RBI...Pham has knocked in a run in three consecutive games for the first time since last season from July 28-31 (also three straight)...Pham is a .339 hitter (39-for-115) in his 35 career games against the Mets.

DENNIS DEALING: Dennis Santana enters today with a 1.57 ERA (34.1ip/6er), the seventh-lowest mark among all Major League relievers so far this season...Since making his Pirates debut last season on June 13, his 2.06 ERA (78.2ip/18er) is the third-lowest mark among all Major League relief pitchers with at least 75.0 innings pitched during that stretch...Only Emmanuel Clase (1.76) and Jason Adam (1.88) have a lower ERA.

SLICK NICK: Nick Gonzales has 14 hits over his last eight games, dating back to game one of the June 19 doubleheader at Detroit, tied with Detroit's Riley Greene and Milwaukee's Christian Yelich for the second-most hits in Major League Baseball during that span...Only Arizona's Ketel Marte (15) has more.

SOUTHPAW SIGHTING: The Pirates will face a left-handed starter tonight for the 20th time this season...That's tied with New York for the second-fewest among all National League teams (Atlanta, 15, has faced the fewest)...Andrew McCutchen is hitting at a .319 clip (23-for-72) so far this season against left-handed pitchers, which ranks eighth among all players in the National League.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

June 27, 2018: The Pirates erased a 3-0, eighth-inning deficit with one run in the eighth and four runs in the ninth, completing a 5-3, come-from-behind victory over the Mets at Citi Field. Each of Pittsburgh's five batters in the ninth inning reached base, highlighted by David Freese's two-run single that scored Corey Dickerson and Gregory Polanco to put the Pirates ahead, 4-3.

STARTING OFF: The 29-year-old Keller is in his seventh Major League season...He signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 23, 2024... He earned Opening Day honors in both 2023 and 2024, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16... He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller allowed three runs (two earned) over his 5.2 innings of work on June 21 vs. Texas, losing a 3-2 decision...It was Keller's first start of less than 6.0 innings since May 2 vs. San Diego (the eight-start streak began on May 7 at St. Louis).

AGAINST THE METS: Keller will make his sixth career start against New York (NL), his second this season...He allowed two runs over 7.0 innings on May 13 at Citi Field, dropping a 2-1 decision...Keller is 3-0 with a 1.29 ERA (21.0ip/3er) in three career starts against the Mets here at PNC Park (allowed two runs in 8.0 innings last July 8).

QUALITY IS JOB ONE: Keller has 11 quality starts this season, tied for the fifth-most in the National League and tied for the eighth-most in all of Major League Baseball.

K IS FOR KELLER: Keller enters the action tonight with 760 strikeouts, 18th-most in Pirates history...Howie Camnitz ranks 17th with 806 (Bob Friend ranks first with 1682).

RIGHT AT HOME: Keller enters tonight's start with 378 career strikeouts at PNC Park, the second-most in stadium history, behind only Paul Maholm (383)...Keller's 76 career starts are here are the third-most, trailing Maholm (100) and Zach Duke (82).

LOOKING FOR A WIN: Keller has lost 10 straight decisions since earning a win in his season debut on March 28 at Miami...He's the first Pirates pitcher to lose at least 10 consecutive decisions since Jose DeLeon lost 11 straight from June 19-October 4, 1985.

IN NEED OF SUPPORT: The Pirates have scored one or zero runs while Keller was in the game in 10 of his first 16 starts to begin the season...Keller's 2.11 average runs of support while in the game are the fewest among all qualified Major League pitchers.

AS A PIRATE: The Pirates selected Keller in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa...He was rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect in each season from 2018-20...He was also recognized by the same publication as a top-100 prospect in the game from 2017-20.

THE 700 CLUB: With his strikeout of St. Louis' Pedro Pagés in the seventh inning of his start on April 9, Keller notched his 700th career strikeout...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the fastest pitcher in club history to reach 700 strikeouts with Pittsburgh by innings (718.1)...The previous record was held by Bob Veale (740.0 innings)...Per Elias, he also became the third-fastest pitcher in team history to reach the 700-strikeout mark with Pittsburgh by games (136), behind only Gerrit Cole (126) and Veale (135).

SIGN HERE, PLEASE: The Pirates signed Keller to a five-year contract extension through 2028 on February 23, 2024...He became the third member of the current team to sign a long-term contract extension, joining Ke'Bryan Hayes and Bryan Reynolds.
