# Miami Marlins (49-86) at San Francisco Giants (68-68)

**TODAY'S GAME:** SF began its six-game homestand with late heroics for a 3-1 win last night and will try to make it a series win with a victory here tonight against Miami.

- ▶ Despite dropping 10 of their last 17 games, SF is still 19-13 (.594) since July 26, the eighth-best win % in MLB.
- ▶ Due to the success of their competitors, SF is 6.5 back of the Braves (74-61) for the final Wild Card spot with the Mets (71-64) and Cubs (69-66) in between...per *FanGraphs*, SF's playoff chances are now 1.5%.

**ROSTER MOVES:** RHP Mason Black (#47) has been recalled from Triple-A Sacramento and will start tonight's game...RHP Austin Warren was optioned to Triple-A to make room on the roster for Black.

**IT AIN'T EASY:** SF plays 21 of its final 26 games against opponents who are currently .500 or better...the Marlins and Cardinals are the only sub .500 teams left on SF's schedule.

- ▶ The Giants have the third-toughest remaining schedule in MLB in terms of their opponents' combined win%...SF's remaining opponents have a .536 win%, which trails only the Rockies (.552) and Rays (.539).

**MATT WITH THE BAT:** IF Matt Chapman single-handedly carried the Giants offense with his bases-clearing double in the 8th inning last night.

- ▶ The swing allowed Chapman to retake the team lead in RBI (67)...he also leads the team in hits (123), runs scored (88), doubles (33), homers (21) and total bases (221)...he's tied for the team lead in walks (60) with the departed Jorge Soler.
- ▶ He's been worth 5.7 bWAR this year, fourth-best in the NL and ninth-best in MLB.
- ▶ The last Giants position player to accumulate at least 5.7 bWAR in a single season was IF Brandon Crawford in 2021 (6.1)...the last Giants third baseman to accumulate that much bWAR in a season was Pablo Sandoval (6.0) in 2011.

**SMALL STEPS:** Last night's win brought the Giants to 14-12 this month, securing a winning record for the month of August...it's SF's third full month with a winning record this year (also 15-13 in May and 13-12 in July).

- ▶ It's the first time SF has had consecutive winning months since May and June of last year (17-12 and 18-8, respectively)...the last time SF had three winning months in a season was 2021 when they had a winning record in every month en route to a 107-55 record.

**GO FISH:** Since the start of the 2018 season, the Giants have won each of their last five home series vs. Miami, going 12-5 with 10 of 17 games being decided by one run (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ OF Michael Conforto has 20 homers, a .946 OPS and 59 RBI in 95 career games vs. Miami, which rank sixth, tied for sixth and eighth among active players (min. 150 PA).

**WELCOME BACK:** RHP Mason Black will make his first start with SF since May 23rd with his outing tonight after being recalled from Triple-A.

- ▶ In four games (three starts) at the Major League level this year Black has allowed 14 runs on 21 hits in 14.1 innings (8.79 ERA) while striking out 10 and walking seven...opponents have hit .339 off him in the limited sample size.
- ▶ This will be his third start here at Oracle Park...he enjoyed his most successful MLB outing here on May 11 vs. the Reds with 4.1 innings of one-run ball.
- ▶ In four starts down at Triple-A this month, Black logged a 2.91 ERA (7er, 21.ip)...he last pitched 11 days ago in Tacoma for the River Cats, giving up one run on one hit in 5.2 innings.
- ▶ Black is currently SF's eighth-best prospect according to *MLB.com* and their third-best pitching prospect behind LHP Carson Whisenhunt (#3 on SF's Top-30) and LHP Joe Whitman (#6).

**OUR YELLOW SUBMARINE:** RHP Tyler Rogers logged another scoreless inning here at home last night, lowering his home ERA this year to 0.84 (3er, 32.0ip).

- ▶ Rogers has not allowed a run at home since May 15 vs. the Dodgers, a span of 22 games and 20.1 innings.
- ▶ The righty has the lowest home ERA in the National League this year (min. 30.0ip) and third-lowest in the Majors.

**OUT THE GATE:** With LHP Blake Snell's 7.0 innings of one-run ball last night, Giants starters as a unit now have a 3.70 ERA (97er, 236.0ip) since July 9 (the day Snell returned from his IL stint)...the 3.70 ERA in that time is seventh-best in the Majors but third-best in the National League behind the Padres (3.69) and Brewers (3.40) in that span.

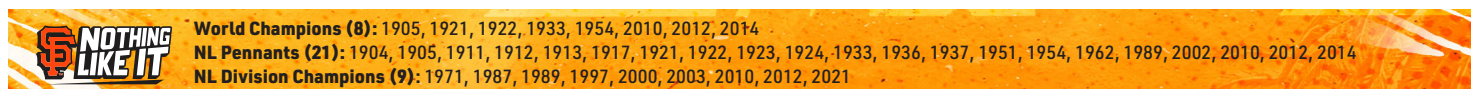
**THE OUTFIELD:** OF Heliot Ramos has 20 homers as an outfielder, tied for third-most in the National League among OF's...only LAD's Teoscar Hernández (28) and CHC's Ian Happ (22) have more homers as outfielders in the NL this year.

## 2024 RECORD: 0-1, 8.79 ERA

**WITH THE GIANTS:** Black is making his fourth MLB start and his fifth appearance with the Giants at the MLB level this season... he has spent parts of four seasons in the system after being taken in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University (Bethlehem, PA)...Black became the seventh Giant, and sixth pitcher, to make his Major League debut this season when he debuted in Philadelphia back on May 6.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Twirled 5.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in Tacoma against the Rainiers 11 days ago on August 20...took the loss, however, as Sacramento was shutout 2-0...Black walked four and struck out three in the losing effort while throwing 90 pitches.

**OF LATE:** Black had a 2.91 ERA (7er, 21.2ip) in four starts at the Triple-A level this month...it's been his best month since being optioned down to Triple-A after his last MLB outing on May 23 at Pittsburgh...prior to this four-start stretch, Black had an 8.25 ERA (33er, 36.0ip) with one quality start over his previous 10 outings from May 28-July 26.

**THIS MONTH'S MIXTAPE:** Below is a breakdown of Black's arsenal this month at Triple-A in his four outings.

**LAST MLB OUTING:** Pitched behind an opener on May 23 at Pittsburgh and allowed four runs on three hits (one homer) while walking two and striking out two...was optioned to Triple-A the next day.

**THE PIPELINE:** The 24-year-old right-hander enters today as the Giants eighth-best prospect overall according to *MLB.com*...he's the third-best pitching prospect in the system behind **LHP Carson Whisenhunt** (#3) and **LHP Joe Whitman** (#6)...below is a look at the pitching prospects in SF's system as of today.

**FAMILY TIME:** Made his debut with SF on May 6 at Philadelphia in the ballpark he grew up going to as a child...Black was born and raised in nearby Scranton, PA before attending Lehigh University in Bethlehem, PA...Black had nearly 60 family and friends on hand for his debut at Citizens Bank Park.

**WHAT'S IN A NAME?:** Black told reporters this spring that he and his brother Dixon's names are inspired by the Mason-Dixon line, which is a line that separates Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware and West Virginia...per *The Athletic's Andrew Baggarly*, Mason and Dixon have matching tattoos of the geographical location (39° 43' 18" N.) to honor their namesake...Dixon is an infielder at Wofford University.
