TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners go for the series win as they play the third of a 4-game series tonight at the Baltimore Orioles (2-0)...Seattle is coming off a 3-game series at the Detroit Tigers (1-2) to start the trip, and will face the Washington Nationals (3 G, June 12-14) as the third and final leg...tonight's game against the O's will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call, with **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Shannon Drayer** on the call.

ODDS & ENDS...the Mariners beat the Orioles by a 6-5 score in 10 innings in thrilling fashion last night...**Seattle is an MLB-best 11-3 (.786) since May 25, 14-6 (.700) since May 18, and 19-12 (.613) since May 6.**

- **Best In The West** - The Mariners (36-32) are in first place in the American League West Division, 3.0 games ahead of the second place Rangers (32-34).
- **Programming Note** - Tomorrow night's finale against the Orioles will be televised live and exclusively on **ESPN**...**Kevin Brown, David Ross, Adam Ottavino** and **Buster Olney** will be on the call.
- **So Extra** - Seattle leads MLB in one-run games (24) and is tied for 2nd-most extra inning games (9).
- **Swung On And Belted** - The Mariners are 32-16 (.667) when they homer in a game, as opposed to 4-16 (.200) when they do not homer.
- **Happy Birthday!** - Mariners bullpen catcher **Fleming Báez** celebrates his 45th birthday today.

★**MARINERS.COM/VOTE**★...All-Star voting is underway for the 2026 MLB All-Star Game on July 14 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia...fans can submit up to 5 ballots per day until the conclusion of Phase One (June 25)...Phase Two, which takes the finalists at each position, will run from June 29-July 2 before the All-Star rosters are announced on July 4...for more information and to vote, visit Mariners.com/Vote.

SMOOTH SAILING...during the Mariners current 11-3 stretch (5/25-c), the pitching staff holds an MLB-best 2.80 ERA (40 ER, 128.2 IP)...Seattle pitchers also lead the AL and rank 2nd in MLB with a 1.01 WHIP during that span, trailing only the Dodgers (0.97)...also during the span, the Seattle offense ranks 3rd in MLB in batting average (.284), 3rd in slugging (.488), 4th in OPS (.822) and 2nd in home runs (27)...their .498 slugging percentage leads the American League.

RANDY: FIT TO BE AN ALL-STAR...**Randy Arozarena** last night went 3-for-5 with 3 RBI, including the go-ahead 2-run home run in the 10th inning...it marked his 2nd consecutive game with 3 hits and his 3rd game-tying or go-ahead homer of the year...Randy has been a steady offensive presence this season, batting .299 (75x251) with 45 runs, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 7 home runs, 33 RBI, 27 walks and 18 stolen bases, getting on base at a .385 clip and slugging .462 for an .847 OPS in 68 games...among AL outfielders with at least 200 plate appearances (min. 50% games played), Arozarena leads the league in hits, fWAR (2.4), stolen bases, and doubles and ranks 2nd in batting average, 4th in OPS, and 4th in OBP.

J-ROD: ALL-STAR BOUND (AGAIN!)...**Julio Rodríguez** has made the All-Star Game in 3 of his first 4 seasons and has the chance to make it 4 out of 5...only 33 players in MLB history have earned a nod to the Midsummer Classic in at least 4 of their first 5 seasons, with 2 of them being Mariners: Hall of Famers Ken Griffey Jr. and Ichiro Suzuki...Julio is batting .255 (70x275) with 38 runs, 14 doubles, 13 home runs, 32 RBI, 22 walks, 9 stolen bases, a .313 OBP and is slugging .447 for a .760 OPS in 68 games.

CAL WORKING HIS WAY BACK...**Cal Raleigh** (right oblique strain) made his second rehab appearance on Tuesday afternoon with Triple-A Tacoma, going 2-for-3 with 2 home runs, including a grand slam, and 6 RBI as catcher...he is set to make his next rehab appearance on Thursday with Triple-A Tacoma...fans with a **Mariners.TV** subscription have access to **MiLB.TV** and can watch Raleigh, along with Mariners top prospects like **Kade Anderson, Ryan Sloan, Lazaro Montes**, and others in the farm system.

FURIOUS GEORGE...across 8 career starts against the Orioles, **George Kirby** owns a 3.26 ERA (18 ER, 49.2 IP) with 39 strikeouts to 5 walks allowed...on August 12, 2023, he threw his first ever complete game against Baltimore, throwing 9.0 scoreless innings with 7 strikeouts at T-Mobile Park...Kirby has faced the Orioles more times than any other opponent outside the American League West.

DAVILA!...the Mariners recalled right-hander **Nick Davila** from Triple-A Tacoma yesterday...Davila registered his first career Major League save in last night's 6-5 win, in his eighth career appearance...in a corresponding move, righty **Cooper Criswell** was placed on the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder strain).

NAYLZ FOR MOST OF THE SEASON...in 44 games since April 17, **Josh Naylor** is batting .324 (56x173) with 22 runs, 7 doubles, 5 homers, 23 RBI, 16 walks and 12 stolen bases, posting a .382 on-base percentage, .451 slugging and .833 OPS in 192 plate appearances...he hit his first grand slam in a Mariners uniform during Monday night's series-opening win.

MARINERS POST-GAME ALUMNI HOME RUN DERBY SET FOR AUGUST 7...the Mariners announced the club will hold its first ever Alumni Home Run Derby, with participants including Hall of Famer **Ichiro Suzuki**, Mariners legend **Mike Cameron**, broadcasters **Ryan Rowland-Smith** and **Ryon Healy**, Bullpen Coach **Austin Nola**, local radio host **Bucky Jacobsen** and former Mariner **Stefen Romero**...all fans with a ticket to the game on Friday, Aug. 7 will have access to the Alumni Home Run Derby.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Randy Arozarena** provided the go-ahead, 2-run homer in the top of the 10th inning last night, the eventual game-winning home run in the 6-5 Mariners victory...it marked Randy's 125th career home run, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...teammate **Julio Rodríguez** also hit his 125th career homer, exactly a week prior to Randy's, on June 2 vs. the Mets?...on back-to-back Tuesdays, Mariners starting outfielders clubbed their 125th career homers in games that **Logan Gilbert** started...Seattle also had 3-run homers from their catchers (**Jhonny Pereda** and **Mitch Garver**, respectively) in both of those games, which resulted in Mariners wins.

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - JUNE 10

- 1992 - The baseball owners vote to approve the sale of the Seattle franchise from Jeff Smulyan to the Baseball Club of Seattle, L.P.
- 1994 - The game in the Kingdome vs. Oakland is delayed 20 minutes by a power outage. When play is resumed the A's snap Randy Johnson's string of 29 consecutive scoreless innings with back-to-back doubles by Rickey Henderson and Stan Javier.
- 2002 - Seattle plays St. Louis for the first time in club history, beating the Cardinals 10-0 as Jamie Moyer goes the distance to earn the victory at then Safeco Field.
- 2002 - So Taguchi and Ichiro Suzuki took the field and marked the first time two Japanese position players played in a major league game.
- 2014 - The Mariners honor Derek Jeter in his last stop in Seattle, presenting him with a chair from the Kingdome. Jeter made his MLB debut on May 29, 1995 at the Kingdome. Robinson Canó also gave a personal gift to The Captain, a watch.

ABOUT GEORGE KIRBY...

- The 28-year-old right-hander is making his 14th start of the season and 1st against the Orioles...is making the 126th start of his career and his 9th career start against Baltimore.
• Is in his 5th season with Seattle; selected by the Mariners in the first round (20th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Ty Holub.
• Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2023.
• Named AL Rookie of the Month in August 2022 after posting a 2.15 ERA and 5-0 record.
• Is the highest drafted player out of Elon University.

LAST TIME OUT...L#5 vs. New York Mets, tossed 4.0 innings, allowing 5 runs (4 ER) on 9 hits and 1 walk while striking out 5 batters...threw 89 pitches and 60 strikes.

BACK IN BALTIMORE... over 4 games at Camden Yards, owns a 11.0 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a walk rate of 2.0%, both marks ranking 6th among pitchers since 2022 (min. 10.0 IP), with a 0.95 WHIP and a 2.49 ERA. has logged the most innings against the Orioles of any non AL West opponent (8 GS, 49.2 IP)...5 of his 8 career starts against the Orioles have been quality starts, 2 being 7.0+ innings, while he has recorded 6.0+ scoreless innings in 3 starts...finished 9.0 shutout innings in his 4th start against the Orioles on August 8, 2023 before the bullpen entered for the 10th inning, marking the only 9.0+ inning game of his career.

GOING THE DISTANCE...has reached the 6th inning in 11 of his 13 starts this year and has cleared the 7th inning in 3 of those starts...his 78.0 innings pitched this season are tied for the 14th most in MLB...has pitched 65 games of 6.0+ innings since 2023, including 7 starts this season, ranking T-5th most such in MLB over that span...his 78.0 IP through his first 13 starts are the most he has pitched over a 13 game span to start the year since his 2023 debut season...is also the most innings pitched over a 13 game span since he threw 78.2 over 13 starts from May 29 to August 7 of 2024.

MAINTAINING THE RATIO...has logged 5+ strikeouts and 2-or-fewer walks in 8 games this season (last: 6/3 vs. NYM) for the 9th most in the AL, matching Bryan Woo and 1 game ahead of Emerson Hancock...his 56 career such games are tied for the 7th most in the AL since 2023...among AL pitchers with 60+ strikeouts in 2026, his 2.1 BB/9 ranks T-9th...owns a 4.2 K/BB over his last 5 games (5/11-c), ranking 14th best in the AL over that span.

PLENTY OF PUNCHOUTS...has tossed 12+ strikeouts in 3 career games, including a career-high 14 strikeouts twice last season...is 1 of 10 pitchers with 3-or-more games of 12+ strikeouts since 2024.

SO NICE HE DID IT TWICE...is the only pitcher to have multiple starts of 14+ SO and no walks since 2025, having done so twice last season (6/8/25 at LAA & 9/14 vs. LAA)...teammate Emerson Hancock, with his May 2 start vs. Kansas City, is among the 4 pitchers that have logged 1 such game since 2025 along with Kirby, Max Meyer-MIA (4/21/25 vs. CIN) and Reid Detmers-LAA (5/24/26 vs. TEX).

GEORGE & WALTER...among pitchers with 125+ starts since 2022, he leads MLB in walks-per-nine innings (1.49) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.17), ranking just ahead of rotation mate Logan Gilbert (1.9 BB/9 and 4.90 K/BB).

QUALITY STUFF...has thrown 6 quality starts this season (last: 5/23 at KC)...has thrown 69 quality starts across his career, T-8th most in MLB since 2022...has 37 career quality starts without any walks (2x this season, last: 5/23 at KC), most in MLB since 2022, ahead of Tarik Skubal-DET (26 G) and Zack Wheeler-PHI (26 G)...has also tossed a quality start with no walks in 17 road games, 2nd most in MLB since 2022 and tied for the lead in Mariners history with Jamie Moyer.

FURIOUS GEORGE...has thrown 7.0+ innings with 3-or-fewer earned runs allowed in 3 starts this season and in 25 career starts...Kirby and Bryan Woo (4 G) are 2 of 11 pitchers in MLB this season to have 3+ games of 7.0+ IP, 3-or-fewer runs, 1-or-fewer walks, and 4+ strikeouts...Kirby's 8 such starts since 2023 are T-9th most in MLB across that span.

EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT...currently averages 15.3 pitches per inning this season, tied for the 9th lowest mark in the AL among qualified pitchers...is averaging 15.6 pitches per inning across his career, tied for the 12th-fewest P/IP among starters since 2022 (min. 500 IP).

KEEPING THEM ON THEIR TOES...owns a 38.6 chase rate this season, ranking 5th in MLB among qualified pitchers while posting a 35.7 career chase rate, ranking 15th among qualified pitchers since 2022...his 650 swing and misses on pitches outside the zone rank 10th among AL pitchers since 2022, while his 328 strikeouts are 8th most...of pitchers with over 250 strikeouts on pitches out of the zone, his 103 walks are the fewest, trailing Garrett Crochet-BOS (96) and Pablo López (101).

KEEPING IT CLOSE...his 53.6% ground-ball percentage this season ranks 3rd-highest in MLB among starters...increased his ground-ball percentage from 44.1% last season (+8.6)...posts a 44.7% ground-ball percentage across his career.

BEST IN ALL THE LAND...among starting pitchers since 2022 (min. 600 IP), he leads the Majors in fewest walks allowed (1.11), strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.17), walks-per-nine innings (1.4), and walk rate (3.8%).

FOR THE M'S HISTORY BOOKS...leads the Mariners franchise (min. 100 GS) in fewest walks-per-nine innings (1.4) and in strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.17)...ranks 7th in franchise history in career ERA (3.63), 2nd in WHIP (1.130) and 11th in total strikeouts (685 SO).

CRUISE CONTROL...tossed 8.0 innings on April 7 vs. Texas on the road, his 2nd career complete game (also: 8/12/23 vs. BAL)...is 1 of 7 pitchers with a complete game so far this season...became the first Mariners pitcher to toss 8.0+ IP since Logan Gilbert did so twice in 2024 (last: 9/7/24 at STL)... Kirby has thrown 8.0+ IP without a walk in 3 career games (last: 4/7 at TEX) and is 1 of 9 pitchers in MLB with 3-or-more such games since 2023, joining teammate Logan Gilbert (3 G, last: 6/16/24 vs. TEX).

WIN #50...earned his 50th career win on May 11 at Houston, becoming the 12th player in franchise history with 50+ wins...his 121 games are tied for the 4th-fewest games to reach 50 wins with the Mariners, alongside: Hisashi Iwakuma and Erik Hanson...behind: Jamie Moyer (100 G), Freddy García (100 G), and Marco Gonzales (118 G).
