RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue a 12-game, 14-day road trip against the Angels (1-1, one to play), Mariners (3G), Athletics (3G) and Giants (3G) today in Anaheim...have split their last four games (2-2), but have lost six of eight, 10 of 13, 16 of 22, 20 of 28 and 24 of their last 34 games...are 3-9 so far on a stretch of 19 road games in a 22-game span (July 25–Aug. 17)...started 21-26, went an MLB-best 25-9 from May 20–June 26 and are an MLB-worst 10-24 since June 27...are fourth in the AL East for the 26th consecutive day, a season-high-tying 11.0 GB the division-leading Blue Jays and 4.5 GB the Yankees for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...including off days and the All-Star break, they have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 32 in third, 56 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ✦ The Rays erupted for seven runs in the 4th inning en route to a 7-3 win over the Angels last night, setting the stage for today's rubber match.
- ✦ The seven-run inning surpassed the Rays total runs from their previous four games combined (5R)...it marked the seventh time they have scored seven runs or more in an inning to account for all of their runs in a game, first since Aug. 7, 2022 at DET.
- ✦ Eight Rays tallied a hit, but none had multiple hits—it was the fourth time in club history Tampa Bay scored seven runs or more without any player registering a multi-hit effort, first since Aug. 31, 2021 vs. BOS (8R), according to Stats Perform.
- ✦ Between **Jonny DeLuca** and **Jake Mangum**, the Rays recorded multiple outfield assists for the first time since July 28, 2024 vs. CIN (DeLuca, J. Lowe).
- ✦ The Rays bullpen has a 1.66 ERA (38.0IP, 7ER) in the last 10 games since July 27, second best in the majors behind the Mariners (1.57)...this, after posting a 6.04 ERA (85.0IP, 57ER) over the previous month (June 27–July 26), third worst in the majors.
- ✦ The Rays are 2-11 in their last 13 road games and 4-16 in their last 20...they are looking to win back-to-back games away from home for the first time since a six-game winning streak from June 13-26.
- ✦ Under **Kevin Cash** (2015–pres.), the Rays are 166-111 (.599) in August, second in the majors, trailing only the Dodgers (188-93/.669).
- ✦ Today, the Rays will be opposed by a left-handed starting pitcher for the fourth time in six games and the sixth time in 12 games...they are 1-8 in their last nine matchups with southpaws, and their 14-18 record in such games ranks 20th in the majors.

WHAT'S AT STAKE

- ✦ Win back-to-back games for the second time since the start of July, joining July 18-19 vs. BAL...snap a four-game losing streak in rubber matches, earning their first such win since June 8 vs. MIA.
- ✦ Halt a four-series losing streak with their first series win since July 18-20 vs. BAL.
- ✦ Snap a six-series losing streak on the road with their first series victory away from home since June 24-26 at KC.
- ✦ Record their first series win over the Angels since April 8-10, 2024 at Tropicana Field, ending an 0-2-1 skid, their longest vs. Los Angeles since Aug. 27, 2013–Aug. 3, 2014 (0-3-1)...improve to 11-3-3 in their last 17 series vs. the Halos overall.
- ✦ Improve to 10-1-0 in their last 11 series at Angel Stadium since 2015, securing their third straight series win in this venue, and 23-8 in their last 31 games in Anaheim.
- ✦ Complete the season series with Los Angeles with a 3-3 tie, moving to 8-0-2 in the last 10 season series since 2015 (clubs did not meet in 2020) while avoiding their first loss since dropping five of seven matchups in 2014.

BIG FRAME FEATS—The Rays plated all seven of their runs in the 4th inning last night, their third time this season recording seven runs or more in a frame along with May 25 vs. TOR (7R, 5th inn.) and April 14 vs. BOS (9R, 3rd inn.)...it was their most runs in any frame on the road since pushing across seven in the 2nd frame on Oct. 1, 2023 at TOR...it marked the AL-most 36th time this season the Rays have plated four runs or more in an inning, second most in the majors behind the Brewers (38)...Tampa Bay is 24-5 in games it records four runs or more in at least one inning.

B-LOWE BLASTS—**Brandon Lowe** opened the scoring with his 20th home run last night, his third consecutive 20-homer season and the fourth of his career...he became the fourth Ray to record four seasons with 20 HR or more, joining **Evan Longoria** (9), **Aubrey Huff** (4) and **Carlos Peña** (4)...he is also the fifth Ray to hit 20 HR or more in three consecutive seasons, joining **Randy Arozarena** (2021-23), Longoria (2013-17 & 2008-11), Peña (2007-10) and Huff (2002-05)...Lowe is one of five active second basemen with four (or more) 20-homer seasons (min. 50% of games at 2B), joining **HOU Jose Altuve** (6), **ATL Ozzie Albies** (4), **AZ Ketel Marte** (4) and **TEX Marcus Semien** (4)...he is responsible for four of the eight 20-HR seasons by second basemen in Rays history—**Ben Zobrist** (2009 & 2011), **Jorge Cantú** (2005) and **Logan Forsythe** (2016) have the others.

- ✦ Lowe's 20 HR rank second among primary second basemen behind Marte (21HR)...his 109 HR since 2021 are third, trailing Semien (136HR) and Altuve (115HR).
- ✦ Lowe is the 10th primary second baseman since 1901 to record four or more 20-HR seasons within his first eight seasons in the majors (see table to the right).

BASH BROS—Between **Junior Caminero** (28HR), **Yandy Díaz** (20HR) and **Brandon Lowe** (20HR), the Rays have three players with 20 HR before the end of August for the seventh time in team history, joining 2023 (Arozarena/Paredes/Siri), 2021 (B. Lowe, Meadows, Zunino), 2017 (Dickerson, Morrison, Souza Jr.), 2009 (Longoria/Peña/Zobrist), 2004 (Cruz Jr./Huff/Martinez) and 2000 (McGriff/Williams/Vaughn)...they are one of seven teams in the majors with three players who have reached the 20-HR mark, including one of four AL teams along with the Athletics (Kurtz/Langeliers/Rooker), Mariners (Arozarena/Raleigh/Rodriguez) and Yankees (Bellinger/Grisham/Judge)...10 major league clubs do not have a 20-HR hitter this season, and 11 have only one player who has reached the mark.

- ✦ Caminero, Diaz and Lowe have accounted for 55.7 pct. (68) of the Rays 122 HR.

MILESTONE WATCH—**Yandy Díaz** is one run from tying **Kevin Kiermaier** (410R) for fifth on the Rays all-time list...his 65 three-hit games are tied with **Aubrey Huff** (65G) for third...**Christopher Morel** is 4 RBI away from 200 for his career...**Junior Caminero** (98 RBI) and **Nick Fortes** (96 RBI) are both closing in on 100 career RBI...**Pete Fairbanks'** 293 SO as a reliever are tied for second most in Rays history (see table to the right)...his 81 saves are four shy of **Fernando Rodney** (85SV) for third in team history.

WILD WEST—The Rays current 12-game road trip is their longest since a pair of 12-game treks in 2005: May 30–June 12 (12G, 3G each in OAK, SEA, CIN, PIT) and Aug. 2-14 (12G, 3G each in TEX, LAA, BAL, CLE)...it also marks their first four-city trip since June 2-13, 2011 (SEA, LAA, BAL, DET), which culminated with a one-game make-up in Detroit...they also had a 10-game trip from July 19-29, 2013 in which they traveled through Toronto, Boston and New York (Yankees) before returning to Boston for a make-up game to close the trip.

- ✦ The Rays will travel over 6,200 miles on this trip, venturing from Tampa through Anaheim, Seattle, West Sacramento and San Francisco before returning home.



MESS WITH THE BULL...—**RHP Brian Van Belle** made his organizational debut last night with Triple-A Durham, tossing six shutout innings while yielding only one hit (W, 6.0IP, H, OR, BB, 4SO)...Van Belle was acquired from the Reds along with **LHP Adam Serwinowski** on July 30 for **RHP Zack Littell**...OF **Everson Pereira**, acquired from the Yankees at the deadline for **INF/OF José Caballero**, went 3-for-5 with a 392-foot, opposite-field homer in the win and has reached base safely in seven of his 16 PA with the Bulls (5H, 2BB, .438 OBP).

- ✦ **INF Carson Williams**, the Rays No. 1 prospect (MLB.com), swiped his 20th stolen base last night and is two homers shy of his third straight 20-HR, 20-SB campaign...only two minor leaguers have accomplished the feat this season: **Spencer Jones** (NYY) and **Kyler Fedko** (MIN)...according to Stats Perform, since 1995, only one minor league hitter has recorded three straight 20-20 seasons: **Kyle Tucker** (2017-19).

TODAY'S START—Shane Baz will toe the rubber for his 23rd start of the season and 11th on the road...marks his 46th career start and 24th as a visitor...marks his second career start opposite the Angels...the Rays have won seven of his last 13 starts and are 12-10 in his outings overall (6-4 on the road)...has taken the loss in a career-high five consecutive starts, pitching to a 6.49 ERA (26.1IP, 19ER)...was acquired from the Pirates as a player to be named later (Aug. 14, 2018) along with **RHP Tyler Glasnow** and **OF Austin Meadows** for **RHP Chris Archer** on July 31, 2018.

LAST TIME OUT—Suffered his career-high fifth consecutive loss after allowing five earned runs with no run support across 5.0 innings in a 5-0 loss to the Dodgers on Aug. 1 at Steinbrenner Field (L, 5.0IP, 8H, 5ER, 2BB, 8SO, HR)...worked from behind early after allowing a pair of doubles (including a two-run double from **Freddie Freeman**) that made it 2-0 after the 1st inning...he then retired nine of his next 11 batters faced (4SO) before he put two runners on in the 4th with a double and a single...both runs ended up scoring after an **Alex Freeland** RBI-single and a **Mookie Betts** sacrifice fly made it 4-0 Dodgers...Freeman added the final run with a solo home run to lead off the 5th before Baz fanned his final three batters to conclude the inning.

- ✦ It marked his fifth time this season with eight strikeouts or more, second most among Rays hurlers behind **Ryan Pepiot** (7G).
- ✦ He generated 16 whiffs, tied for his third most this season behind July 1 vs. ATH (20) and April 18 vs. BOS (17)...14 of those whiffs came on his fastballs (four seamer - 8; cutter - 6), second most in any outing of his career behind July 1 vs. ATH (15).
- ✦ The Rays have lost each of his last six starts after winning his previous seven from May 24-July 12...is 0-5 with three quality starts, a 5.94 ERA (33.1IP, 22ER), 38 SO and a .296 (40-for-135) opp. average in that six-start span...is the second-longest winless streak by a Rays starter this season, behind **Drew Rasmussen's** seven-start span from April 6-May 11.

CALLING ALL ANGELS—Baz has faced the Angels just once in his career, allowing two earned runs on a home run in a 4-3 loss on April 8 at Steinbrenner Field (7.0IP, 3H, 2ER, HR, 4BB, 6SO)...has made eight starts against AL West clubs in his career, going 2-2 with a 3.38 ERA (50.2IP, 19ER), 46 SO and a .234 (45-for-192) opp. average...yielded three earned runs or fewer in each of those eight outings...is 1-1 with a 2.92 ERA (24.2IP, 8ER), 18 SO and a .247 (23-for-93) clip over four career starts on the road in AL West ballparks.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN—Baz is 3-4 with a 2.97 ERA (60.2IP, 20ER) in 10 road starts, the eighth-lowest mark among qualified AL pitchers...four of his last five starts on the road have been quality starts, going 2-3 with a 1.69 ERA (32.0IP, 6ER) in that span while holding opponents to a .202/.283/.298 (23-for-114) clip with 30 strikeouts.

- ✦ Baz has allowed three runs or fewer in 13 of his last 14 road starts dating back to Aug. 20, 2024 at OAK, sporting a 2.63 ERA (85.2IP, 25ER) in that span.
- ✦ He has taken the loss in three straight road starts despite two of the three being quality starts.

WHERE DID THE PARTY GO?—Over the span of eight consecutive starts between May 24-July 1, Baz received three runs of support or more in each start, totaling 36 runs of support and a 6.66 run support average...he also posted a 5-0 record and a 3.33 ERA (48.2IP, 18ER) over that timeframe...in his five starts since, he has received three total runs of support, good for a 1.03 run support average, while pitching to a 6.49 ERA (26.1IP, 19ER).

- ✦ When Baz receives three runs of support or more in his career, he is 13-1 with a 3.11 ERA (124.1IP, 43ER), and the Rays are 19-4 (10-2 in 2025)...in 21 starts with two runs or fewer, he is 2-12 with a 5.13 ERA (119.1IP, 68ER), and Tampa Bay has gone 5-17 (2-8 in 2025).

CUT IT UP—Baz fully introduced a cutter to his arsenal on June 15 and opponents have since gone 17-for-58 (.293) with 11 SO against the offering... they were 2-for-17 (.118) in his first three starts after implementing the pitch, but are 15-for-41 (.366) in his last six...the cutter has been his second-most utilized pitch over his last nine starts, throwing it 28.5 pct. of the time (249 of 875 pitches), trailing only his four-seam fastball (39.7%/347 of 875)... he has not thrown a slider since he began utilizing the cutter.

RUNNING OUT OF GAS—Over the first three innings, Baz has pitched to a 3.27 ERA (66.0IP, 24ER), 1.17 WHIP and .220 (54-for-246) opp. average... he has held opponents scoreless in the opening frame in 19 of his 22 starts this season and 37 of his 45 career starts...Baz went 13 straight starts (April 25-July 1) without a run allowed in the first two frames prior to his outing on July 7 at DET...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 6.52 ERA (58.0IP, 42ER), 1.52 WHIP and .288 (65-for-226) opp. average...42 of his 66 runs allowed (63.6%) have come from the 4th inning on.

10 FOR 10—Baz struck out a career-high 11 batters on April 14 vs. BOS... paired with his start on April 1 vs. PIT, he became the fifth pitcher since 1901 to record 10 SO or more with no walks in two of his first three starts of a season, joining **MIL Corbin Burnes** and **CWS Lance Lynn** in 2021, **WSH Stephen Strasburg** in 2010 and **AZ Randy Johnson** in 2000 (Stats Perform).

GOING STREAKING—Baz threw 6.0 IP or more with two runs or fewer in six consecutive starts from Sept. 17, 2024-April 14, 2025, tying the longest streak in franchise history (6GS, 5x, last: **Shane McClellan**, June 20-July 26, 2022)...he was 4-0 with a 1.89 ERA (38.0IP, 8ER) and 0.74 WHIP during the streak, holding opponents to a .160/.218/.252 (21-for-131) slash line with 46 SO and 7 BB.
