## STAY INFORMED

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RAY REPORT-The Rays open a seven-game homestand against the Orioles (4 to play) and Cubs ( 3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...on Wednesday, they wrapped up a 3-2 road trip through Baltimore (1-2) and Miami (2-0)...have won three straight games for the first time since a season-high five-game streak from May 13-18...are 6-3 in their last in their last 15 games overall after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 from May $3-18 \ldots$ have spent the entire season to this point within four games of $.500 . .$. this marks 3-18....have speginning of a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June $7-26$.

With Wednesday's 5-3 win in Miami, the Rays collected their second series sweep of 2024 , joining May $3-5$ vs. NYM...it marked their first road sweep since Sweep of 2024, Joining
The Rays plated three runs in the opening frame and never relinquished the lead... they had not gone wire-to-wire in their previous 15 games, earning their first such victory since May 17 at TOR (4-3)
Tampa Bay hit . 435 (10-for-23) with RISP during the two-game set...the Rays had produced a. 194 (18-for-93) clip in scoring situations over their previous 13 games. The Rays bullpen owns a 2.82 ERA (121.11P, 38ER) since May 3 , third lowest in the AL behind the Guardians (1.93) and Astros (2.50) and fifth in MLB.
Tampa Bay is an AL-worst 4-9 in its last 13 home games since May 8.
The Rays are 1-6 in their last seven games against AL East opponents after a 9-7 start...they have lost four straight home games to division rivals, their longest skid since April 18-May 10, 2019 (5G), and are 0-2-1 in home sets vs. AL East clubs. Tampa Bay has won six of its last 10 series following a 3-5-2 start...this marks the club's fourth four-game series, going 1-0-2 in the previous three.
With a win tonight, the Rays will move above the .500 mark for the first time since entering play on May 21 (25-24).
RECENT TRANSACTIONS-Earlier today, the Rays reinstated SS Taylor Walls (recovery from right hip surgery) from the 60-day IL and designated OF Harold Ramírez
for assignment...Walls underwent the surgery on Oct. 27, 2023 performed by Dr. JW for assignment...Walls underwent the surgery on Oct. 27, 2023, performed by Dr. J.W. and repair a labral tear...he hit 263 (10-for-38) over a 10-game rehab assignment, going 8 -for-21 (.381) with 5 2B, 13 B and 5 RBI over five games with Triple-A Durham.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS-The Rays will face a left-handed starter for the fourth consecutive game, their longest streak since April 23-26, 2021 (Matz, Ray, Ryu, Manaea), and for the fifth time in their last seven games...they are 11-5 (.688) when opposed by LH starters, fourth best in the majors behind the Guardians (12-3/.800), orinst lefty starters dating to May 3 vs. NYM, their longest streak since Aug. 3-25, 2022 ( 7 G ), according to Elias...prior to the current stretch of five in seven games, Tampa Bay faced a LH starter southpaw in 10 of their first 24 contests.

Since the start of 2023, the Rays are 35-16 (.686) in games against LH starters, the third-best record in MLB behind the Braves (36-16/.692) and Orioles (49-22/.690).
TURNING TIDES-From June 4-5, Randy Arozarena reached base safely in eight consecutive plate appearances (1B, 2B, 4BB, 2HBP).... he fell 2 PA shy of the club record of 10 PA, shared by himself (May 20-22, 2022), Yandy Díaz (Aug. 20-23, 2020) and Ji-Man Choi (Sept. 11-12, 2019)...the two-game stretch raised his on-base pct. from . 263 to .285.

Despite posting an average exit velocity of 90.4 mph , only 1.3 mph below his 2023 mark (91.7), Arozarena's .169 average is the lowest qualified mark in the majors.. his 203 batting av Naylor (.199).

average (.248)...this, despite posting a higher hard-hit rate against heaters (55.9\%) average (.248)...this, despite post.

BRINGING THELUMBER-Isaac Paredes is batting .310 ( 9 -for-29) with 4 2B, 1 HR and 8 RBI during his seven-game hitting streak....he also has a 13-game on-base streak and has reached safely in 31 of his last 32 games since April 28, ranking among AL leaders during base multiple times in 35 of his 58 games overall-in all of MLB, only NYY Aaron Judge and NYY Juan Soto (both 39G) have recorded more such efforts.

Brandon Lowe, who has a 12 -game on-base streak, went 4 -for- 8 with 1 2B, 1
HR and 6 RBI during Tampa Bay's two-game sweep in Miami..he recorded consecutive multi-hit games for the first time since May 16-17, 2023 at NYM.
Jose Siri is batting .296 ( 8 -for-27) with $32 \mathrm{~B}, 2 \mathrm{HR}$ and 8 RBI over his last eight games...he has 14 RBI in his last 16 games after entering that stretch with 7 RBI in his first 34 contests.
RALLY RAYS-The Rays 17 comeback wins are tied with the Tigers for fourth most in the majors behind the Yankees (19), Orioles and Phillies (both 18)...each of their six wins from May 18-June 4 came in come-from-behind fashion, their longest streak since May $8-18,2013$ (8G), per Elias... 54.8 pct. of their victories ( 17 of 31 ) have been comeback wins, tied with the Ingers for the highest percentage in the AL/tied for fourth highest in the majors...they are on pace for 44 comeback wins, wh
total in club history behind 2021 (46) and 2008 (45).

The Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (T2nd, 7), seven (1st, 6) and eight (T3rd, 3) frames.
Tampa Bay has rallied from a $3+$ run to deficit to win six times, including twice in its last three games...it ties the Giants for the most such wins in the majors (Elias).

DOWN TO THE WIRE-The Rays own the best record in the majors in both one-run games (12-4/.750) and games decided by two runs or fewer (22-9/.710)...their 31 games decided by two or fewer runs are tied with the Orioles for third most in the AL behind (22), but their 22 losses Angels (32)...they lead the majors in wins by two runs or fewer
season streak a seven-game run from Aug. 10-Sept. 2, 2019...they are 13-3 in their last 16 games decided by two runs or fewer.
BIRDS IN THE BAY-The Rays and Orioles continue a 13 -game season series with the fourth of seven matchups over 11 days from May 31-June 10...in 2023, the Rays went $5-8$ against the Orioles (2-4 at home), snapping a streak of six consecutive season series victories...since 2017, the Rays are 73 - 45 against the Orioles, their most wins against any opponent over that timeframe...however, the Rays have lost 10 of the last 15 meetings and are 13-19 in the last 32 matchups on the heels of a $27-2$ stretch in the previous 29 .

The Rays are 0-4-1 in five series against the Orioles since the beginning of last
season...their last series win over Baltimore came from Aug. 12-14, 2022 at Tropicana Field.

TONIGHT'S START-Civale will take the ball for his 13th start of the season, including his seventh at Tropicana Field...has gone $0-3$ with a 6.92 ERA (39.OIP, 30ER) in his last eight starts after pitching to a 2-1 mark and 2.74 ERA (23.OIP, 7ER) in his first four...is seeking his first win since April 9 at LAA...has gone 4-7 with a 5.37 ERA (107.1IP, 64ER) in 22 starts since

LAST TIME OUT-Did not factor into the decision on May 31 at BAL, allowing one run on six hits and one walk across 5.1 innings...worked around singles by Gunnar Henderson and Ryan Mountcastle in the 1st to Henderson in the in order in the 2nd....worked around a one-out walk the 4th...remained scoreless through 5.0 IP after stranding Jorge Mateo and Adley Rutschman...a Santander single in the 6th chased Civale, and Santander scored after Richard Lovelady came on in relief.

IT'S YOU AGAIN-Civale takes on the Orioles for the second time in as many starts...in four career starts opposite Baltimore, he is $2-0$ with a 5.48 ERA (21.1IP, 13ER)...he has worked 5.0+ innings in each outing, but has allowed a total of six home runs, including 3 HR in his first career start at Camden Yards on June 5, 2021.

He is 6-8 with a 5.29 ERA (97.0IP, 57ER) in 19 career starts against AL
East opponents, including 1-2 with a 4.78 ERA (26.1IP, 14ER) in five starts this season.
BATTLING BACK-Over his last two starts, Civale has posted a 2.61 ERA (10.1IP, 3ER) with two walks and one home run allowed...this, following a six-start stetch from April 21-May 19 in which he went $0-3$ with an 8.48 ERA (28.2IP, 27ER) while conceding 12 walks and five home runs.

CRUISING, THEN BRUISING-From innings 1-3, Civale has posted a 2.50 ERA (36.0IP, 10ER) and a . 198 (26-for-131) opp. average...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 9.35 ERA (26.0IP, 27ER) with a 342 (39-for-114) opp. average...he has allowed a combined 25 runs (23ER) in the 4th and 5th innings compared to 14 runs (all earned) in all other frames...this includes 14 runs allowed in the 5th inning, second most in the majors behind STL Miles Mikolas (16R).

He has struggled to escape innings, allowing opponents to slash 296/.367/.494 (24-for-81) with two outs... 17 of the 31 RBI recorded against him have come with two outs, including 4 of the 11 HR .

STARTING AT THE TOP-Civale has limited opposing lead-off hitters to a 152/.222/.242 (5-for-33) line, the fifth-lowest opp. average in the AL (min 35BF) behind SEA Logan Gilbert (.083), NYY Luis Gil (.125), BAL Corbin Burnes (.135) and LAA Patrick Sandoval (.147).

Five-and six-hole hitters have given him the most trouble, as they are hitting a combined .420 (21-for-50) with $62 \mathrm{~B}, 5 \mathrm{HR}$ and 12 RBI. overall, opposing 5-9 hitters have gone 38-for-120 (.317) with 7 2B, 8
HR and 22 RBI off Civale, while 1-4 hitters are 27 -for-125 (.216) with
3 2B, 3 HR and 9 RBI.
BIT BY THE LONG BALL-Civale's 11 HR allowed are tied for fifth most in the AL...he has yielded at least 1 HR in 10 of his 12 starts and in 16 of his last 19 dating back to Aug. 23, 2023 vs. COL...entering that stretch, he had permitted just 1 HR in his previous 10 starts from June 25-Aug. 16, 2023.

Nearly half (18) of the 39 runs he has allowed this season have come on the 11 HR against him.
3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER-For his career, Civale is $31-1$ with a 3.41 ERA (316.2IP, 120ER) in games when he receives three or more runs of support. he has a $2-29$ record with a 5.06 ERA (220.2IP, 124ER) in games receiving two or fewer runs of support.

He has received two runs of support or less in seven of 12 starts this season, going 0-4 with a 4.38 ERA (37.0IP, 18ER)...when getting $3+$
runs of support in 2024 , Civale is $2-0$ with a 6.84 ERA (25.0IP, 19ER).
